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in perception first form of mind tyler burge develops an understanding of the most primitive type of mental representational perception focusing on the functions and capacities of perceptual states burge accounts for their representational content and structure and develops a formal semantics for them the discussion explains the role of iconic format in the structure it also situates the

accounts of content structure and semantics within scientific explanations of perceptual state formation emphasizing formation of perceptual categorization in the book's second half burge discusses what a perceptual system is exploration of relations between perception and other primitive capacities conation attention memory anticipation affect learning and imagining helps distinguish perceiving with its associated capacities from thinking with its associated capacities drawing mainly on vision science not introspection perception first form of mind is a rigorous agenda setting work in philosophy of perception and philosophy of science
