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dan barker s dramatic journey from devout soul winner to one of america s most prominent freethinkers after 19 years of evangelical preaching ordained minister associate pastorship missionary to mexico cross country evangelism christian

songwriter dan barker threw out the bathwater and found there is no baby there a challenge to believers and an arsenal for skeptics

atheism s leading lights have long been intellectuals raised in the secular and academic worlds richard dawkins sam harris and the late christopher hitchens by contrast jerry dewitt was born and bred into the church and was in fact a pentecostal preacher before arriving at atheism through an extraordinary dialogue with faith that spanned more than a quarter of a century hope after faith is his account of that journey dewitt was a pastor in the town of deridder louisiana and was a fixture of the community in private however he d begun to question his faith late one night in may 2011 a member of his flock called seeking prayer for her brother who had been in a serious accident as dewitt searched for the right words to console her speech failed him and he found that the faith which once had formed the cornerstone of his life had finally crumbled to dust when it became public knowledge that dewitt was now an atheist he found himself shunned by much of deridder s highly religious community losing nearly everything he d known dewitt s struggle for identity and meaning mirrors the one currently facing millions of people around the world with both agnosticism and atheism entering the mainstream one in five americans now claim no religious affiliation according to a recent study the moment has arrived for a new atheist voice one that is respectful of faith and religious traditions yet warmly embraces a life free of religion finding not skepticism and cold doubt but rather profound meaning and hope hope after faith is the story of one man s evolution toward a committed and considered atheism one driven by humanism a profound moral dimension and a happiness and self confidence obtained through living free of fear

this book is a companion volume for my book why i became an atheist a former preacher rejects christianity amherst ny prometheus books 2008 it presents some personal reflections and additional arguments not covered in that other book

for about two decades john w loftus was a devout evangelical christian an ordained minister of the church of christ and an ardent apologist for christianity with three degrees in philosophy theology and philosophy of religion he was adept at using rational argumentation to defend the faith but over the years doubts about the credibility of key christian tenets began to creep into his thinking by the late 1990s he experienced a full blown crisis of faith in this honest appraisal of his journey from believer to atheist the author carefully explains the experiences and the reasoning process that led him to reject religious belief the original edition of this book was published in 2006 and reissued in 2008 since that time loftus has received a good deal of critical feedback from christians and skeptics alike in this revised and expanded edition the author addresses criticisms of the original adds new argumentation and references and refines his presentation for every issue he succinctly summarizes the various points of view and provides references for further reading in conclusion he describes the implications of life without belief in god some liberating some sobering this frank critique of christian belief from a former insider will interest freethinkers as well as anyone with doubts about the claims of religion

sam whitehead was raised in a strict religious family and was a teenage preacher at age twenty two he began a forty year quest of research and reflection to prove that his faith was the one true religion and that god was real he reluctantly came to the conclusion that there is no god and that no religion is true staunch believers in god and readers who are trying to find their own truth will find sam s journey compelling it moves from alabama to ohio and back to the deep south in atlanta this serious work challenges believers to live up to their creed and reflects the humor in many situations along the way sam holds an mba degree from georgia state university with a major in finance he retired from a lengthy and varied career with one of the largest petroleum transportation companies in the world most of his work was in human resources management and public affairs

miracle of a virgin birth but what as an atheist can guide and support you there are hundreds of thousands of atheists in the world so we all probably meet and talk with and write to many each day one purpose of this work is to better understand what faiths atheists have so as to get along better with one another especially with those having different beliefs we will look at some famous atheists and review what influenced them and what changed for some of them as they matured into adults from childhood we will make some comparisons between atheists and those calling themselves christians

do atheists hate god many christians seem to think so for the last three centuries christians have widely assumed that atheism is always a result of a rebellious sinful rejection of god according to this view at some level atheists really do know there is a god but they sinfully suppress this knowledge because they want to live independently of god but what if that is not correct what if some folks are atheists not because they re sinful and foolish but because they ve thought hard they ve looked carefully and they have simply not found god what if the common christian assumptions about atheism are little more than an indefensible prejudice what if the atheist really is our neighbor

weve heard it said many times when life hands you a bunch of lemons just make lemonade my question would be what if you dont have any sugar on the outside he looked like just another little scrawny kid in the neighborhood who couldnt run as fast or keep up with the rest of the boys in their games on the inside he had a dreadful disease that neither he nor his family fully understood which one day would put him on a deathbed on the outside he looked like any other child playing in sunday school and not giving his full attention when the preacher was preaching on the inside of his mind were questions prompted by a picture being painted in front of him on a life size canvas over the years questions that would put his life on a journey from which few have safely returned little did he know he had a travel agent and his travel plans had already been booked from birth they would take him places and let him experience things that he would later write about in a book called from atheist to ambassador come and travel with the author as he shows you how god took one who was hopeless and turned him into one who now preaches hope from one who

spent countless days racked in pain from a disease the doctors said could not be cured to one who is healed from the disease and now lays hands on the sick and watches god heal them what do you do when life gives you a bunch of lemons you wait until god gives you honey from the rock and then you make a refreshing drink for all to enjoy

it is june 2018 as an unusual group of scholars professors lecturers and students gather in a california hotel they are all attendees of an apologetics conference intended to join qualified representatives of christian deist and atheist thought for a two week no holds barred debate and discussion of their respective positions that will ultimately be included in a book published after the conference evangelical christianity is represented by advocates of evidentialist and presuppositionalist approaches to apologetics catholicism liberal christianity and deism are also well supported the atheist perspective is advocated by a polemical author and a college professor notorious for attacking the views of his christian students as the participants argue over controversial issues such as cosmology evolution the bible historical evidence for jesus the resurrection biblical prophecies and the problem of evil intellectual fireworks result but what will result when such a volatile and eclectic group is placed face to face for more than two weeks the debaters of this age is the tale of what happens inside a california hotel in 2018 when a group of intellectuals gather to vigorously discuss the religious issues of our time

every thinking person wants to lead a life of meaning and purpose for thousands of years holy books have told us that such a life is available only through obedience and submission to some higher power today the faithful keep popular devotionals and tracts within easy reach on bedside tables and mobile devices all communicating this common message life is meaningless without god in this volume former pastor dan barker eloquently powerfully and rationally upends this long held belief offering words of enrichment emancipation and inspiration he reminds us how millions of atheists lead happy loving moral and purpose filled lives practicing what he preaches he also demonstrates through his own personal journey that life is valuable for its own sake that meaning and purpose come not from above but from within

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
