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conceiving of christianity as a worldview has been one of the most significant events in the church in the last 150 years in this new book david naugle provides the best discussion yet of the history and contemporary use of worldview as a totalizing approach to faith and life this informative volume first locates the origin of worldview in the writings of immanuel kant and surveys the rapid proliferation of its use throughout the english speaking world naugle then provides the first study ever undertaken of the insights of major western philosophers on the subject of worldview and offers an original examination of the role this concept has played in the natural and social sciences finally naugle gives the concept biblical and theological grounding exploring the unique ways that worldview has been used in the evangelical orthodox and catholic traditions this clear presentation of the concept of worldview will be valuable to a wide range of readers

this book explores how early christian intellectuals expressed their understanding of the cosmos it reviews the role of women documentation of the vitality and influence of jewish intellectual thought and the continuing impact of greek intellectual thought during christianity s formative years

the church today can be divided into two different understandings of the kingdom of god the first group views the kingdom of god as mystical invisible and heavenly these christians assert that jesus is lord of all but his kingdom does not make a difference

what did medieval authors know about their world were they parochial and focused on just their monastery town or kingdom or were they aware of the broader medieval europe that modern historians write about this collection brings the focus back to medieval authors to see how they described their world while we see that each author certainly had their own biases the vast majority of them did not view the world as constrained to their small piece of it instead they talked about the wider world and often they had informants or textual sources that informed them about the world even if they did not visit it themselves this volume shows that they also used similar ideas to create space and identity whether talking about the desert the holy land or food practices in their texts by examining medieval authors and their own perceptions of their world this collection offers a framework for discussions of medieval europe in the twenty first century

there is an increasing recognition today that young people need to have knowledge about religions and world views in order to live and work in diverse societies what kind of maps are they provided with through religious values and ethics education does education address the challenging existential questions that children and adolescents ask about life and the world this volume addresses different aspects of how existential questions have been dealt with in educational research it especially draws attention to the swedish research tradition of focusing on life questions and the interpretation of life in education but with contemporary international research added it also addresses issues of ethics education and discusses possible options for the future of existential questions as a resource for education

of the white world order of power in the 21st century since 2004 deconstruction of the oeuvre of frantz fanon michel foucault derek walcott the discourse of massa of african enslavement in the caribbean and the thought of xi jinping for the new era have been published which has changed the nature of the road map today versus that of 2004 an extensive revision of the text of 2004 was now necessary which focuses on the the nature of hallucinatory whiteness that afflicts non white peoples under the hegemony of massa white world order of power thereby rendering them incapable of liberating themselves at the level of the idea the need now was to uncover hallucinatory whiteness as it constitutes human action and how the nature of this action is the product of hallucinatory whiteness hence it reinforces white hegemony over the non white person at the level of the idea to this end a deconstruction of the writings of toussaint l ouverture of the haitian revolution george jackson of the african revolution of amerikkka and skin bleaching in the caribbean in the 21st century are presented as case studies illustrating potentially the debilitating power hallucinatory whiteness wields over the mind of non white persons who insist they are champions of liberation which drives the resilience of massa hegemony over non white peoples of the world

process thought is an important component of contemporary philosophy alfred north whitehead s organic philosophy has a special place in the landscape of process thinking being detailed precise and well thought and at the same time extremely visionary and far reaching the global community of process thinkers includes physicists biologists doctors political scientists educators activists philosophers theologians and other people devoted to rethinking their disciplines in the light of process philosophy this volume presents the cutting edge in the creation of a process worldview leading scholars from all over the world gathered to discuss how process thinking can inspire us to rethink our lives precise philosophical language and a unifying vision are applied to core issues such as politics society education and religion the book represents a bold move from academic philosophy into the realm of actual human lives

