charismatic theology of the holy spirit has infected most of evangelicalism in ways we don't often recognize one of the primary reasons for this is a neglect in clear teaching about who the holy spirit is and what we should expect his normal work to be according to the word of god the remedy to this problem then is to clearly articulate what the bible tells us will be the holy spirit's normal work this book is not a book on the doctrine of the holy spirit generally but rather a focused consideration of the holy spirit's work in history scott aniol progresses through each major category of the holy spirit's activities in scripture assessing their role and helping you to discern that we should expect the spirit to normally work today in ways that bring order and completion to the plan and people of god scott aniol phd is executive vice president and editor in chief of g3 ministries and professor of pastoral theology at grace bible theological seminary he also serves as an elder of pray's mill baptist church in douglasville ga

god calling provides groundbreaking and provocative insights into how god works in the world through the gift of his holy spirit in the nt we do not find the saints praying and constantly asking god what to do instead the spirit continuously leads and guides giving spiritual direction for people in the real world people just like you looking at the biblical record as a whole god calling delivers a paradigm shift for our understanding the indwelling spirit's impact on christians decision making prayer life spiritual practices and knowing god's will bringing spiritual warfare down to the real world god calling helps us correct some of our hyper spiritual practices while giving clear spiritual direction to enable followers of jesus living in the real world to be

wise mature and christ like and for his church to be robust proactive and confident

while acknowledging the inherent tension between evangelicals who emphasize theological propositions and those who emphasize personal experience alister mcgrath believes that spirituality represents the interface between ideas and life between christian theology and human existence the book explores the centrality of mcgrath s theology in the development of his views on spirituality mcgrath does not approach spirituality from a theological void but instead uses his theological perspective as the foundation through detailed examination of mcgrath s previous work and the writing of other evangelicals the merging of theology and spirituality offers an overview of a unique thinker s contributions and a guide for future theological and spiritual exploration

the hiddenness of god addresses the problem of divine hiddenness which concerns the ambiguity of evidence for god s existence the elusiveness of god s comforting presence the palpable and devastating experience of divine absence and abandonment and more phenomena which are hard to reconcile with the idea central to the jewish and christian scriptures that there exists a god who is deeply and lovingly concerned with the lives of humans michael c rea argues that divine hiddenness is not a problem to be explained away but rather a consequence of the nature of god himself he shows that it rests on unwarranted assumptions and expectations about god s love for human beings rea explains how scripture and tradition bear testimony not only to god s love but to god s transcendence he shows that god s transcendence should be

understood as implying that all of god's intrinsic attributes divine love included elude our grasp in significant ways

prayers from god ups the ante on how to pray out loud at church a methodology is described whereby you can pray prayers that not only glorify god and edify the church but change lives and change the church the book includes two hundred prayers that have been prayed out loud as part of the life of one evangelical church by one layman in worship services prayer meetings etc over a period of twenty years what makes these prayers unique is the author's justification for calling them prayers from god these prayers display a passion and a concern for the lost you'll find nowhere else and give a glimpse into the life of evangelical church life you'll not find prayers that cause controversy and make people uncomfortable in most books of prayers but you will here you can't just read these prayers you pray these prayers as you read them

served as an expert witness centered on the constitutionality of allowing religious organizations to operate programs in state run facilities using the trial as a case study sullivan argues that separation of church and state is no longer possible religious authority has shifted from institutions to individuals making it difficult to define religion let alone disentangle it from the state prison religion casts new light on church state law the debate over government funded faith based programs and the predicament of prisoners who have precious little choice about what kind of rehabilitation they receive if they are offered any at all
