humanities in considering leisure as a condition of being human not only do chapters 1 through 4 establish the basic definitions and parameters for studying leisure they ask readers to consider these concepts from their own personal framework part two is a focus on leisure's role in creating and reflecting society chapters 5 through 8 build on the personal relevancy of leisure discussed in part one and teach about leisure's contemporary cultural significance these chapters rely on anthropology sociology and psychology concepts leisure's personal and cultural vitality are brought to a pragmatic conclusion in part three leisure's use as a social instrument material from recreation and park studies is featured in chapters 9 through 12

the purpose of this eighth edition of pastimes is to extend the discussion about contemporary leisure to new concepts supported by the latest research findings and scholarly commentary in this edition much of the content is new including an added discussion on architecture as material culture as well more attention to indigenous people within a leisure context is incorporated there is also a new chapter that challenges us to look at leisure as a fundamental aspect of human rights the implication of this chapter is to aid readers learners and instructors to think even more broadly about not only what leisure is but also what it can be this new edition of pastimes also contains new illustrations of concepts through field based cases new biographical features new exploratory and participatory activities and new research study summaries more than a textbook pastimes is very much a point of view it presents leisure as a human phenomenon that is individual and collective vital and frivolous historical and contemporary factual and subjective good and bad human life and its culture cannot be understood without understanding leisure leisure is a complex subject yet worth knowing back cover

this encyclopedia covers culture from the end of the imperialist period in 1945 right up to date to reflect the vibrant nature of contemporary japanese society and culture

this book illustrates how leisure as with other complex ideas that hold currency in today s world suffers at the level of common sense due to a combination of oversimplification moral depreciation and even lack of recognition leisure s modern legacy is both profound and immense as a product of approximately 45 years of steady research application and theory development the common sense view of free time activities therefore can and should be challenged stebbins provides this confrontation by tackling four particular themes that gatekeepers within the institutions of higher education and funding agencies for research often fail to attach adequate resources to the idea of leisure that the general population are guided by certain common sense definitions and largely unaware of how an informed view of free time could be beneficial that practitioners within certain fields continue to refuse to engage with the idea of leisure despite its benefit for their clients and that the weak reception of the science of leisure within mainstream social sciences suggests a similarly warped understanding of how people use their free time leisure s legacy will be of interest to scholars of leisure studies and all those wishing to learn more about the vital importance of leisure in modern western society

for first year students in tertiary leisure studies programs both leisure studies and social science *australian leisure 4e* provides an introduction to and analysis of a broadly defined concept of leisure it integrates australian and international knowledge so that the book is an australian interpretation based largely on local sources but which engages with relevant international research and theory this edition has been extensively reviewed and updated and includes new chapters on social networks global cultures and events leisure is not just sport or the arts or outdoor recreation it is all these things and more including tourism gambling hobbies television watching
