this title was first published in 2001 this wide ranging and comprehensive collection investigates the background to environmental economic development over the last thirty years and the political implications of new directions resulting from technological and cultural changes in environmental issues it examines the application of economic analysis to environmental problems in the past and solutions to the current issues of water soil air energy waste and urban ecology discussing the implications of political decisions cultural changes and technological constraints it will prove a stimulating resource for students academics researchers and policy makers alike

the articles of these proceedings arise from a nsf cbms regional conference on the mathematical modeling of the hearing process that was held at rensselaer polytechnic institute in the summer of 1980 to put the articles in perspective it is best to briefly review the history of such modeling it has proceeded more or less in three stages the first was initiated by herman helmholtz in the 1880 s whose theories dominated the subject for years however because of his lack of accurate experimental data and his heuristic arguments it became apparent that his models needed revision accordingly based on the experimental observations of von bekésy the long wave theories were developed in the 1950 s by investigators such as zwislocki peterson and bogert however as the experiments became more refined such as rhode s wssbauer measurements even these models came into question this has brought on a flurry of activity in recent years into how to extend the models to account for these more recent experimental observations one approach is through a device commonly referred to as a second filter see allen s article and another is through a more elaborate hydroelastic model see chadwick s article in conjunction with this latter approach there has been some recent work on developing a low frequency model of the cochlea see holmes article

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we live in an era of human dominated ecosystems in which the demand for environmental governance is rising rapidly at the same time confidence in the capacity of governments to meet this demand is waning how can we address the resultant governance deficit and achieve sustainable development this book brings together perspectives from economics management and political science in order to identify innovative approaches to governance and bring them to bear on environmental issues the authors analysis of important cases demonstrates how governance systems need to fit their specific setting and how effective policies can be developed without relying exclusively on government they argue that the future of environmental policies lies in coordinated systems that simultaneously engage actors located in the public sector the private sector and civil society governance for the environment draws attention to cutting edge questions for practitioners and analysts interested in environmental governance

it is increasingly common for businesses to face public policies and government regulation that demand some form of environmental or social protection these protective public policies have grown in number complexity and stringency over the last few decades not only in industrialized countries but also in the developing world in this 2010 book jorge rivera presents a theoretical framework for understanding the relationship between protective public policies and business compliance this framework explains different levels of business compliance in terms of three different factors the link between the stages of protective public policies and different levels of business resistance the effect of country context and the effect of firm level characteristics the second part of the book supports and elaborates on this framework by presenting empirical studies that examine two voluntary environmental programs the us ski industry s sustainable slopes program and the certification for sustainable tourism in costa rica

in managing a business entrepreneurs are required to maintain good company performance however various conditions experienced by their company sometimes hinder them from achieving the desired performance the difference between the decision making function i e the agent manager and the risk taking function i e the owners of the company may lead to a conflict between the agent and the owner in the agency perspective there is an inherent conflict of interest attached to the relationship between the agent manager and the owner of the company this conflict can manifest in managerial decisions such as defining the ownership structure in the company formulating the decisions about business diversification and determining the company size consequently a number of mechanisms are needed to reduce agency conflicts in order that the company s financial performance can be well maintained in the real world many large profit organizations and non profit organizations including higher education institutions have been successful in their fields but have experienced significant shocks the main cause of which is the conflict between the owner and the agent manager considering the number of cases where the company performance was damaged due to the agency conflict is the reason motivating the author to write this book the contents of the book are derived from reading the research reports on the relevant topic and the authors own research reports

since the early 1990s voluntary programs have played an increasingly prominent role in environmental management in the u s and other industrialized countries programs have attempted to address problems ranging from climate change and energy efficiency to more localized air and water pollution problems but do they work despite a growing theoretical literature there is limited empirical evidence on their success or the situations most conducive to the approaches even less is known about their cost effectiveness getting credible answers is important research to date has been largely limited to individual programs this innovative book seeks to clarify what is known by looking at a range of program types including different approaches adopted in different nations the focus is on assessing actual performance via seven case studies including the u s climate wise program the u s epa s 33 50 program on toxic chemicals the u k climate change agreements and the keidanren voluntary action plan in japan the central goals of reality check are understanding outcomes and more specifically the relationship between outcomes and design by including in depth analyses by experts from the u s europe and japan the book advances scholarship and provides practical information for the future design of voluntary programs to stakeholders and policymakers on all sides of the atlantic and pacific
