we could have been called a lot of things brazen vandals scared kids threats to social order self obsessed egomaniacs marginalized youth outsider artists trend setters and thrill seekers but to me we were just regular kids growing up hard in america and making the city our own being writers gave us something to live for and going all city gave us something to strive for and for some of my friends it was something to
