while the 1960s may have been a decade of significant upheaval in america it was also one of the richest periods in musical theatre history shows produced on broadway during this time include such classics as bye bye birdie cabaret camelot hello dolly fiddler on the roof how to succeed in business without really trying oliver and man of la mancha performers such as dick van dyke anthony newley jerry orbach and barbara streisand made their marks and other talents such as bob fosse john kander fred ebb alan jay lerner frederick loewe jerome robbins and stephen sondheim also contributed to shows in the complete book of 1960s broadway musicals dan dietz examines every musical and revue that opened on broadway during the 1960s in addition to providing details on every hit and flop dietz includes revivals and one man and one woman shows that centered on stars like jack benny maurice chevalier marlene dietrich danny kaye yves montand and lena horne each entry consists of opening and closing datesplot summariescast membersnumber of performancesnames of all important personnel including writers composers

directors choreographers producers and musical directors musical numbers and the names of performers who introduced the songs production data including information about tryouts source material critical commentary tony awards and nominations details about london and other foreign productions in addition to entries for each production the book offers numerous appendixes a discography film and television versions published scripts gilbert and sullivan operettas and lists of productions by the new york city center light opera company the new york city opera company and the music theatre of lincoln center a treasure trove of information this significant resource will be of use to scholars historians and casual fans of one of the greatest decades in musical theatre history

on april 15 1941 sarajevo fell to germany s 16th motorized infantry division the city along with the rest of bosnia was incorporated into the independent state of croatia one of the most brutal of nazi satellite states run by the ultranationalist croat ustasha regime the occupation posed an extraordinary set of challenges to sarajevo s famously cosmopolitan culture and its civic consciousness these challenges included humanitarian and political crises and tensions of national identity as detailed for the first time in emily greble s book the city s complex mosaic of confessions catholic orthodox muslim jewish and ethnicities croat serb jew bosnian muslim roma and various other national minorities began to fracture under the ustasha regime s violent assault on serbs jews and roma contested categories of identity in this multiconfessional space tearing at the city s most basic traditions nor was there unanimity within the various ethnic and confessional groups some catholic croats detested the ustasha regime while others rode to power within it muslims quarreled about how best to position themselves for the postwar world and some cast their lot with hitler and joined the ill fated muslim waffen ss in time these centripetal forces were complicated by the yugoslav civil war a multisided civil conflict fought among communist partisans chetniks serb nationalists ustashas and a host of other smaller groups the absence of military conflict in sarajevo allows greble to explore the different sides of civil conflict

shedding light on the ways that humanitarian crises contributed to civil tensions and the ways that marginalized groups sought political power within the shifting political system there is much drama in these pages in the late days of the war the ustasha leaders realizing that their game was up turned the city into a slaughterhouse before fleeing abroad the arrival of the communist partisans in april 1945 ushered in a new revolutionary era one met with caution by the townspeople greble tells this complex story with remarkable clarity throughout she emphasizes the measures that the city s leaders took to preserve against staggering odds the cultural and religious pluralism that had long enabled the city s diverse populations to thrive together

atlantic childhoods in global contexts explores childhood and youth in the global south the term childhood often conjures images of innocence vulnerability and the need for protection but this book suggests that in colonial contexts these images need to be re examined in fact as the articles in this collection demonstrate deviance culpability and a presumed autonomy were the more popular notions of childhood in the colonial context these notions were held by the various actors in the colonial drama not only colonial officials but interestingly enough often by the colonized people themselves furthermore traditional notions of childhood as a period of total dependency are challenged in this collection as the various authors explore the ways in which children were pro active agents who shaped notions of childhood and therefore our understanding of the history of childhood this collection provides in depth analysis and offers new perspectives on how children were imagined and constructed both legally and informally in the colonial context the contributions cover a broad geographic range that spans the caribbean latin america africa and india each of the authors explore the ways in which the interplay of atlantic and global influences shaped young people s experiences as well as the discourses that were used to articulate concerns about youth the themes explored in this collection include the pathologization of childhood juvenile delinquency cultural creativity and the use of child labour the book ends with an interview by sara austin of world vision canada who discusses the ways in which the un convention on the rights of the child

neglected to include the voices of children until 2014 this book was originally published as a special issue of atlantic studies

the first book of its kind with comprehensive up to date details historic sites along the mall such as the u s capitol building the white house and the lincoln memorial are explored from an entirely new perspective in this book with never before told stories and statistics about the role of blacks in their creation this is an iconoclastic guide to washington d c in that it shines a light on the african americans who have not traditionally been properly credited for actually building important landmarks in the city new research by a top washington journalist brings this information together in a powerful retelling of an important part of our country s history in addition the book includes sections devoted to specific monuments such as the african american civil war memorial the real uncle tom s cabin the benjamin banneker overlook and frederick douglass museum the hall of fame for caring americans and other existing statues memorials and monuments it also details the many other places being planned right now to house for the first time rich collections of black american history that have not previously been accessible to the public such as the soon to open smithsonian institution national museum of african american history and culture and the martin luther king jr national monument as well as others opening over the next decade this book will be a source of pride for african americans who live in or come from the d c maryland and virginia area as well as for the 18 million annual african american visitors to our nation s capital jesse j holland is a political journalist who lives in the capitol hill neighborhood of washington d c he is the congressional legal affairs correspondent for the associated press and his stories frequently appear in the new york times and other major papers in 2004 holland became the first african american elected to congressional standing committee of correspondents which represents the entire press corps before the senate and the house of representatives a graduate of the university of mississippi he is a frequent lecturer at universities and media talk shows across the country

this book the first collection of its kind collates work from numerous philosophers of language on a diverse range of topics that arise in online conversation

cullman county was established in 1877 in large part from the west side of blount and the east side of winston counties today the few old cemeteries which existed in those counties in the early days are found within the borders of cullman the cemetery listings in this four volume set were conducted by the author beginning in 2003 and ending in early 2006 an attempt was made to personally visit every cemetery in cullman county and record information from each readable monument volume 4 of this series covers alphabetically cemeteries m through z beginning with the mt zion united methodist church cemetery and concluding with the zion grove cemetery the volumes are filled with photos of many of the old cemetery sites and notes describing the company and unit of most of the old civil war era veterans this set of books is vital to any serious student of cullman county genealogy and history

despite an often unfair reputation as being less popular less successful or less refined than their bona fide broadway counterparts off broadway musicals deserve their share of critical acclaim and study a number of shows originally staged off broadway have gone on to their own successful broadway runs from the ever popular a chorus line and rent to more off beat

productions like avenue q and little shop of horrors and while it remains to be seen if other popular off broadway shows like stomp blue man group and altar boyz will make it to the larger broadway theaters their off broadway runs have been enormously successful in their own right this book discusses more than 1 800 off broadway off off broadway showcase and workshop musical productions it includes detailed descriptions of off broadway musicals that closed in previews or in rehearsal selected musicals that opened in brooklyn and in new jersey and american operas that opened in new york along with general overviews of off broadway institutions such as the light opera of manhattan the typical entry includes the name of the host theater or theaters the opening date and number of performances the production s cast and creative team a list of songs a brief plot synopsis and general comments and reviews from the new york critics besides the individual entries the book also includes a preface a bibliography and 21 appendices including a discography filmography a list of published scripts and lists of musicals categorized by topic and composer
