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an untamed region teeming with snakes alligators and snapping turtles with sausage and cracklins sold at every gas station cajun country is a world unto itself the heart of this area the acadiana region of louisiana is a tough land that funnels its spirit into the local cuisine you can t find more delicious rustic and satisfying country cooking than the dirty rice spicy sausage and fresh crawfish that this area is known for it takes a homegrown guide to show us around the back roads of this particularly unique region and in real cajun james beard award winning chef donald link shares his own rough and tumble stories of living cooking and eating in cajun country link takes us on an expedition to the swamps and smokehouses and the music festivals funerals and holiday celebrations but more important reveals the fish fries étouffées and pots of granny s seafood gumbo that always accompany them the food now famous at link s new orleans based restaurants cochon and herbsaint has roots in the

family dishes and traditions that he shares in this book you ll find recipes for seafood gumbo smothered pork roast over rice baked oysters with herbsaint hollandaise louisiana crawfish boudin quick and easy flaky buttermilk biscuits with fig ginger preserves bourbon soaked bread pudding with white and dark chocolate and blueberry ice cream made with fresh summer berries link throws in a few lagniappes to give you an idea of life in the bayou such as strategies for a great trip to jazz fest a what not to do instructional on catching turtles and all you ever or never wanted to know about boudin sausage colorful personal essays enrich every recipe and introduce his grandfather and friends as they fish shrimp hunt and dance from the backyards where crawfish boils reign as the greatest of outdoor events to the white tablecloths of link s famed restaurants real cajun takes you on a rollicking and inspiring tour of this wild part of america and shares the soulful recipes that capture its irrepressible spirit

carolyn kolb provides a delightful and detailed look into the heart of her city new orleans she is a former times picayune reporter and current columnist for new orleans magazine where versions of these essays appeared as chronicles of recent history kolb takes her readers both those who live in new orleans and those who love it as visitors on a virtual tour of her favorite people and places divided into sections on food mardi gras literature and music these short essays can be read in one gulp or devoured slowly over time either way the reader will find a welcome companion and guide in kolb in bringing her stories up to date kolb s writings reflect an ongoing pattern of life in her fascinating city since the devastation of hurricane katrina in 2005 some of these things remembered will never return some of the people whose

stories kolb tells are no longer with us it is important to her and to us that they are not forgotten kolb and her readers can honor them by sharing and enjoying their stories as kolb says when things fail when the lights go out and the roof caves in and the water rises all that remains ultimately is the story this collection of such stories was made with love

restless with the familiarity of her alabama home ellie fields accepts a teaching job in a tiny louisiana town deep in bayou country though rightfully suspicious of outsiders who have threatened both their language and their culture most of the people in tiny bernadette louisiana come to appreciate the young and idealistic schoolteacher as a boon to the town she s soon teaching just about everyone and coming up against opposition from both the school board and a politician with ulterior motives acclimating to a whole new world ellie meets a lonely but intriguing cajun fisherman named raphe who introduces her to the legendary white alligator that haunts these waters raphe and ellie have barely found their way to each other when a huge bounty is offered for the elusive gator bringing about a shocking turn of events that will test their love and their will to right a terrible wrong a master of the southern novel valerie fraser luesse invites you to enter the sultry swamps of louisiana in a story that illuminates the struggle for the heart and soul of the bayou

gone to the country chronicles the life and music of the new lost city ramblers a trio of city bred musicians who helped pioneer the resurgence of southern roots music during the folk revival of the late 1950s and 1960s formed in 1958 by mike seeger john cohen and tom paley the ramblers introduced the regional styles of southern ballads blues string bands and bluegrass to northerners yearning for a sound and an experience not found in mainstream music ray allen interweaves biography history and music criticism to follow the band from its new york roots to their involvement with the commercial folk music boom allen details their struggle to establish themselves amid critical debates about traditionalism brought on by their brand of folk revivalism he explores how the ramblers ascribed notions of cultural authenticity to certain musical practices and performers and how the trio served as a link between southern folk music and northern urban audiences who had little previous exposure to rural roots styles highlighting the role of tradition in the social upheaval of mid century america gone to the country draws on extensive interviews and personal correspondence with band members and digs deep into the ramblers rich trove of recordings

egerton explores southern food in over 200 restaurants in 11 southern states describing each establishment s specialties and recounting his conversations with owners cooks waiters and customers includes more than 150 regional recipes

louisiana fiddlers shines light on sixty two of the bayou state s most accomplished fiddlers of the twentieth century author ron yule outlines the lives and times of these performers who represent a multitude of fiddling styles including cajun country western swing zydeco bluegrass irish contest fiddling and blues featuring over 150 photographs this volume provides insight into the fiddlin grounds of louisiana yule chronicles the musicians varied appearances from the stage of the louisiana hayride honky tonks dancehalls house dances radio and television and festivals to the front porch and other more casual venues the brief sketches include observations on musical travels recordings and family history nationally acclaimed fiddlers harry choates dewey balfa dennis mcgee michael doucet rufus thibodeaux and hadley castille share space with relatively unknown masters such as mastern brack cheese read john w daniel and fred beavers each player has helped shape the region s rich
