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the fully revised second edition of this textbook offers a comprehensive introduction to theories of public policy and policymaking the policy process is complex it contains hundreds of people and organisations from various levels and types of government from agencies quasi and non governmental organisations interest groups and the private and voluntary sectors this book sets out the major concepts and theories that are vital for making sense of the complexity of public policy and explores how to combine their insights when seeking to explain the policy process while a wide range of topics are covered from multi level governance and punctuated equilibrium theory to multiple streams analysis and feminist institutionalism this engaging text draws out the common themes among the variety of studies considered and tackles three key questions what is the story of each theory or multiple theories what does policy theory tell us about issues like evidence based policymaking and how universal are

public policy is a broad and interdisciplinary area of study and research in the field tends to reflect this yet for those teaching and studying public policy the disjointed nature of the field can be confusing and cumbersome this text provides a consistent and coherent framework for uniting the field of public policy authors kevin b smith and christopher w larimer offer an organized and comprehensive overview of the core questions and concepts major theoretical frameworks primary methodological approaches and key controversies and debates in each subfield of policy studies from the policy process and policy analysis to program evaluation and policy implementation the third edition contains the latest scholarship and approaches in the field including new and expanded coverage of behavior economics the narrative policy framework implementation studies the policy regime approach and field experiments now with an appendix of sample comprehensive exam questions the public policy theory primer remains an indispensable text for the systematic study of public policy

this book questions the way policy making has been distanced from politics in prevailing theories of the policy process and highlights the frequently overlooked ubiquity of values and values conflicts in politics and policy it examines the strengths and weaknesses of current theories reviews the illusions of rationalism in politics and explores the way values are implicated throughout the democratic process from voter choice to policy decisions it argues that our understanding of public policy is enhanced by recognizing its intrinsically political and value laden nature

public policy issues directly and indirectly affect many everyday aspects of the lives of all americans yet most of us don t fully understand how policy evolves why do public policies exist what different types of policies are there and how controversial have they become over time how can we better understand the continuity and change in public policies expanding upon the first and second editions the author uses theoretical and historical approaches to answer these questions and highlight changes that have occurred with public policies over the past decade he explains the complex relationship of political and social theories that explain the modifications and restructuring of public policies that exist today through his engaging writing style wilson examines a variety of controversial issues and legal cases to deconstruct each aspect of public policy his explanations provide detailed information in clear comfortable language that encourages the reader to better understand and appreciate policies and theories a list of referenced websites after each chapter allows for exploration outside of the text for up to date information on the ever changing world of public policy

the text condenses early chapters on theory and the policy making process allowing students to take up key policy challenges such as immigration education and health care much earlier in the semester structured chapter layouts of substantive policy areas allow instructors to supplement with their own examples seamlessly the book's emphasis on policy choices asks students to look beyond simple pros and cons to examine the multifaceted dimensions of decision making and the complexities inherent in real world problem solving not every student starts out engaged in public policy so place your students both majors and non majors alike in the driver's seat by fostering their analytical skills early and spend the rest of the semester discussing policy issues examining data and debating current policy examples that matter most to them

this book considers a range of contemporary approaches to public policy studies these approaches are based on a number of theoretical perspectives on decision making as well as alternative perspectives on policy instruments and implementation the range of approaches covered in the volume includes punctuated equilibrium models the advocacy coalition framework multiple streams approaches institutional analyses constructivist approaches behavioural models and the use of instruments as an approach to public policy the volume concludes with a discussion of fundamental issues of democracy in public policy

an analysis of presidential vetoes from fdr to jimmy carter which clarifies the problems caused by the veto and reveals how it has shaped public policy watson concludes that the veto power has operated well both in terms of public policy and relations between congress and the president and argues that it would be a mistake to alter it through the adoption of an item veto

a reference tool divided into three sections which correspond to the types of conclusions possible regarding the relationship between political theory and political analysis complementary integral and mutually exclusive

this textbook presents an up to date introduction to policy studies and provides the theory and practice of public policy interdisciplinary and comparative in scope it covers agenda formation and problem definition policy making implementation and evaluation
