animals and war is the first collection of essays to explore its important yet neglected topic scholars from sociology history anthropology and literary and cultural studies investigate the presence of animals in human wars the essays analyze a wide range of phenomena including the new militarization of bees zoo animals during war war dogs finish horses in world war ii
