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this report presents proposed standards for teaching internship programs the internship standards are intended to be embedded in a state s teacher licensing system the year long paid

internship is simultaneously the last year of formal teacher preparation the first year of supervised teaching and one requirement for the unrestricted teaching license an intern would have to satisfactorily complete the internship before taking the final examination to receive a teaching license the report is intended to provide guidance to teaching standards boards as well as colleges of education school districts and others concerned with improving the practical preparation of teachers the discussion is presented in four sections 1 the case for a supervised teaching internship 2 internships in the licensed professions 3 standards for an internship program and 4 implementing the internship the value of clinical schools the appendices provide examples of evaluation forms an extract from minnesota s vision for teacher education stronger standards new partnerships the code of ethics for minnesota teachers and detailed descriptions of internship programs in four licensed professions engineering psychology architecture and medicine a bibliography completes the volume jd

in practical knowledge in teacher education expert contributors from across asia and europe explore and reflect upon the innovation and creativity in teacher education programs specific focus is given to the internships that provide students an opportunity for intensive hands on experience in schools different approaches to internship provide comprehensive information on a diversity of ways of organising and managing internship programmes within teacher education courses and equip future teachers with real world knowledge within a global context this book focuses on approaches to internship in teacher education programmes in europe and asia it explores the idea that a consideration of the rich variation in approaches and experience across eurasia will foreground critical aspects of successful internship each chapter provides a different focus from asian and european perspectives on aspects of the teacher education practicum or internship and what can be learned from school placement this book is an invaluable resource for all those involved in teacher education educational policy and anyone who has a stake in ensuring effective teacher education for the 21st century it offers a far reaching overview of the teacher internship phase across a number of countries and contributes to identifying distinctive features of teacher education in european and asian universities

internship programs has an underlying theme that such programs can make a serious contribution to the career and professional development needs of teachers and to the quality of instruction chapter 1 considers how employer sponsored teacher internships are connected to educational reform the second chapter discusses the purposes of teacher internships eleven pioneer teacher internship programs are briefly described in chapter 3 many of these programs focus on improving mathematics and science instruction many also place a strong emphasis on communication skills all rely heavily on the leadership and motivation of employers to improve scientific and mathematical understanding and competence in chapter 4 replicability sustainability and expansion of these programs are considered finally chapter 5 discusses new directions and next steps for teacher internships contacts and addresses for the 11 programs are listed in the appendix mns

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
