what does the power of great art have to do with madness should psychedelic drugs
make us doubt the evidence of our senses how did power sadism and conformity turn
education into mind control not that we need either can a rock band keep its identity
as its members change what can we learn from the synchronicities between the dark
side of the moon and the wizard of oz did friedrich nietzsche foreshadow syd barrett
when did you realize that you are the hole in reality how can you have any pudding if
you don't eat yer meat

in this book authors from a wide interdisciplinary spectrum discuss the issue of care
the book covers both philosophical and therapeutic studies and contains a three
pronged approach to discussing the concepts of care vulnerability otherness and
therapy above all it is a matter of combining in a plural form a path with multiple
theoretical and conceptual bifurcations but which always point to an observation of
society from the perspective of human vulnerability

retracing the philosophical discussions around care our current culture is dominated by
the ideology of creativity one is supposed to create the new and not to care about the
things as they are this ideology legitimises the domination of the creative class over
the rest of the population that is predominantly occupied by forms of care medical care
child care agriculture industrial maintenance and so on we have a responsibility to care
for our own bodies but here again our culture tends to thematize the bodies of desire
and to ignore the bodies of care ill bodies in need of self care and social care but the

discussion of care has a long philosophical tradition the book retraces some episodes of this tradition beginning with plato and ending with alexander bogdanov through hegel heidegger bataille and many others the central question discussed is who should be the subject of care should i care for myself or trust the others the system the institutions here the concept of the self care becomes a revolutionary principle that confronts the individual with the dominating mechanisms of control

this book presents a fascinating examination of modern indian philosophical thought from the margins it considers the subject from two perspectives how it has been understood beyond india and how indian thinkers have treated western ideas in the context of indian society the book discusses the concepts of the self the other and the border that underline various debates on modernity this engaging work will be of interest to scholars and researchers of indian philosophy social and political philosophy indian political theory postcolonialism and south asian studies

without thinking about it c k s religion is apathetic agnostic conveyed in his thought experiment that god began work in 1982

african american philosophers brings into conversation seventeen of the foremost thinkers of color to discuss issues such as black existentialism racism black women philosophers within the academy affirmative action and the conceptual parameters of african american philosophy

philosophers wittily and expertly uncover amazing philosophical insights from the endlessly fascinating tv show it s always sunny in philadelphia littmann shows how the values of the gang are the same as those of homeric heroes ketcham argues that the church should make charlie a saint partly because it s always sunny is all about free will hamer shows how closely the gang s activities comply with the scientific method alkema and barkman analyze the way the gang perceives happiness and how they try to get it leonard proves beyond doubt that the game of chardee macdennis reveals everyone s unconscious desires king examines the morality of the gang s behavior by the standard of how they respond to extreme suffering chambers agrees that each of the five central characters is a terrible person but argues that given their circumstances they are not truly to blame for their actions tanswell demonstrates that many of the gang s wrong actions result not from immoral motives but from illogical thinking aylesworth uses examples from it s always sunny to bring out some of the moral problems with real consent to sex jones reveals that nietzsche foresaw everything the gang at paddy s pub would do

in the walking dead human beings are pushed to their limits by a zombie apocalypse and have to decide what really matters good and evil freedom and slavery when one life has to be sacrificed for another even the nature of religion all the ultimate questions of human existence are posed afresh as the old society crumbles away and a new form of society emerges with new beliefs and new rules the ultimate walking
