shortlisted for the 2021 tapra edited collection prize the methuen drama handbook of theatre history and historiography is an authoritative guide to contemporary debates and practices in this field the book covers the key themes and methods that are current in theatre history research with a particular focus on expanding the object of study to include engagement with theatre and performance practices and the development of theatre histories around the world central to the book are eighteen specially commissioned essays by established and emerging scholars from a wide range of international contexts whose discussion of individual case studies is predicated on their understanding and experience of their local landscape of theatre history these essays reveal where important work continues to be done in the field and most valuably draws on academic contexts beyond the western academy to expand our knowledge of the exciting directions that such an approach opens up prefaced by an introduction tracing the development of the discipline of theatre history and changing historiographical approaches the handbook explores current issues pertaining to theatre and performance history research as well as providing up to date and robust introductions to the methods and historiographic questions being explored by researchers in the field featuring a series of essential research tools including a detailed list of resources and an annotated bibliography of key texts this is an indispensable scholarly handbook for anyone working in theatre

during the 1970s a wave of counter culture people moved into rural communities in many parts of australia this study focuses in particular on the town of kuranda in north queensland and the relationship between the settlers and the local aboriginal population concentrating on a number of linked social dramas that portrayed the use of both public and private space through their public performances and in their everyday spatial encounters these people resisted the bureaucratic state but in the process they also contributed to the cultivation and propagation of state effects

over the past 50 years indigenous australian theatre practice has emerged as a dynamic site for the discursive reflection of culture and tradition as well as colonial legacies leveraging the power of storytelling to create and advocate contemporary fluid conceptions of indigeneity performing indigenous identities on the contemporary australian stage offers a window into the history and diversity of this vigorous practice it introduces the reader to cornerstones of indigenous australian cultural frameworks and on this backdrop discusses a wealth of plays in light of their responses to contemporary australian identity politics the in depth readings of two landmark theatre productions scott rankin s namatjira 2010 and wesley enoch anita heiss i am eora 2012 trace the artists engagement with questions of community consolidation and national reconciliation carefully considering the implications of their propositions for identity work arising from the translation of traditional ontologies into contemporary orientations the analyses of the dramatic texts are incrementally enriched by a dense reflection of the production and reception contexts of the plays providing an expanded framework for the critical consideration of contemporary postcolonial theatre practice that allows for a well founded appreciation of the strengths yet also pointing to the limitations of current representative approaches on the australian mainstage this study will be of great interest to students and scholars of postcolonial literary performance and theatre studies

this third volume of asnel papers covers a wide range of theoretical and thematic approaches to the subject of intertextuality intertextual relations between oral and written versions of literature text and performance as well as problems emerging from media transitions regionally instructed forms of intertextuality and the works of individual authors are equally dealt with intertextuality as both

a creative and a critical practice frequently exposes the essential arbitrariness of literary and cultural manifestations that have become canonized the transformation and transfer of meanings which accompanies any crossing between texts rests not least on the nature of the artistic corpus embodied in the general framework of historically and socially determined cultural traditions traditions however result from selective forms of perception they are as much inventions as they are based on exclusion intertextuality leads to a constant reinforcement of tradition while at the same time intertextual relations between the new literatures and other english language literatures are all too obvious despite the inevitable impact of tradition the new literatures tend to employ a dynamic reading of culture which fosters social process and transition thus promoting transcultural rather than intercultural modes of communication writing and reading across borders becomes a dialogue which reveals both differences and similarities more than a decolonizing form of deconstruction intertextuality is a strategy for communicating meaning across cultural boundaries

surprising theater origins challenges conventional wisdom about the history of performing arts it argues that modern theater s roots lie not solely in classical greek drama but also in diverse cultural practices many existing outside traditional institutions the book explores proto theater religious rituals political theater and popular entertainment revealing how these elements shaped the dramatic forms we recognize today the book examines the deep connections between early dramatic forms and religious ceremonies highlighting how rituals evolved to incorporate storytelling it also investigates how social movements used performance as a tool for protest and expression presenting case studies from various historical periods the book progresses from ancient rites to medieval plays and renaissance street performances demonstrating their convergence in shaping modern theatrical landscapes

a study of post colonial drama and theatre it examines how dramatists from various societies have attempted to fuse the performance idioms of their traditions with the western dramatic form demonstrating how the dynamics of syncretic theatrical texts function in performance

de scribing empire is a stunning collection of first class essays collectively they examine the formative role of books writing and textuality in imperial control and the fashioning of colonial world views the volume as a whole puts forward strategies for understanding and neutralising that control and as such is a major contribution to the field it will be invaluable for students in post colonialist criticism

west words gives the reader a bird s eye view of the contemporary theatre scene across the prairies

tropical environments presents a comprehensive introduction to the complex systems of the tropics covering a broad cross regional range of humid through to semi arid tropical climate zones the book features a wealth of case studies drawn from throughout the tropical world the authors tackle the major problems within the tropics from complex biological interactions and soil nutrient deficiencies offering a balanced integration of biophysical and human management issues

burning brightly is the first full length book treatment of professional storytelling in north america today for some years there has been a major storytelling revival throughout the continent with hundreds of local groups and centres springing up and with storytelling becoming an important part of the professional training for librarians in the book stone explores storytelling through storytellers themselves while providing enlightening commentary from her own background as a storyteller included in her analysis are informative discussions of organized storytelling communities individual tellers and tales issues such as the modern recontextualization of old tales and the role of women in folktales are linked to individual storytelling accounts texts of eight stories that exemplify the approaches of the various storytellers are also included burning brightly will be compelling reading for storytellers and for everyone who loves storytelling

storytelling in world cinemas vol 2 contexts addresses the questions of what and why particular stories are told in films around the world both in terms of the forms of storytelling used and of the political religious historical and social contexts informing cinematic storytelling drawing on films from all five continents the book approaches storytelling from a cultural historical multidisciplinary perspective focusing on the influence of cultural politics postcolonialism women s social and cultural positions and religious contexts on film stories publisher website

the representation of non western cultures in opera has long been a focus of critical inquiry within this field the diverse relationships between opera and first nations and indigenous cultures however have received far less attention opera indigene takes this subject as its focus addressing the changing historical depictions of indigenous cultures in opera and the more contemporary practices of indigenous and first nations artists the use of re presenting in the title signals an important distinction between how representations of indigenous identity have been constructed in operatic history and how indigenous artists have more recently utilized opera as an interface to present and develop their cultural practices this volume explores how operas on indigenous subjects reflect the evolving relationships between indigenous peoples the colonizing forces of imperial power and forms of internal colonization in developing nation states drawing upon postcolonial theory ethnomusicology cultural geography and critical discourses on nationalism and multiculturalism the collection brings together experts on opera and music in canada the americas and australia in a stimulating comparative study of operatic re presentation

the theatre of societas raffaello sanzio chronicles four years in the life of an extraordinary italian theatre company whose work is widely recognized as some

Company founders Claudia Castellucci, Romeo Castellucci, and Chiara Guidi discuss their approach to theatre making with Joe Kelleher and Nicholas Ridout.
