cause or be associated with dysphagia such as prematurity velopharyngeal insufficiency ankyloglossia laryngeal clefts laryngomalacia vocal fold paralysis and cricopharyngeal dysfunction the text goes on to explore the pathophysiology and treatment options for each anatomic inflammatory and neuromuscular esophageal causes of dysphagia are also evaluated in addition it delves into the impact of craniofacial anomalies sialorrhea and psychological factors on swallowing finally it discusses how a multidisciplinary aerodigestive team can help streamline multidisciplinary care for individual patients it will incorporate information pertinent to the different roles tools and views of a multidisciplinary dysphagia team including how pediatric otolaryngologists gastroenterologists pulmonologists speech language pathologists occupational therapists and dieticians can collaborate to provide optimal evaluation and care of these often challenging patients especially for those who are at high risk of complications related to aspiration
