 officials and policy makers into a governmentality framework it analyses the impact on the daily activities of bureaucrats and ministers the
 book utilises comprehensive and novel empirical material including around 100 interviews with key officials documentary sources and

academic literature it uncovers the kind of negotiations management and coordination triggered by the immense challenge of presiding over the eu including being a part of a trio this text will be of key interest to scholars students of political science european union studies and public administration as well as more broadly to comparative politics and international relations it will also be of interest to officials and policy members in eu member states approaching the presidency

during the last 30 years the japanese political economy system has experienced significant changes that are usually not well understood or analysed because of their complexity and contradictions this book provides new analyses and insights on the process of evolving japanese political economy including japan s current economic policy known as abenomics the first three chapters looks at evolutions at the corporate

level characterised in recent years by increasing firm heterogeneity the authors apply theoretically driven analyses to the complex subject of corporate governance human resource management and corporate reporting by discussing new developments in context of their economic opportunities as well as of their institutional contradictions with continuities in japanese business practices the second group of chapters deals with institutional changes and evolving economic reforms on the macro level of political economy the two chapters focus on the financial system regulation and economic growth policies as two central elements of japan s political economy and key drivers in the evolution of its economy their analysis allows us to better understand the interplay between reforms and change in consumption credit and to reinterpret abenomics as a manifestation of ongoing contradictions within the japanese political economy the chapters were originally published in a special issue in japan forum

how do centralized institutional religions make peace with the modern state s displacement of their traditional prestige and power what are the factors that can promote the mutual acceptance of religious communities and the secular rule of law these are the questions posed in jonathan laurence s new book which argues that roman catholicism and sunni islam have trod surprisingly similar paths in their respective histories contemporary roman catholicism and sunni islam both descend from religious states and empires the papacy in the case of catholicism and the caliphate in the case of islam as religio political orders the western church and the islamic caliphate ruled vast territories and populations each set of religio political institutions made law controlled land and governed people for roughly four centuries yet both suffered three similar upheavals and challenges the end of empires the rise of the modern national state and significant outward migrations

from the home base of the religious tradition laurence suggests that the historical experience of catholicism offers a useful model for those concerned about the contemporary sunni muslim leadership s attitude toward the modern state just as catholicism worldwide benefited from the survival of the vatican micro state and its ability to exert guidance over the religious belief and practice of catholics worldwide so argues laurence muslim majority states should continue exert control over mosques imam training and religious education to reconcile islam with the rule of law and thus with the authority of the secular state this book is based on prodigious archival research in vatican and ottoman archives and on interviews conducted with senior officials responsible for islamic affairs or public religious education in algiers ankara casablanca istanbul oran rabat tunis and with senior interior ministry and foreign ministry officials in various european capitals responsible for relations with north african turkish qatari and saudi ministries of islamic and religious affairs

the transition from the soviet to the post 1991 russian military is a fascinating story of decline and reinvention the soviet army suffered a slow demise dissolving in 2000 and only gradually reforming based on radically different principles the first chechnya war 1994 1996 was the lowest point for the soviet military but the second chechnya war 1999 2004 saw the initial stirrings of the new russian army the five day war with georgia in august 2008 was its first major success and marked russia s return to world power status lively accounts and maps describe the actions of these wars along with the crimea operation of 2014 the separatist struggles in eastern ukraine and the ongoing russian intervention in syria

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from de gaulle onwards france s strategic independence has been predicated on self sufficiency in modern weapons to achieve and maintain the requisite defence industrial base in the context of limited domestic orders paris sought to promote the export of its arms during the cold war this underpinned but was also an expression of france s determination to resist bipolar domination france offered customers around the world an alternative to reliance on one superpower or the other and in doing so it generated the revenue to support an extensive domestic arms industry the end of the cold war ushered in fundamental changes however western defence spending shrank and the global market was turned upside down while france s arms export policy was less affected by human rights concerns than other democracies it was not immune to pressures stemming from the consolidation of europe s defence industrial base and the increased interest of the eu in regulating the arms trade this adelphi book considers how france has responded to changing political and market circumstances in the way that it promotes and

controls the export of weapons it examines the rationale for considering a liberal arms export policy as essential to french independence and the institutional arrangements that underpinned this it tracks the dramatic changes in the global arms market since 1990 in terms of demand and market competition and charts the response of the french government to these changes the book underlines how the french machinery of government as a directing force behind the defence industry has been resistant to the notion of export restraint even in the case of sales to authoritarian regimes however it argues that france now faces a dilemma over whether to continue with a long successful course or to moderate its independence through greater collaboration to bolster european integration and better compete globally
