the frontier s call is a comprehensive exploration of the american frontier and its lasting impact on the nation s history culture and identity this book takes a multifaceted approach to understanding the frontier experience examining the motivations that drove people to leave their established homes and embark on perilous journeys into the unknown it explores the interactions between settlers and native american tribes the conflicts and alliances that shaped their relationships it delves into the economic social and political forces that fueled westward expansion and the impact it had on the environment and the land itself through vivid accounts and historical analysis the frontier s call brings to life the trials and triumphs of those who lived on the frontier it sheds light on their struggles to establish a foothold in a harsh and unforgiving land their efforts to build communities and institutions and their determination to forge a new life for themselves and their descendants the book explores the legacy of the frontier which extends far beyond the physical boundaries of the past the frontier experience shaped american values laws and national identity by understanding the history and significance of the frontier we gain a deeper appreciation for the sacrifices and contributions of those who went before us and we can better understand the challenges and opportunities that continue to shape our nation today the frontier s call is essential reading for anyone interested in american history culture or the enduring legacy of the frontier it is a valuable resource for students scholars and general readers alike if you like this book write a review

the skill with which slater combines various levels and modalities of narrative utilizing her personal experience as a colorful unifying thread is truly remarkable antonio candido author of antonio candido on literature and society howard s becker editor a very important book that quite gracefully elegantly and persuasively moves beyond the usual myth and history format to put at its center stories about the amazon and the people who tell them entangled edens persuasively

argues that the amazon can only be grasped understood and come to terms with through its myths and stories it addresses a very real failing of modern environmentalism which for all its virtues tends to dehumanize and metaphorically depopulate when it does not villainize populations that do share its concerns or share them in very different ways instead of forcing us to choose between land and people slater uses the stories and the people who tell them to rethink human relations with nature and each other richard white author of the organic machine the remaking of the columbia river elegant erudite profoundly serious entangled edens is a source of inspiration and knowledge for the reader interested in the amazon without the cultural tradition and the life experience of amazonia s people any analysis of the amazon risks becoming inconsequential or opportunistic this is one of the powerful messages of this important reflection on the amazon whose greatest riches are ultimately its people candace slater has written a book that will last milton hatoum author of the tree of the seventh heaven 1994 and the brothers 2002

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human security is a key element in the measure of well being and a hot topic in anthropology and development studies a world of insecurity outlines a new approach to the subject the contributors expose a contradiction at the heart of conventional accounts of what constitutes human security namely that without taking non material considerations such as religion ethnicity and gender into account discussions of human security academically and in practical terms are incomplete inconclusive and deeply flawed a variety of compelling case studies indicate that in fact material security alone cannot adequately explain or fully account for human activity in a range of different settings and exposed to a variety of different threats this forceful book will expand and deepen the entire concept of human security in the process endowing it with political relevance it is an essential read for students of development studies and anthropology

first published in 1998 this volume uses guyana as an excellent comprehensive case study to examine various sectors operations effects upon the environment and the ways in which the sector can impact upon the vitality and development potential of other sectors the authors attempt to demonstrate how it is possible to adjust current sectoral activities for improved resource utilisation they begin in the interior looking at mining and forest resource exploitation attention then moves towards the coast looking at agriculture fishing human settlement and service provision a review of industry transport and energy follows before examining biodiversity tourism and the amerindian community finally a detailed

analysis is presented of the challenges to be faced in devising a sustainable development national strategy

based on an ethnographic account of subsistence use of amazonian forests by wapishana people in guyana edges frontiers fringes examines the social cultural and behavioral bases for sustainability and resilience in indigenous resource use developing an original framework for holistic analysis it demonstrates that flexible interplay among multiple modes of environmental understanding and decision making allows the wapishana to navigate socio ecological complexity successfully in ways that reconcile short term material needs with long term maintenance and enhancement of the resource base

this book explores the impact of resource extraction and the dynamics of great powers competing for natural resources in the caribbean the book analyzes labour capital relations between china the united states the european union and russia in the caribbean as competition increases with the arrival of non traditional sources of foreign investments in infrastructure from the east chapters assess these dynamics through varying historical and current forms of worker community and organization resistance in the caribbean s extractive industries from the 1970s to the present in doing so the book critically analyzes the interplay of extractive capital with labour unions community organizations management and the state particularly regarding the struggle for higher wages improved working conditions and the broader issues of extractive capitalism and underdevelopment dispossession social exclusion and environmental degradation the first book on extractivism and labour in the caribbean and a major contribution to critical development studies literature it will appeal to policymakers as well as students and scholars in the fields of development studies development economics sociology politics and international relations

what has it meant to be a man in canada alexander ross fur trader percy nobbs architect fisherman fencer andy paull residential school survivor and athlete yves charbonneau jazz musician and commune member james black and gay in postwar windsor who were these men and how did they identify as masculine populated with figures both well known and unknown making men making history frames masculinity as a socially and historically constructed category of identity susceptible to variation across time place and social context this examination of historical canadian masculinities reveals the dissonance between hegemonic ideals of manhood and masculinity and the everyday lives of men and boys the volume showcases some of the best new work in masculinity studies with an introduction that contextualizes the international origins of the field making men making history is the first book to explore these themes entirely in canadian historica settings

the idea that the caribbean could be devolving downward in wealth function and sovereignty has become a recurrent theme in both academic and popular literature by focusing on some of the current issues facing caribbean nation states the editors and contributors to this volume hope to inform and contribute to the ongoing debate on the broad themes of sovereignty and development and the prospects for survival of caribbean nation states in a globalised world while some of the papers seek to describe and analyse the range and complexity of the challenge to national sovereignty and public policy autonomy others focus on issues relating to small country size gender and ethnic tensions security constitutional

this landmark monograph in ethnoecology is now available in print format for the first time based on long term fieldwork in guyana during 1998 1999 and 2000 it examines relationships between the ecological knowledge of wapishana hunters and equivalent areas of ecological science it places this in the ethnographic context of wapishana settlement subsistence and symbolism and the wider context of the political ecology of guyanas economic liberalisation and the consequent exposure of the indigenous peoples of guyanas rupununi region to extractive industries and international conservation interests for the first time the result is a robust argument grounded in extensive data and analysis for alternative trajectories in conservation and international development rooted in the skills knowledge and interests of indigenous users and custodians of biodiversity

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
