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in the wake of its caliphate declaration in 2014 the self described islamic state has been

the focus of countless academic papers government studies media commentaries and documentaries despite all this attention persistent myths continue to shape and misdirect public understanding and strategic policy decisions a significant factor in this trend has been a strong disinclination to engage critically with islamic state s speeches and writings as if doing so reflects empathy with the movement s goals or even more absurdly may itself lead to radicalisation going beyond the descriptive and the sensationalist this volume presents and analyses a series of milestone islamic state primary source materials scholar practitioners with field experience in confronting the movement explore and contextualise its approach to warfare propaganda and governance examining the factors behind its dramatic evolution from failed proto state in 2010 to standard bearer of global jihadism in 2014 to besieged insurgency in 2018 the isis reader will help anyone students and journalists military personnel civil servants and inquisitive observers to better understand not only the evolution of islamic state and the dynamics of asymmetric warfare but the importance of primary sources in doing so

the rapid rise of the islamic state in iraq and greater syria was almost like a fairy tale a group that was unheard of in early 2013 captured territories as big as great britain by 2014 june effectively erasing the border between iraq and syria it announced a caliphate drew in thousands of fighters and supporters from across the world including india launched attacks in nations from brussels to bangladesh and earned loyalties of local militant groups in conflict ridden states such as nigeria libya afghanistan and pakistan by the end of 2014 isis had transformed itself into a global force of terror isis caliphate tells the story of this phenomenon based on primary sources and interviews the book explores the geopolitical organisational and ideological roots of isis and narrates how the group has spread its wings from its core in iraq and syria to the peripheries of india and pakistan

based almost entirely on primary sources in arabic including ancient religious texts and secret al qaeda and islamic state letters that few have seen william mccants s the isis apocalypse explores how religious fervor strategic calculation and doomsday prophecy shaped the islamic state s past and foreshadow its dark future the islamic state is one of the most lethal and successful jihadist groups in modern history surpassing even al qaeda thousands of its followers have marched across syria and iraq subjugating millions enslaving women beheading captives and daring anyone to stop them thousands more have spread terror beyond the middle east under the islamic state s black flag how did the islamic state attract so many followers and conquer so much land by being more ruthless more apocalyptic and more devoted to state building than its competitors the shrewd leaders of the islamic state combined two of the most powerful yet contradictory ideas in islam the return of the islamic empire and the end of the world into a mission and a

message that shapes its strategy and inspires its army of zealous fighters they have defied conventional thinking about how to wage wars and win recruits even if the islamic state is defeated jihadist terrorism will never be the same

a sober analysis of isis media and propaganda output essential for understanding what drives the movement

the sudden emergence of the islamic state of iraq and greater syria or most commonly known as isis is one of the most profound and alarming phenomenon in the middle east awash in sheer violence on this account there is no doubt that isis is one of the most powerful jihadist groups in the modern world this group brings a very tremendous level of fear not only in the middle east but also on other parts of the world being one of the terrorist insurgent groups in the world the forces of isis have seized total control of mosul the second largest city in iraq the list of isis nightmarish deeds is indeed chilling this includes the brutal persecution of native christian people in iraq and syria the nightmarish genocide against the yazidi people in iraq rape beheadings crucifixions forced conversions and the massive execution of the syrian tribe that failed to resist its conquest

the sudden emergence of the so called islamic state generally referred to as the isis in territories of iraq and syria in 2014 shocked the world with its gruesome acts of extreme violence and brutality its blow to the westphalian system of the nation state and its messianic drive to instigate a global war of apocalyptic proportions with more wealth and fighters than al qaeda the isis has stolen the thunder from every other islamist and jihadist outfit by declaring the territory under its control as the caliphate which has always been the ultimate islamist utopia various international organizations government agencies and media outlets remain baffled to this day over the genesis modus operandi warfare and global outreach behind the isis spectacular success this book seeks to investigate and explore most of these questions and also recommends ways in countering the isis threat both ideologically and militarily

providing up to date information for general readers as well as those well informed about the islamic state this book offers an essential understanding of the rise of isis and its current influence in the middle east as well as worldwide isis also referred to as isil the islamic state or daesh began to assert its power and gain recognition for its militant and terroristic activities in april 2013 after the coordinated attacks in paris on november 13th 2015 isis has captured the full attention of observers in the west this accessible book explains what isis is what the group s goals are what their members believe and why their ranks are growing readers will gain an understanding of how isis is a unique group one

seeking to be the army of the righteous fighting to defeat the unbelievers and usher in the end of days but that the extremist views of isis are an expression of a growing frustration with life in the middle east and elsewhere shared by a larger community of non state and post state actors the book provides an introduction that documents the origins of isis within the larger al qaeda organization during the iraq war the following chapters discuss the origins development and territorial expansion of isis in syria and iraq and examine the ideological motivations behind the emergence of isis thereby enabling a nuanced understanding of the importance of isis in contemporary history other entries discuss individuals events and organizations that put isis in historical context in terms of contemporary events since the iraq war into the present and explain the group s position within the complex conflict currently boiling in the middle east

this unique study pioneers a comparative analysis between two major jihadist entities the taliban and the islamic state focusing on their state building endeavors it highlights the taliban s historical state building efforts in the 1990s as a model for understanding similar initiatives by jihadist groups such as the islamic state departing from existing literature that often examines individual jihadist groups in isolation this study adopts a comparative approach offering unique insights into the broader phenomenon of jihadist groups and their attempts at state making through detailed examinations of the taliban and the islamic state in afghanistan and elsewhere and the impacts of other regional actors the study sheds light on the resurgence of these movements even after apparent decline as witnessed with the resurgence of the taliban the book will be an invaluable reference for researchers scholars politicians and diplomats concerned with the region and with the aspirations of terror groups to engage in state building

this book explores the social and psychological factors behind how isis was able to rise in iraq control most of it and why most of that population eventually turned on it synthesized by some of the foremost experts on terrorism the analysis is based on a unique array of public opinion data from surveys focus groups and interviews

on the 29th of june 2014 isis declared the establishment of a caliphate stretching across territories in iraq and syria in response operation inherent resolve a us led 77 nation coalition was launched to respond to the threat of islamic state the west s war against islamic state offers the first history of operation inherent resolve and the west s war against isis from its inception in 2014 to the fall of raqqa in 2017 andrew mumford offers a comprehensive analysis and assessment of the military campaign deployed against isis in syria and iraq by examining the west s strategic objectives as well as the conflicting interests of rival powers namely russia iran and turkey by examining individual

operational components of this military engagement such as drone usage cyber warfare special forces operations and sponsorship of guerrilla forces this book offers a unique insight into the nature of modern warfare
