ordained according to contemporary ecclesial understanding repeated canonical prohibitions on ordaining women show both that women were being ordained and how those bans were very selectively implemented these canons were a cultural practice in search of a theology and the subsequent theological justifications for restricting ordination to men appealed to supposed female inferiority against the background of priesthood as eminence rather than service o brien shows that the assertion of women s non ordainability is a matter of canon law rather than doctrine as such that law can be reformed
