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this refreshing and authoritative book provides readers with a guide to the essential thinking research and concepts in interactionism and explains why the interactionist influence has not been fully acknowledged in Britain

an engaging text that enables readers to understand the world through symbolic interactionism this lively and accessible book offers an introduction to sociological social psychology through the lens of symbolic interactionism it provides students with an accessible understanding of this perspective to illuminate their worlds and deepen their knowledge of other people's lives as well as their own written by noted experts in the field the book explores the core concepts of social psychology and examines a collection of captivating empirical studies the book also highlights everyday life putting the focus on the issues and concerns that are most relevant to the readers social context the social self and everyday life bridges classical theories and contemporary ideas joins abstract concepts with concrete examples and integrates theory with empirical evidence it

covers a range of topics including the body emotions health and illness the family technology and inequality best of all it gets students involved in applying concepts in their daily lives demonstrates how to use students social worlds experiences and concerns to illustrate key interactionist concepts in a way that they can emulate develops key concepts such as meaning self and identity throughout the text to further students understanding and ability to use them introduces students to symbolic interactionism a major theoretical and research tradition within sociology helps to involve students in familiar experiences and issues and shows how a symbolic interactionist perspective illuminates them combines the best features of authoritative summaries clear definitions of key terms with enticing empirical excerpts and attention to popular ideas clear and inviting in its presentation the social self and everyday life understanding the world through symbolic interactionism is an excellent book for undergraduate students in sociology social psychology and social interaction

a companion to qualitative research draws on the work of an array of leading scholars from europe britain and north america to present a summary of every aspect of the qualitative research process from nuts and bolts methods and research styles to examinations of methodological theory and epistemology it is one of the few surveys of qualitative research to adopt a genuinely international voice

this book is a survey of symbolic interaction in thirteen short chapters it traces the history the social philosophical roots the founders movers and shakers and evolution of the theory symbolic interactionism the basics takes the reader along the exciting but tortuous journey of the theory and explores both the meta theoretical and mini theoretical roots and branches of the theory symbolic interactionism or sociological social psychology traces its roots to the works of united states sociologists george hebert mead charles horton cooley and herbert blumer and a canadian sociologist erving goffman other influences are harold garfinkel s ethnomethodology and austrian american alfred schutz s study of phenomenology symbolic interactionism basics explores the philosophical sources of symbolic interactionism including pragmatism social behaviorism and neo hegelianism the intellectual origins of symbolic interactions can be attributed to the works of william james george simmel john dewey max weber and george herbert mead mead is believed to be the founder of the theory although he did not publish any academic work on the paradigm the book highlights the works of the intellectual heirs of symbolic interactionism herbert blumer mead s former student who was instrumental in publishing the lectures his former professor posthumously with the title symbolic interactionism erving goffman and robert park

one of the longest standing traditions in sociology interactionism is concerned with studying human interaction and showing how society to a large part is constituted by patterns of interaction in spite of the work of figures such as robert e park everett c hughes erving goffman herbert blumer norman k denzin and gary alan fine interactionism perhaps owing to its association with the perspective of symbolic interactionism remains something of an odd man out in mainstream sociology this book seeks to rectify this apparent neglect by bringing together critical social theories and microsociological approaches to research thus revealing the critical and cultural potentials in interactionism the chapters arguing that far from being oriented towards the status quo interactionism in fact contains a critical and cultural edge presenting the latest

work from some of the leading figures in interactionist thought to show recent developments in the field and offer an overview of some of the most potent and prominent ideas within critical and cultural criminology critical and cultural interactionism will appeal to scholars of sociology with interests in interactionism social theory research methods and criminology

this new book addresses the topical issues surrounding employment relations in uk voluntary organizations that operate within the quasi market of social care combining an analysis of the established literature with in depth qualitative field work ian cunningham explores the nature of power relations between state and voluntary sector implications of employment policy and subsequent pressures for change in pay and working conditions the influence of trade unions in the sector management's capacity to resist external pressure and employee responses to this environment cunningham's focus on the employment relationship in this sector is unique highlighting a complex and variable pattern of interdependence and subordination between government agencies and voluntary sector employers the author examines the way in which financial pressures from the state coupled with weak unionization diminish working conditions arguing that employee morale will not be sustained if the voluntary sector fails to maintain its autonomy and minimize its dependency on state funding

just what is a picture worth qualitative research is dominated by language however researchers have recently shown a growing interest in adopting an image based approach this is the first volume dedicated to exploring this approach and will prove an invaluable sourcebook for researchers in the field the book covers a broad scope including theory and the research process and provides practical examples of how image based research is applied in the field it discusses use of images in child abuse investigation exploring children's drawings in health education cartoons the media and teachers

narrative inquiry is growing in popularity as a research methodology in the social sciences medicine and the humanities in narrative inquiry the transparency of interactions between researcher and research participants together with rich contextual descriptions help to shape and structure research texts rendering them engaging and readable contextualising narrative inquiry argues that all researchers should foreground the importance of the context in which research takes place and develop methodological approaches that are grounded in their local contexts to do so they need to pay attention to how knowledge is constructed shared and understood in those contexts this is particularly important when contexts have been subjugated historically through colonialism and when local indigenous ways of knowing have been ignored or dismissed the contributors to this edited collection have all used narrative inquiry for a range of topics and in a range of contexts including leadership styles of asian women the deaf community in the uk voluntary celibacy in malta administrators in ghanaian higher education multiculturalism in primary education in cyprus teacher identities in hong kong the reflective practitioner in higher education in malaysia the diversity of the topics illuminates the potential for narrative inquiry to be used to investigate a broad range of issues in many contexts by people with a wide range of backgrounds a common thread throughout is a reflexive discussion of how each contributor used narrative inquiry as a methodological approach highlighting not only its affordances but also the complexities of using it in specific cultural social and historical contexts

the aim of this book is to better understand the phenomenon of hiv in a country that has faced the fullest might of the disease and yet after first faltering has made more progress than any other country in the world in its response to hiv it aims to reflect the complexity of this narrative and the range of widely differing insights by featuring what is likely the largest number of contributors in a single publication on the subject in south africa as well as a full spectrum of specialised areas ranging from high end science to personal reflections

the field of sociology itself and sociological theory by extension is relatively new both date back to the 18th and 19th centuries the drastic social changes of that period such as industrialization urbanization and the rise of democratic states caused particularly western thinkers to become aware of society the oldest sociological theories deal with broad historical processes relating to these changes since then sociological theories have come to encompass most aspects of society including communities organizations and relationships the basic insight of sociology is that human behaviour is largely shaped by the groups to which people belong and by the social interaction that takes place within those groups the main focus of sociology is the group not the individual this compendium offers selections that present special propositions specific concepts or examples of substantive theorizing rather than discussions of integrated systems the present attempt is made to describe the different aspects of sociological theory generally being explained by the social scientists and it is hoped that it will be of great use for all those concerned with sociology
