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andrew donskov takes a critical look not only at tolstoy s attitude towards the peasant class he so often championed for their simple ways and freedom from upper class sophistication and

pretentiousness but more importantly gives voice to representatives of the peasant class itself the theme of the peasantry is central throughout most of Tolstoy's long career his obsession with this class is seen not just as a matter of social or humanitarian concern but as a response to the questions of how to live a good life and what is the meaning of life that an inevitable death will not destroy these questions plagued him his entire life the letters he exchanged with the four major peasant sectarian writers Bondarev Zheltov Verigin and Novikov reveal that Tolstoy was matched as a profound thinker by his correspondents as they converse on religious moral questions the meaning of life and how one should strive to find it and on a wide array of burning social and personal problems reading through the analysis and the extensively annotated letters as a unified whole elucidates the progressive development of the ideas they shared and where these diverged and which guided Tolstoy's and his correspondents' lives juxtaposing Tolstoy's letters with those of his four sectarian correspondents makes them even more significant as it shows them in their original context a dialogue or conversation also with the aim to present the conversation in an even broader context Andrew Donskov briefly discusses Tolstoy's relationship with peasants in general as well as with each of the four individual writers in particular in addition he provides a background sketch of two major religious groups namely the Doukhobors and the Molokans both of which still claim sizeable populations of followers in North America today originally published in 2008 by the Slavic Research Group at the University of Ottawa under the title *Leo Tolstoy and Russian Peasant Sectarian Writers Selected Correspondence* the expanded University of Ottawa Press edition includes 44 letters never published in English out of the total 155 letters correspondence translated by John Woodsworth published in English

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born in paris in 1905 to a german jewish family from frankfurt and dying a century later in montreal raymond klibansky lived a life indelibly coloured by the history of the twentieth century his thought shaped and was shaped by intellectual currents both european and american and his scholarly work entailed an intellectual reckoning with tradition that was unique in its scope and ambition long before talk of academic interdisciplinarity klibansky a student of karl jaspers and ernst cassirer was educated in the liberal milieu of the weimar republic forced to emigrate from germany in 1933 klibansky spent the war years in london where he participated in the british war effort working in the tradition established by aby warburg and the warburg library he completed with erwin panofsky and fritz saxl the german text of saturn and melancholy the book s cast metal type was reclaimed for the war effort before it could be printed but it was eventually published in english in 1964 and has deeply influenced understandings of the interrelations between humanities disciplines ever since after the war klibansky came to mcgill university where he enjoyed a brilliant career as a scholar of platonic studies and the history of ideas mainly in the works of locke and hume over twelve chapters each devoted to questions that were dear to klibansky during his long life georges leroux presents dialogues with his mentor selected from decades of conversation exploring themes including philosophical traditions melancholy tolerance peace and the role of philosophy in international relations scholarship interlinked with the events of a turbulent century is at the centre of these fascinating conversations between student and teacher a richly illustrated autobiography through dialogue raymond klibansky is a portrait of a heroic figure in twentieth century philosophy a model for a younger generation who can find in his scholarship an admirable example of virtue in the service of peace

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pierre nora s concept lieux de mémoire realms of memory has become arguably the most significant academic point of reference when discussing processes of nation building and their interconnectedness with history and collective memory although his theory has acquired popularity well beyond its application to the french context his influential seven volume series 1984 92 is not without its own shortcomings and failures which have only occasionally been exposed over the last two decades it is not until the recent publication of postcolonial realms of memory liverpool university press 2020 that we see an expansive critique of nora s own selective memory our project seeks to continue challenging nora s approach and france s national narrative by providing space to examine queer lives cultures and memories we contend however that those related to queer experiences within france s collective memory have almost never been addressed queer realms of memory is the first book length study to question nora s lack of engagement with queer french and francophone cultures and histories

being able to collect valid data is crucial for empirical science disciplines such as linguistics developmental psycholinguistics clinical psycholinguistics and speech and hearing sciences in recent years there has been an increasing use of digital devices for remote language assessments such as online elicitation of language samples apps for eliciting expressive and productive lexical abilities and online questionnaires with the ongoing covid 19 pandemic still affecting many lives globally there have been numerous disruptions of face to face in person language assessments leading many researchers to conduct their language assessments online despite the necessity of remote language assessments and the convenience they may bring to both assessors and assesseees the potential merits limits and problems of remote testing have not yet been systematically explored and understood this timely research topic seeks contributions that mobilize new evidence and or insightful and nuanced discussions to address questions such as can we control online testing so that it is as good as face to face in person testing and if so how do we have evaluative evidence of such practices and if so how robust is the evidence what adaptations and concerns can and cannot be accommodated at the present time what opportunities are offered by recent technological advances are there certain conditions in which online testing works better or worse last but not least how do differences between offline in person language assessments

and online remote assessments affect the results of testing the current topic has two main foci the first deals with the assessment of conversational discourse in general and narrative discourse in particular in both children and young adults communicative competence at the discourse level has been considered an essential and ecologically valid component in language assessments of children and adults for three key reasons 1 this competence is crucial for an individual s everyday functioning and academic and social life 2 it provides information about an individual s socio cognitive and linguistic abilities and 3 it is a versatile test of language skills at the levels of content form use and their integration the second focus is on comparing the results elicited via in person assessments and remote online assessments this research topic welcomes empirical articles discussing new evidence perspective and opinion papers on issues at the conceptual methodological interface and methods articles presenting approaches that can offer opportunities for remote testing of developmental discourse supported by recent technological advances potential themes may include but are not limited to comparisons of remote versus in person testing modes using a within participants research design learner variables such as age gender language status monolingual multilingual and clinical status typically developing children and adults children and adults with clinical conditions such as developmental language disorder autism spectrum disorder which may affect the efficacy of remote testing linguistic variables such as the use of referential and relational devices and mental state language which may be subject to more variations when being assessed remotely new methods that offer opportunities for the remote testing of developmental and adult discourse supported by recent technological advances articles addressing the same research question within developmental narrative discourse but using different i e either online or offline research methods
