contents this ebook is the best known work of thomas aquinas c 1225 1274 although unfinished the summa
is one of the classics of the history of philosophy and one of the most influential works of western
literature it is intended as an instructional guide for moderate theologians and a compendium of all of
the main theological teachings of the catholic church it presents the reasoning for almost all points
of christian theology in the west the summa theologica is divided into three parts and each of these
three parts contains numerous subdivisions part 1 deals primarily with god and comprises discussions of
119 questions concerning the existence and nature of god the creation angels the work of the six days
of creation the essence and nature of man and divine government part 2 deals with man and includes
discussions of 303 questions concerning the purpose of man habits types of law vices and virtues
prudence and justice fortitude and temperance graces and the religious versus the secular life part 3
deals with christ and comprises discussions of 90 questions concerning the incarnation the sacraments
and the resurrection some editions of the summa theologica include a supplement comprising discussions
of an additional 99 questions concerning a wide variety of loosely related issues such as

excommunication indulgences confession marriage purgatory and the relations of the saints toward the damned scholars believe that rainaldo da piperno a friend of aquinas probably gathered the material in this supplement from a work that aquinas had completed before he began working on the summa theologica it seeks to describe the relationship between god and man and to explain how man s reconciliation with the divine is made possible at all through christ to this end aquinas cites proofs for the existence of god and outlines the activities and nature of god approximately one half of the summa theologica then examines the nature and purpose of man finally aquinas devotes his attention to the nature of christ and the role of the sacraments in effecting a bridge between god and man within these broad topical boundaries though aquinas examines the nature of god and man in exquisite detail his examination includes questions of how angels act on bodies the union of body and soul the cause and remedies of anger cursing and the comparison of one sin with another aquinas is attempting to offer a truly universal and rational view of all existence thomas aquinas o p 1225 1274 also thomas of aquin or aquino was an italian dominican priest and an immensely influential philosopher and theologian in the tradition of scholasticism within which he is also known as the doctor angelicus doctor communis and doctor universalis he was the foremost classical proponent of natural theology and the father of thomism his influence on western thought is considerable and much of modern philosophy was conceived in development or refutation of his ideas particularly in the areas of ethics natural law metaphysics and political theory

robert greene contemporary of shakespeare and marlowe and member of the group of six known as the university wits is the subject of this essay collection the first to be dedicated solely to his work although in his short lifetime greene published some three dozen prose works composed at least five plays and was one of the period s most recognized even notorious literary figures his place within the

canon of renaissance writers has been marginal at best writing robert greene offers a reappraisal of greene s career and of his contribution to elizabethan culture rather than drawing lines between greene s work for the pamphlet market and for the professional theatres the essays in the volume imagine his writing on a continuum some essays trace the ways in which greene s poetry and prose navigate differing cultural economies others consider how the full spectrum of his writing contributes to an emergent professional discourse about popular print and theatrical culture the volume includes an annotated bibliography of recent scholarship on greene and three valuable appendices presenting apocrypha edition information and editions organized by year of publication

the council of nicaea in 325 ad marked the beginning of a new era in christianity for the first time doctrines were organized into a single creed the nicene and post nicene fathers did most of their writing during and after this important event in church history unlike the previous era of christian writing the nicene and post nicene era is dominated by a few very important and prolific writers in volume viii of the 14 volume collected writings of the nicenes and post nicenes first published between 1886 and 1889 readers will find saint augustines extensive treatment of the psalms augustine took this book from the old testament and wove into it the revelation of jesus as the savior of humanity through the skill of augustine it seems as though the psalms had been written by an oracle who knew that eventually the messiah would come and wrote to pave the way this volume is a valuable reference book for any christian wishing to have the psalms illuminated and explained

by setting forth the book of genesis as it is re presented in the rabbinic statement genesis rabbah neusner demonstrates the way in which judaism confronted creation and the genesis story in confronting creation the author presents a new analytical translation of genesis rabbah a document that came to closure around 400 c e what made that particular time crucial in the life of israel and the jewish people is an event that also helped shape the entire history of western civilization the rise of christianity to the status of the official religion of the roman empire the judaic sages rereading of the torah s accounts of the beginning of the world and of israel took place during a time of significant change in western civilization that fact explains the importance of this reading of genesis to western civilization because genesis rabbah illuminates the judaic tradition in contemplating god s

creation of the world

this is the extended and annotated edition including an extensive biographical annotation about the author and his life in any commentary on a portion of the old testament by a writer unacquainted with hebrew exact criticism and freedom from mistake must not be expected but the psalms have been so in the mouth and in the heart of god s people in all languages that it has been necessary often to find an explanation suitable to imperfect translations and no doubt it is intended that we should use such explanations for the purpose of edification when we are unable to be more accurate though in proving doctrine it is necessary always to remember and allow for any want of acquaintance with the original or uncertainty with respect to its actual meaning however the main scope and bearing of the text is rarely affected by such points as vary in different translations and the analogy of the faith is sufficient to prevent a catholic 4 mind from adopting any error in consequence of a text seeming to bear a heterodox meaning perhaps the errors of translation in the existing versions may have led the fathers to adopt rules of interpretation ranging too far from the simple and literal but having such translations they could hardly use them otherwise meanwhile st augustine will be found to excel in the intense apprehension of those great truths which pervade the whole of sacred writ and in the vivid and powerful exposition of what bears upon them it is hardly possible to read his practical and forcible applications of holy scripture without feeling those truths by the faith of which we ought to live brought home to the heart in a wonderful manner his was a mind that strove earnestly to solve the great problems of human life and after exhausting the resources and discovering the emptiness of erroneous systems found truth and rest at last in catholic christianity in the religion of the bible as expounded by st ambrose and though we must look to his confessions for the full view of all his cravings after
