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new edition of bestselling introductory text outlining the history and ways of reading gothic literature this revised edition includes a new chapter on contemporary gothic which explores the gothic of the early twenty first century and looks at new critical developments an updated bibliography of critical sources and a revised chronology the book opens with a chronology and an introduction to the principal texts and key critical terms followed by five chapters the gothic heyday 1760 1820 gothic 1820 1865 gothic proximities 1865 1900 twentieth century and contemporary gothic the discussion examines how the gothic has developed in different national contexts and in different forms including novels novellas poems films radio and television each chapter concludes with a close reading of a specific text frankenstein jane eyre dracula the silence of the lambs and the historian to illustrate ways in which contextual discussion informs critical analysis the book ends with a conclusion outlining possible future developments within scholarship on the gothic

while the numinous and heavily psychological aspects of the gothic have received serious attention

studies do not tend to examine the relation of the gothic supernatural to the very different backgrounds of 18th century and victorian belief this study examines the rise of the form the artistic difficulties experienced by its early practitioners and the transformation of the original problem ridden gothic works into the successful victorian tales of unearthly terror in doing so this study makes a distinct contribution to our grasp of the gothic and of the links between literature and religion

carol a senf traces the vampire s evolution from folklore to twentieth century popular culture and explains why this creature became such an important metaphor in victorian england this bloodsucker who had stalked the folklore of almost every culture became the property of serious artists and thinkers in victorian england including charlotte and emily brontë george eliot charles dickens karl marx and friedrich engels people who did not believe in the existence of vampires nonetheless saw numerous metaphoric possibilities in a creature from the past that exerted pressure on the present and was often threatening because of its sexuality

this book contributes to an emerging field of study and provides new perspectives on the ways in which gothic literature visual media and other cultural forms explicitly engage gender sexuality form and genre the collection is a forum in which the ideas of several well respected critics converge producing a breadth of knowledge and a diversity of subject areas and methodologies it is concerned with several questions including how can we discuss gothic as a genre that crosses over boundaries constructed by a culture to define and contain gender and sexuality how do transgender bodies specifically mark or disrupt this boundary crossing in what ways does the gothic open up a plural narrative space for transgenre explorations encounters and experimentation with this the volume s chapters explore expected categories such as transgenders transbodies and transembodiments but also broader concepts that move through and beyond the limits of gender identity and sexuality such as transhistories transpolitics transmodalities and transgenres illuminating such areas as the appropriation of the trans body in gothic literature and film the function of trans rhetorics in memoir textual markers of transgenderism and the gothic s transgeneric qualities the chapters offer innovative but not limited ways

to interpret the gothic in addition the book intersects with but also troubles non trans feminist and queer readings of the gothic together these diverse approaches engage the gothic as a definitively trans subject and offer new and exciting connections and insights into gothic media film narrative and gender and sexuality studies

this innovative book explores the role played by clothing in the discourses of the gothic it makes an explicit connection between the veils masks and disguises of gothic convention and historically specific fashion discourses from the revealing chemise dress popularized by queen marie antoinette to the subcultural style of contemporary goths in so doing it sheds new light on the cultural construction of gothic bodies taking an original interdisciplinary approach catherine spooner offers readings of literary cinematic and popular cultural texts in the context of fashion from the 1790s to the 1990s progressing chronologically from the novels of radcliffe and lewis through the sensation fiction of the victorian period and the gothic fiction of the fin de siècle fashioning gothic bodies culminates with twentieth century film and the supposed resurgence of the gothic in pre millennial culture

by highlighting features common to the gothic classics and the works of adelaïda garcía morales this monograph aims to put the gothic on the map in hispanic studies the gothic as a literary mode extending well beyond its first proponents in eighteenth century england is well established in english studies but has been strangely under used by hispanists now abigail lee six uses it as the paradigm through which to analyse the novels of adelaïda garcía morales while not suggesting that every novel by this author is a classic gothic text she reveals certain constants in the work that can be related to the gothic even in novels which one might not classify as such each of the novels studied is paired with an english language gothic text such as dracula frankenstein and dr jekyll and mr hyde and then read in the light of it the focus of each chapter ranges from psychological aspects such as fear of decay or otherness or the pressures linked to managing secrets to more concrete elements such as mountains and frightening buildings and to key figures such as vampires ghosts or monsters this approach sheds new light on how garcía morales achieves probably the most distinguishing feature of her novels their harrowing atmosphere abigail lee six is professor of hispanic studies at royal holloway university of london

in this ground breaking study saggini explores the relationship between the late eighteenth century novel and the theatre arguing that the implicit theatricality of the gothic novel made it an obvious source from which dramatists could take ideas similarly elements of the theatre provided inspiration to novelists

abstract in this paper i will examine the gothic sublime by using the example of horace walpole s novel the castle of otranto i want to examine the features of the gothic sublime what was new and different about it how is this reflected in the novel in order to prove the importance of walpole s work it marks in a certain aspect a turning point in literature since it is regarded the first gothic novel i will argue that the horror as developed in the castle of otranto is not simply based upon the appearance of ghosts and supernatural events but rather a subtle kind of horror firstly an introduction into the gothic novel in general its characteristic features and the examination of the cultural background of english gothic fiction shall give a brief overview over the topic secondly i will

examine the means by which walpole evokes fear in the reader and the effects they had

includes the castle of otranto the first work of the gothic genre vathek the high point of the oriental tale in english literature thevampyre the first full length vampire story in english and lord byron s little known fragment
