journeying through the decades this book profiles a diverse array of influential hostesses with each historic era comes iconic recipes featuring a total of 40 main cocktails and more than 100 variations that readers can make at home whether its happy hour punch à la martha washington or a harlem renaissance inspired green skirt readers will find that many of the ingredients and drinks they re familiar with today wouldn t be here without the hostesses who served them first

a picture of some phases of life in the early days of the massachusetts bay colony is presented in the following pages it follows many of the every day happenings the manners and customs of daily life few realize how modern are the furnishings and comforts of our present day houses and how different was the home life of our ancestors chairs were unknown in ordinary english households until a generation or so before the sailing of the mayflower hats were worn at meals and the use of table forks did not become general until the last of the 1600s food was placed in the mouth with the knife or the fingers this is a collection of source materials somewhat digested rather than a comprehensive well balanced narrative of daily life in the colony contents every day life in the massachusetts bay colony the voyage to massachusetts their early shelters and later dwellings how they furnished their houses counterpanes and coverlets concerning their apparel pewter in the early days the farmhouse and the farmer manners and customs sports and games trades and manufactures concerning shipping and trade from wampum to paper money herb tea and the doctor crimes and punishments

in the decades leading up to the end of u s slavery many free blacks sat for daguerreotypes decorated in fine garments to document their self possession people pictured in these early photographs used portraiture to seize control over representation of the free black body and reimagine black visibility divorced from the cultural logics of slavery in picture freedom jasmine nichole cobb analyzes the ways in which the circulation of various images prepared free blacks and free whites for the emancipation of formerly unfree people of african descent she traces the emergence of black freedom as both an idea and as an image during the early nineteenth century through an analysis of popular culture of the period including amateur portraiture racial caricatures joke books antislavery newspapers abolitionist materials runaway advertisements ladies magazines and scrapbooks as well as scenic wallpaper cobb explores the earliest illustrations of free blacks and reveals the complicated route through visual culture toward a vision of african american citizenship picture freedom reveals how these depictions contributed to public understandings of nationhood among both domestic eyes and the larger atlantic world

tulasi srinivas explores the dynamic and gendered world of beauty through the experiences of women in the intimate space of the contemporary indian beauty salon

this collection presents for the first time the complete mazurkas of Frederic Chopin
arranged for solo classical guitar the mazurka is the only form the composer
embraced throughout his lifetime the distinctive and personal pieces are unimaginably

evident in his other compositions the mazurkas are a true monument to Chopin s genius

one of George Bernard Shaw s best known plays Pygmalion is based on ancient Greek
mythology Pygmalion fell in love with one of his sculptures which then came to life the
general idea of that myth was a popular subject for Victorian era British playwrights
Shaw s updated and revised version of this ancient Greek legend was first presented in
England in 1914 poking fun of the antiquated British class system it introduces Henry
Higgins a professor of speech and phonetics who takes on a bet that he can transform
a bedraggled Cockney flower seller Eliza Doolittle into a refined young lady simply by
polishing her manners and changing the way she speaks their dynamic personalities
clash and the play follows their antics as Higgins imparts his knowledge to a stubborn
Eliza who s happy to learn but reluctant to leave her old ways behind in the process of
convincing society that his creation is a mysterious royal figure a Duchess Professor
Higgins falls in love with his elegant handiwork Shaw s clever adaptation was a rousing
success his irresistible theme together with brilliant dialogue made Pygmalion one of
the most popular comedies in the English language it was presented on the London and
New York stages and as an entertaining motion picture in its musical version My Fair
Lady Shaw s most well known play and the humorous and fascinating relationship
dynamics at play make it a timeless classic that will inspire generations to come

dromedaries rabbits and grasscutters in view of the un sustainable development goals in particular sdg 2 zero hunger and sdg 15 life on land the purpose of this volume is to catalogue opportunities that can be leveraged with available technologies and technical knowhow for achieving rapid genetic gain and improved livestock productivity in africa it fosters the utilization of genetic resources and the protection of indigenous livestock biodiversity natural selection and humans have generated genetically diverse breeds of domesticated farm animals which can significantly contribute to the livelihoods of millions of africans today africa s indigenous livestock are particularly hardy and well adapted to local production contexts having evolved adaptations to the continent s diverse climatic conditions and environmental pressures in spite of the wealth of desirable genetic traits however some of africa s iconic and lesser known livestock are disappearing at an alarming rate moreover despite increasing recognition of what this diversity portends little has been done to understand and optimally harness the full potential of these genetic resources by combining scientific basis and practical instructions this work is a valuable manual for a diverse readership including students researchers livestock farmers livestock and non governmental organizations policy makers and business professionals who want to understand the uniqueness of african livestock genetic resources production systems and strategies for sustainable improvement for the african environment
