months before alma lópez s digital collage our lady was shown at the museum of international folk art in 2001 the museum began receiving angry phone calls from community activists and catholic leaders who demanded that the image not be displayed protest rallies prayer vigils and death threats ensued but the provocative image of la virgen de guadalupe hands on hips clad only in roses and exalted by a bare breasted butterfly angel remained on exhibition highlighting many of the pivotal questions that have haunted the art world since the nea debacle of 1988 the contributors to our lady of controversy present diverse perspectives ranging from definitions of art to the artist s intention feminism queer theory colonialism and chicano nationalism contributors include the exhibition curator tey marianna nunn award winning novelist and chicana historian emma pérez and deena gonzález recognized as one of the fifty most important living women historians in america accompanied by a bonus dvd of alma lópez s i love lupe video that looks at the chicana artistic tradition of reimagining la virgen de guadalupe featuring a historic conversation between yolanda lópez ester hernández and alma lópez our lady of controversy promises to ignite important new dialogues

this book shows how police and politicians in latin america informally regulate drug markets using corruption and violence

in the past decade unions and community groups have come together around a wide range of campaigns for economic justice from fighting for living wages to electing progressive champions to questioning market oriented economic development to promoting anti sprawl smart growth efforts partnering for change brings together activists and intellectuals on the forefront of these organizing efforts they discuss general patterns of labor community coalitions in terms of alliances between unions and such community players as environmentalists religious groups low income organizations and local employers the contributors also offer a wealth of case studies such as the successful campaign for corporate subsidy accountability in minnesota vermont s livable wage campaign the wisconsin regional training partnership and the model regional power building projects of the south bay afl cio the volume s editor david reynolds combines a broad overview of labor community coalitions practical examples applicable to diverse communities and an appreciation of the challenges as well as the opportunities for building the movement for economic change

this collection of essays is based on the 2005 society for american archaeology symposium and presents research that epitomizes richard i ford s approach of engaged anthropology this transdisciplinary approach integrates archaeological research with perspectives from ethnography history and ecology and engages the anthropologist with native partners and with socio natural landscapes research papers largely focus on the u s southwest but also consider other areas of north america issues related to museums collections and indigenous approaches to materials research

this issue contains fifty years of excavations and researches at arslantepe malatya turkey a contribution to the study of the earliest centralised societies proceedings of the international conference held in rome on 5 7 december 2011 to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the sapienza university expedition at arslantepe the volume is organised in five thematic sections each referring to a topic on which the excavations at arslantepe have obtained results and presenting contributions by both members of the arslantepe team and other scholars working on the same topic in other sites or regions of the near east the objective was to

in 1985 winemaker joe benziger and sonoma artist bob nugent struck on the idea of putting original art on special releases of imagery estate wines the goal was straight forward commission the world s modern art luminaries to create works for reproduction onto wine labels two decades and 160 labels later they have assembled a staggering collection of contemporary art from the likes of sol lewitt terry winters nancy graves john baldessari judy pfaff and bob arneson this book highlights 133 works of art the best of the imagery collection the images are big and lush and accompanied by biographical sketches of the artists careers as well as a short description of their individual ideas and methods the pictorial index shows the works in their label form from 1985 to the most recent vintages these images are evocations of wine s multi faceted ability to inspire us

san marcos one of the largest late prehistoric pueblo settlements along the rio grande was a significant social political and economic hub both before spanish colonization and through the pueblo revolt of 1680 this volume provides the definitive record of a decade of archaeological investigations at san marcos ancestral home to kewa formerly santo domingo and cochiti descendants the contributors address archaeological and historical background artifact analysis and population history they

explore possible changes in pueblo social organization examine population changes during the occupation and delineate aspects of pueblo spanish interaction that occur with spaniards intrusion into the colony and especially the galisteo basin highlights include historical context in depth consideration of archaeological field and laboratory methods compositional and stylistic analyses of the famed glaze paint ceramics analysis of flaked stone that includes obsidian hydration dating and discussion of the beginnings of colonial metallurgy and protohistoric pueblo population change

chaco canyon has one of the most significant concentrations of archaeological remains in north america pueblo bonito the largest and best known of chaco s great houses was largely excavated in the late 1890s and early 1920s but then no extensive excavations were conducted at the site until a team of archaeologists from the university of new mexico began work there in 2004 in exploring the possible evidence of water control features archaeologists recovered some 200 000 artifacts here they use the artifacts and fauna they found to examine the lives and activities of the inhabitants of pueblo bonito as well as to further interpret current models of chaco archaeology the contributors particularly focus on questions regarding crafts production long distance exchange relationships and evidence for feasting and other ritual behavior the results from the 2004 2008 excavations challenge many interpretations related to the daily activities of the pueblo bonito population while supporting others

a master photographer alfred stieglitz was also a visionary promoter and avid collector of modern american and european art from the first half of the 20th century this book is the first fully illustrated catalogue of works in the unparalleled alfred stieglitz collection which was given to the metropolitan museum after stieglitz s death

folk art is as varied as it is indicative of person and place informed by innovation and grounded in cultural context the variety and versatility of 300 american folk artists is captured in this collection of informative and thoroughly engaging essays american folk art a regional reference offers a collection of fascinating essays on the life and work of 300 individual artists some of the men

and women profiled in these two volumes are well known while others are important practitioners who have yet to receive the notice they merit because many of the artists in both categories have a clear identity with their land and culture the work is organized by geographical region and includes an essay on each region to help make connections visible there is also an introductory essay on u s folk art as a whole those writing about folk art to date tend to view each artist as either traditional or innovative one of the major contributions of this work is that it demonstrates that folk artists more often exhibit both traits they are grounded in their cultural context and creative in the way they make work their own such insights expand the study of folk art even as they readjust readers understanding of who folk artists are
