the sixth international joint conference on autonomous agents and multiagent systems aamas 2007 held in honolulu hawai in may 2007 and the 5th workshop on trading agent design and analysis tada 2007 co located with the twenty second aaai conference on artificial intelligence aaai 2007 held in vancouver canada in july 2007 this volume presents 15 carefully revised and selected papers from these workshops the primary and complementary goal of both workshops was to continue to bring together novel work from diverse fields on modeling implementation and evaluation of computational trading institutions and or agent strategies the papers originating from amec focus on a large variety of issues on auctions negotiation and strategic behavior in electronic marketplaces the papers originating from tada reflect the effort of the community to design scenarios where trading agent designers and market designers can be pitched against one another

syntactic dependencies are often non local they can involve two positions in a syntactic structure whose correspondence cannot be captured by invoking concepts like minimal clause or predicate argument structure relevant phenomena include long distance movement long distance reflexivization long distance agreement control non local deletion long distance case assignment consecutio temporum extended scope of negation and semantic binding of pronouns a recurring strategy pursued in many contemporary syntactic theories is to model cases of non local dependencies in a strictly local way by successively passing on the relevant information in small domains of syntactic structures

norris presents a series of closely linked chapters on recent developments in epistemology philosophy of language cognitive science literary theory musicology and other related fields while to this extent adopting an interdisciplinary approach norris also very forcefully challenges the view that the academic disciplines as we know them are so many artificial constructs of recent date and with no further role than to prop up existing divisions of intellectual labour he makes his case through some exceptionally acute revisionist readings of diverse thinkers such as derrida paul de man wittgenstein chomsky michael dummett and john mcdowell in each instance norris stresses the value of bringing various trans disciplinary perspectives to bear while none the less maintaining adequate standards of area specific relevance and method most importantly he asserts the central role of recent developments in cognitive science as pointing a way beyond certain otherwise intractable problems in philosophy of mind and language

this volume assembles supporters and critics of situated cognition research to evaluate the intricacies prerequisites possibilities and scope of a 4e methodology the contributions are divided into three categories the first category entails papers dealing with a 4e methodology from the perspective of epistemology and philosophy of science it discusses whether to support explanatory pluralism or explanatory unification and focuses on possible compromises between ecological psychology and enactivism the second category addresses ontological questions regarding the synchronic and diachronic constitution of cognitive phenomena the localization of cognitive processes and the theoretical issue of mutual manipulability the third category analyzes how the theoretical and practical commitments of 4e approaches lead to empirically supported investigations of different phenomena such as research on affordances and chronic pain the book renews attention to the possible adverse consequences coming along with methodical fragmentation as found among 4e positions it provides an overdue first step towards a systematic and positive answer to methodological concerns in situated cognition research without this and further steps in the future the growth of 4e s significance for the scientific study of the mind might stall or even decrease with such steps situated cognition research could realize its frequently highlighted but so far not comprehensively accessed potential to change radically the modalities of how cognitive phenomena are studied this volume is of interest to scholars of the philosophy of mind
