in *Miyazawa Kenji and His Illustrators* Helen Kilpatrick examines re-visionings of the literature of one of Japan's most celebrated authors Miyazawa Kenji 1896-1933. The deeply Buddhist Kenji's imaginative *dōwa* children's tales are among the most frequently illustrated in Japan today. Numerous internationally renowned artists such as Munakata Shikō, Kim Tschang Yeul and Lee Ufan have represented his stories in an array of intriguing visual styles, reinvigorating them as picture books for modern audiences. Focusing on some of Kenji's most famous narratives, the author analyses the ways artists respond to the stories, metaphysical philosophies, exploring the interaction of literature, art and culture. *Miyazawa Kenji and His Illustrators* is richly depicted with full-colour images of the representations of Kenji's work, making the book a valuable resource on how illustrations shape story and how these picture books continue to convey the texts' witty and ironic messages more deeply than the written word alone.

This new collection of the letters that Lewis Carroll wrote to the illustrators and prospective illustrators of his books affords fresh insights into Carroll's complex character, traces the history of the books that became great classics of the Victorian era and charts the sometimes tempestuous seas of Carroll's relationships with his correspondents. Carroll, a meticulous artist, made detailed demands upon his illustrators, who included John Tenniel, Henry Holiday, Arthur Burdett Frost, Harry Furniss and Gertrude Thomson. *Lewis Carroll and His Illustrators* reveals the author as an expert in the details of book production in an age in which new technologies repeatedly altered the publishing process. Morton N. Cohen and Edward Wakeling's general introduction to the volume looks at Lewis Carroll, the man, and touches on his place in Victorian publishing. Each group of letters is preceded by an introduction that includes a brief biography of the artist and a summary of his or her collaboration with Carroll. Many of the letters include Carroll's own sketches as aids to his collaborators. Comparison of these sketches with the artists' final drawings also included shed light on the genesis of the illustrations. Some letters from the illustrators to Carroll, also printed here, add greater insight into the process.

a master photographer alfred stieglitz was also a visionary promoter and avid collector of modern american and european art from the first half of the 20th century this book is the first fully illustrated catalogue of works in the unparalleled alfred stieglitz collection which was given to the metropolitan museum after stieglitz s death

dickens and his illustrators by frederic george kitton that dickens s association with his illustrators was something more than mere coadjutorship is evidenced both in forster s life and in the published letters from these sources we derive much information tending to prove the existence of a warm friendship subsisting between author and artists indeed the latter with two or three exceptions were privileged to enjoy the close personal intimacy of dickens and his family circle recalling the fact that the novelist not unfrequently availed himself of the traits and idiosyncrasies of his familiars it seems somewhat strange that in the whole range of his creations we fail to discover a single attempt at the portraiture of an artist for those dilettanti wielders of the brush miss la creevy and henry gowan can scarcely be included under that denomination during the earlier part of this century the illustrators of books seldom if ever resorted to the use of the living model such experts as cruikshank seymour phiz maclise doyle and leech were no exceptions to this rule but at the beginning of the sixties there arose a new school of designers and draughtsmen prominent among them being leighton millais walker and sandys those popular royal academicians mr marcus stone and mr luke fildes the illustrators respectively of our mutual friend and edwin drood are almost the only surviving members of that confraternity they however speedily relinquished black and white art in order to devote their attention to the more fascinating pursuit of painting while admitting the technical superiority of many of the illustrations in the later editions of dickens s works such as those by frederick barnard and charles green the collector and bibliophile claim for the designs in the original issue an interest which is lacking in subsequent editions that is to say they possess the charm of association a charm that far outweighs possible artistic defects and conventions for be it remembered these designs were produced under the direct influence and authorisation of dickens and by artists who worked hand in hand with the great romancer himself