this book an edited compilation of twenty nine essays focuses on the difference s that a christian worldview makes for the disciplines or subject areas normally taught in liberal arts colleges and universities three initial chapters of introductory material are followed by twenty six essays each dealing with the essential elements or issues in the academic discipline involved these individual essays on each discipline are a unique element of this book these essays also treat some of the specific differences in perspective or procedure that a biblically informed christian perspective brings to each discipline christian worldview and the academic disciplines is intended principally as an introductory textbook in christian worldview courses for christian college or university students this volume will also be of interest to christian students in secular post secondary institutions who may be encountering challenges to their faith both implicit and explicit from peers or professors who assume that holding a strong christian faith and pursuing a rigorous college or university education are essentially incompatible this book should also be helpful for college and university professors who embrace the christian faith but whose post secondary academic background because of its secular orientation has left them inadequately prepared to intelligently apply the implications of their faith to their particular academic specialty such specialists be they professors or upper level graduate students will find the extensive bibliographies of recent scholarship at the end of the individual chapters particularly helpful

with the loss of many of the world s languages it is important to question what will be lost to humanity with their demise it is frequently argued that a language engenders a worldview but what do we mean by this term attributed to german politician and philologist wilhelm von humboldt 1767 1835 the term has since been adopted by numerous linguists within specialist circles it has become associated with what is known as the sapir whorf hypothesis which suggests that the nature of a language influences the thought of its speakers and that different language patterns yield different patterns of thought underhill s concise and rigorously researched book clarifies the main ideas and proposals of humboldt s linguistic philosophy and demonstrates the way his ideas can be adopted and adapted by thinkers and linguists today a detailed glossary of terms is provided in order to clarify key concepts and to translate the german terms used by humboldt

worldview religious studies brings the study of religion spirituality secularism and other mixed attitudes of life under the overarching scheme of worldview studies this book introduces and defines worldviews more generally before establishing a framework specific to religious studies the drive for meaning making is explored through ritual symbolic activities ideas of play and the power of emotions to transform simple ideas into values and beliefs that frame identity and signpost destiny identity and its sacralisation are discussed alongside gift reciprocity theory in their relation to ideas of merit karma and salvation in eastern and western traditions this theoretical background is used to introduce a new classification of worldviews natural scientific ancestral karmic prophetic sectarian mystical and ideological organised thematically by chapter this book brings together familiar and unfamiliar authors theories and sources to challenge students and teachers of religious studies theology and ethics it introduces worldview religious studies as a framework through which to re think human endeavours to identify cope and even transcend life s flaws and perils

in this book the author explores the shifting philosophical boundaries of modern medical knowledge and practice occasioned by the crisis of quality of care especially in terms of the various humanistic adjustments to the biomedical model to that end he examines the metaphysical epistemological and ethical boundaries of these medical models he begins with their metaphysics analyzing the metaphysical positions and presuppositions and ontological commitments upon which medical knowledge and practice is founded next he considers the epistemological issues that face these medical models particularly those driven by methodological procedures undertaken by epistemic agents to constitute medical knowledge and practice finally he examines the axiological boundaries and the ethical implications of each model especially in terms of the physician patient relationship in a concluding epilogue he discusses how the philosophical analysis of the humanization of modern medicine helps to address the crisis of care as well as the question of what is medicine the book s unique features include a comprehensive coverage of the various topics in the philosophy of medicine that have emerged over the past several decades and a philosophical context for embedding bioethical discussions the book s target audiences include both undergraduate and graduate students as well as healthcare professionals and professional philosophers this book is the 99th issue of the series philosophy and medicine and it can be considered a crown of thirty years of intensive and dynamic discussion in the field we are completely convinced that after its publication it can be finally said that undoubtedly the philosophy of medicine exists as a special field of inquiry

darwin s theory of evolution by natural selection is considered in its application to human beings in this book brian baxter examines the various sociobiological approaches to the explanation of human behaviour which view the human brain and so the human mind as the product of evolution and considers the main arguments for and against this claim in so doing he defends the approaches against some common criticisms such as the charge that they are reductionist and dehumanising the implications of these arguments for the social sciences and humanities are assessed as is the naturalistic view of ethics to which they lead a key issue examined in the book is the connection between this darwinist perspective on human beings and modern environmental ethics which also often assume that human beings are part of an evolved living world the implications of these positions for the meaningfulness of human life are also examined throughout the discussion the positions in sociobiology and environmental ethics developed by edward o wilson are taken as an exemplar of the characteristic features of a darwinian worldview and the arguments of wilson and his chief critics are thoroughly examined
