lgbtq experience delving deeply into research on a multitude of hot topics including risks experienced by this sometimes targeted population in june of 2015 the united state supreme court issued an opinion that directly impacted the lives of many lgbt americans in obergefell v hodge the court required all states to issue marriage licenses to same sex couples and to recognize same sex marriages performed in other jurisdictions while many activists consider this a major achievement lgbt individuals still face a number of pressing issues in lesbian gay bisexual and transgender americans at risk editor chuck stewart and a carefully selected group of contributors unravel these far reaching concerns the book is a cutting edge resource for academics activists scholars students and lay people who are interested in examining lgbt social and political movements as well as the public policy progress and setbacks of recent years three volumes of essays by experts in a variety of fields delve deeply into primary sources to tackle important topics such as transgender adolescents alcohol and drug abuse and the massacre at pulse gay nightclub along with dozens of others organized by life stages this comprehensive work sheds light on concerns and controversies affecting youth adults and seniors connected to the lgbt community

violence and nonviolence an introduction critiques five dominant societal views about violence and nonviolence using evidence from scientific studies as well as anecdotal evidence and news reports esteemed scholar and editor barry l gan shows readers that these widely adopted and violent views are largely mistaken and require a fundamental rethinking and adjustment by synthesizing new research with old philosophies gan introduces readers to an alternative paradigm of nonviolence through which we can begin to build a more peaceful world nonviolent strategic action a kind of selective nonviolence is the first of the two alternative paradigms that provides a concrete approach to addressing social and political problems arising from violence nonviolence as a way of life is the second of the paradigms that expands upon and in some respects critiques the first preferring a comprehensive and radical response to the scourges of violence that have plagued human history

gay bars have been closing by the hundreds the story goes that increasing mainstream acceptance of lgbtq people plus dating apps like grindr and tinder have rendered these spaces obsolete beyond that rampant gentrification in big cities has pushed gay bars out of the neighborhoods they helped make hip who needs gay bars considers these narratives accepting that the answer for some might be maybe nobody and yet jarred by the closing of his favorite local watering hole in cleveland ohio greggor mattson embarks on a journey across the country to paint a much more complex picture of the cultural significance of these spaces inside big four gay cities but also beyond them no longer the only places for their patrons to socialize openly mattson finds in them instead a continuously evolving symbol a physical place for feeling and challenging the beating pulse of sexual progress from the historical archives of seattle s garden of allah to the outpost bars in texas missouri or florida that serve as community hubs for queer youth these are places of celebration where the next drag superstar from alaska or oklahoma may be discovered they are also fraught grounds for confronting the racial and gender politics within and without the lgbtq community the question that frames this story is not asking whether these spaces are needed but for whom earnestly exploring the diversity of folks and purposes they serve today loosely informed by the damron guide the so called green book of gay travel mattson logged 10 000 miles on the road to all corners of the united states his destinations are sometimes thriving sometimes struggling but all offering intimate views of the wide range of gay experience in america poc white trans cis past present and future

susan gluck mezey s newest book gay families and the courts is a compelling examination of the role of the state and federal courts in furthering the goals of the gay and lesbian community unlike mezey s earlier book queers in court this book evaluates the extent to which litigation is effective in advancing equal rights for gay families families in which at least one member is gay as they seek to expand their opportunities and battle discrimination mezey shows how the courts address gay and lesbian rights and sexual orientation in schools and social organizations such as the boy scouts along with family oriented problems such as marriage and parenthood in doing so mezey emphasizes the complexity of the issues involved in the cases and assesses the degree to which the outcome of the litigation is explained by the type of case the type of court and the judge s perception of his or her role as a policymaker it is a valuable reference for scholars interested in judicial legislative and executive policymaking at the federal and state level as well as anyone interested in lgbt politics

co winner of the 2023 latino a section best book award given by the american sociological association honorable mention 2024 best book award given by the asia and asian america section of the american sociological association the stories of second generation immigrant gay men coming of age in los angeles growing up in the shadow of hollywood the gay sons of immigrants featured in brown and gay in la could not have felt further removed from a world where queerness was accepted and celebrated instead the men profiled here maneuver through family and friendship circles where masculinity dominates gay sexuality is unspoken and heterosexuality is strictly enforced for these men the path to sexual freedom often involves chasing the dreams while resisting the expectations of their immigrant parents and finding community in each other ocampo also details his own story of reconciling his queer filipino american identity and those of men like him he shows what it was like for these young men to grow up gay in an immigrant family to be the one gay person in their school and ethnic community and to be a person of color in predominantly white gay spaces brown and gay in la is an homage to second generation gay men and their radical redefinition of what it means to be gay to be a man to be a person of color and ultimately what it means to be an american

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
