much of guyana's 20th century history was defined by the pnc dictatorship and the political and economic wreckage it left behind in guyana's great economic downswing 1977 to 1990 dr ramesh gampat presents a comprehensive study of these specific years when the national economy contracted by 2.7 percent annually he explores the multiple facets of the country's political tribalism which does not value freedom liberty and the flourishing of all people it values only freedom liberty and flourishing of tribes the study reinforces the widely held belief that until and unless these adversarial groups subsume their respective selfish interests and commit to the common cause of national peace and development the great downswing might not rest as a historical event but could well re-emerge with further economic devastation if the lessons go unheeded dr gampat makes a strong case for federalism as a solution to guyana's ethnic politics federalism he posits would ensure that all guyanese have equal access to opportunities and resources since a system of provincial governance would be better placed to address discriminatory policies and practices at a localised level with the country sitting on the cusp of transformative development to be propelled by new found oil wealth there is an urgency to settle the divisive politics if every guyanese is to benefit fairly and equitably from the economic boom guyana's great economic downswing 1977 to 1990 offers up a studied and comprehensive analysis that should be part of that bipartisan discourse going forward ryhaan shah novelist social activist a few piecemeal academic articles analyzing guyana's economic evolution over the period 1977 to 1990 were written but they are scattered and lost away in various journals what was missing is a comprehensive and rigorous exploration of the era of cooperative socialism dr ramesh gampat's book fills this gap it is a superb synthesis of historical theoretical and econometric exploration of the great downswing the book not only provides estimates of important macroeconomic concepts such as guyana's total factor productivity and long term growth but also produces the useful statistics and reviews of poverty inequality life expectancy education outcomes as well as a detailed analysis of the rice sector as if these are not enough gampat sets the tone by situating the exploration in the country's long standing and debilitating ethno-political dynamics this self-contained book will be of tremendous use to policy makers journalists and students interested in the historical context of present day outcomes i highly recommend this book to public libraries and home reference libraries tarron khemraj william and marie selby professor of economics and international studies new college of florida

this book makes the bold claim that we must put the small easily overlooked south american nation of guyana on the map if we hope to understand the global threat of environmental catastrophe as well as the pernicious forms of erasure that structure caribbean women's lives

this volume looks at the ways historians have written the history of the region depending upon their methods of interpretation and differing styles of communicating their findings the chapters discussing methodology are followed by studies of particular themes of historiography the second half of the volume describes the writing of history in the individual territories taking into account changes in society economy and political structure the final section is a full and detailed bibliography serving not only as a guide to the volume but also as an invaluable reference for the general history of the caribbean as a whole

christian missionaries worked hard to convert immigrants their first order of business was to denigrate hinduism designate hindus as heathen and disparage their culture food and even

attire immigrants stubbornly resisted led by the tiny educated elite including brhmaas whom we call brahmins conversion was a failure at least up to the end of the 19th century but picked up a self generating momentum thereafter the result is that the share of hindus in guyana s indian population declined from 83.5 percent in 1880 to 62.8 percent in 2012 the largest portion of the contraction was lost to christianity the loss notwithstanding even a casual observer would conclude that guyanese hindus at home and in the diaspora are a very religious people many of us do a jhandi or havan once annually others do the more elaborate and costlier yajña where everyone is welcome once or twice in their lifetime most of us do a short daily puja prayers offerings reading the stras and listening to bhajan in our homes an important but perhaps unintended way immigrants countered conversion to christianity was an unplanned movement towards a synthesis that brought hindus regardless of caste or sect under a unitary form of hinduism the synthesis began around the 1870s and was completed by the 1930s to the 1950s guyanese hindus call the unified corpus of religious beliefs and practices that emerged from the synthesis sanatana dharma ramesh gampat labels it plantation hinduism in this path breaking book the book argues that the brand of hinduism practiced is inconsistent with sanatana dharma called vednta by the more philosophically inclined plantation hinduism features an extraordinary dependence upon purohiths pandits which has anaesthetized the hindu mind and render him unable to think question and inquire when it comes to dharma rituals and bhakti have been degraded and turned into desire motivated worship devats have been misconstrued as brahman rather than as limited manifestation of the one non dual pure consciousness belief in the multiplicity of gods encourages image worship and superstitions anchor guyanese hindus to tradition and mere belief plantation hinduism is little more than desire motivated actions dogmas and superstitions absent is the idea that sanatana dharma is a spiritual science no less scientific than hard sciences such as physics and astronomy the central message of vednta is the innate divinity of every person and the freedom to realize that divinity through anubhava direct personal experience of supreme reality

ramesh gampat stands out as the first analyst to consolidate recent statistics on guyana s burgeoning oil economy his work is essential reading for anyone engaged in public debate and policy regarding the dynamics of the local foreign exchange market fiscal and public debt policies and exchange rate management students and general readers will appreciate the accessible introduction to exchange rate theory and the thorough examination of the local fx market covering cambios as well as the inter bank fx market the book s central focus is on the net sale of foreign exchange to the local market by both bank and non bank cambios with an emphasis on the period from 2013 to the second quarter of 2023 key observations include banks were net buyers of foreign exchange for most of the review period with notable exceptions in 2014 2021 and 2022 monthly data provide a more useful reflection of market balance compared to annual frequencies and the bank of guyana has sometimes exacerbated rather than mitigated demand and supply imbalances additionally while some analyses have criticized the banking system for local fx issues gampat notes that commercial banks could only cover about one week s worth of imports even if they depleted their liquid foreign assets challenging the claim of badly behaved banks this book is essential reading for anyone interested in the intricacies of guyana s evolving economy and its impact on the foreign exchange market dr collin constantine girton college university of cambridge

this memoir specifically highlights the experiences of a female of indo guyanese decent growing up in the midwest often confused for being an immigrant east indian ashti offers a brief exposure to a thriving culture that is consistently overlooked ultimately she aims to show others what it is like to be a west indian living in the united states as she explains her ethnic background ashti also covers the nuances of growing up guyanese the struggles she and others like herself face and the comical interactions they have all likely experienced as it progresses the book delves deeper into a theme of finding oneself this occurs as the author reaches adulthood and makes discoveries that all millennials must make in their lifetime highly anecdotal growing up guyanese offers any reader regardless of ethnicity something to which he or she can relate

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
