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this instalment in the nineteenth century literature in transition series concerns a decade that was as technologically transitional as it was

eventful on a global scale it collects work from a group of internationally renowned scholars across disciplinary boundaries in order to engage with the wide array of cultural developments that defined the 1830s often overlooked as a boundary between the romantic and victorian periods this decade was the book proposes the central pivot of the nineteenth century far from a time of peaceful reform it was marked by violent colonial expansion political resistance and revolutionary technologies such as the photograph the expansion of steam power and the railway that changed the world irreversibly contributors explore a flurry of cultural forms to take the pulse of the decade from silver fork fiction to lithography from working class periodicals to photographs and from urban sketches to magazine fiction

in may 1999 a second conference of hellenists of all periods and subject areas from the dutch speaking countries was organized in groningen the theme of this second conference was constructions of greek past identity and historical consciousness from antiquity to the present the conference theme was described as follows when seeking to establish its own identity a culture country people nation readily resorts to its own history which it uses either as an example or as something to react against in recent years there has been a growing awareness that this process often reveals more about a culture in the present day than the historical era to which it harks back its own identity and thus its own history are constructed in this way the constructional approach is usually applied to the birth of new nation states and the development of their national ideologies particularly in the nineteenth century but it can be applied more broadly too greek culture is an excellent subject area for studying this phenomenon even further back in history precisely because its history is so long and included several golden ages to which later periods could and can hark back greek culture still presents itself as a product of ancient greek and or byzantine culture however the problem of continuity in greek culture has frequently manifested itself particularly during periods of radical political ideological or demographic change the homeric influence on the mycenaean world is therefore also an aspect of this phenomenon the homeric world served as an example for later periods as did the attic period for the greeks in the hellenistic roman age the tensions between the hellenistic and roman character of the greek world had a strong influence on the shaping of the greek identity during late antiquity and the middle ages those tensions still exist today ellenismós ellenikótita v romiosyni the theme was designed to bring together hellenists of all periods and disciplines literature language history archaeology ecclesiastical history sociology etc relating to the greek world the colloquium sessions were

held in dutch but the papers are published in english two in french

this revised and updated third edition contains a wealth of new material that draws on new research in this area

conflict the volume summarizes insights gleaned from these studies and formulates an analytical framework for understanding the role of identity constructions in conflict or peace

in most latin american countries key officials and political figures have been involved in big corruption scandals in the last decade leading to a rigorous academic debate on the possible socio economic political and cultural factors responsible for corrupt practices across the region this book takes a different approach by focusing on chile which shows the lowest levels of corruption in the region instead of analysing notoriously bad cases in mexico argentina brazil and venezuela this book explores the factors which have led to a relatively high degree of public probity among power holders in chile public probity and corruption in chile presents a long term historical analysis demonstrating that public probity in chile has its roots in the colonial period and that public and state responses have historically shown a low level of tolerance for public cases of corruption in particular the author highlights the role played by relative poverty and lack of resources geographical remoteness the impact of the arauco war against the mapuche people the militarisation of both government and public administration the extreme oligarchic nature of the chilean aristocracy the early consolidation of state institutions and the rule of law high levels of political stability and the role played by patriotism studying an example of better practice in detail in this way provides valuable insights into the factors and actors which can help to prevent or to revert the phenomenon of public corruption in the region more generally as such this book will be of interest to researchers of corruption and public probity both in chile and further afield

slavery has also intensified awareness of enslavement as a global phenomenon inviting a comparative trans regional approach across time space divides though different aspects of enslavement in different societies and eras are discussed each of the volume s three parts contributes to and has benefitted from a global perspective of enslavement the chapters in part one propose to structure the global examination of the theoretical ideological and methodological aspects of the global local and glocal part two regional and trans regional perspectives of the global presents through analyses of historical case studies the link between connectivity and mobility as a fundamental aspect of the globalization of enslavement finally part three deals with personal points of view regarding the global local and glocal grosso modo the contributors do not only present their case studies but attempt to demonstrate what insights and added value explanations they gain from positioning their work vis à vis a broader big picture

the publication of this book sees the completion of a monumental work listing the technical details and career histories of every significant british warship between 1603 and 1863 following three earlier volumes this one carries forward the story from the post napoleonic war reorganisation of the royal navy s rating system to the end of sail as the principal mode of propulsion although apparently well documented this is a period of great complexity in the procurement and naval architecture of ships the introduction of steam radically altered the design of vessels under construction and was later retro fitted to others while many names lived a ghostly existence on the navy list ships ordered but not started and in some cases having their intended draughts altered more than once before being cancelled entirely this book meticulously sorts out and clarifies these confusions a major contribution in itself but for the first time it also provides outline service histories for an era that is largely neglected like its companion volumes the book is organised by rate classification and class with significant technical and building data followed by a concise summary of the careers of each ship in every class with its unique depth of information this is a work of the utmost importance to every naval historian and general reader interested in the navy of the sailing era and the formative years of the steam navy that supplanted it

douglas e ashford joins a growing number of scholars who have questioned the behavioralist assumptions of much policy science the essays in this volume show why policy analysis cannot be confined to prevailing methods of social science policy making behavior involves historical contextual and philosophical factors that also raise critical questions about the concepts and theory of the discipline ashford asks difficult questions about the contextual conjunctural and unintentional circumstances that affect actual decision making his bridging essays summarize opposing viewpoints and conflicting interpretations to help form a new agenda for comparative policy analysis

this study offers an exploration of the role of merchants throughout maritime history through the analysis of maritime trade networks it attempts to fill in the gaps in the historiography to determine the range of activities that maritime merchants undertook it is comprised of nine chapters one introductory and eight exploring aspects of merchant history across europe during the period 1640 to 1940 several major themes recur throughout these studies the necessity of port networks the extension of trade networks through merchant migration and in migration the assimilation of merchants into port communities and the impact of urban governance and trade associations on merchant activity it concludes by claiming merchants across europe had a more common with one another when approaching risk management than has previously been assumed and that the at the core of the merchant s risk management strategy the question of who they could trust with their trade is a universally unifying factor it suggests that further research on the demographics of ports is the necessary next step in merchant historiography

the dictionary of german national biography is unique complete and comprehensive with biographies of 60 000 people from the german speaking world it covers not only individuals from germany but also from austria switzerland and other countries where german is or used to be spoken coverage stretches all the way from the time of charlemagne to the present day and includes lesser known as well as world famous germans in order to ensure that entries were as objective as possible only individuals whose life and works have come to an end were included
