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this textbook offers a critical introduction to the study of africa drawing on scholarship from a range of academic disciplines a comprehensive discussion of the continent s geography and history provides a backdrop to broad ranging coverage of its social economic political and cultural composition as well as its future prospects moreover moving beyond the all too common tendency to view africa as a single homogeneous entity graham provides a nuanced overview that challenges preconceptions and stereotypes written in a sophisticated yet accessible style and supported by a range of pedagogical features this book introduces undergraduate students from a range of different disciplinary backgrounds to the contemporary study of africa

60 years after independence african nations still find it difficult to face a number of challenges from establishing meaningful democratic institutions to establish social structures centered on the advancement of gender equality this volume approaches these contemporary african challenges while

combating a reflexive and facile afro pessimism

this book explains how and why cities on the african continent have grown at such a rapid pace how municipal authorities have tried to cope with this massive influx of people and how long time urban residents and newcomers interact negotiate and struggle over access to limited resources

in our globalized world diseases originating in africa have become worldwide concerns health in contemporary africa examines the illnesses that affect people around the continent as well as the challenges countries face due to current infrastructure the book traces the transmission of disease and medical interventions while looking ahead to cutting edge technology and new advances poised to improve lives around africa

part one addresses theological foundations the five essays in this section deal with the bible theology and ecumenism the subjects of theological methods contextual hermeneutics and appropriate curriculum are given special attention of course even foundational issues cannot be discussed in a vacuum and so each of the essays addresses these foundational subjects in the light of african realities part two deals with contemporary issues it is particularly in this section that the traditional themes in african theology have been somewhat displaced by concerns which are today very pressing indeed three essays are devoted to the question of hiv aids this disease which has devastated the african continent demands a theological and practical response from those who claim to follow jesus christ if the churches do not respond to this crisis with energy and determination we should not be surprised if the next generation wonders whether the gospel has the power which we claim that it has two essays address the question of islam and muslim christian relations in africa the resurgence of islam in the world today is a concern of many for those who believe in jesus this is a challenge which demands much wisdom and love how should we respond to our muslim neighbours what are appropriate and thoughtful ways to share the love of christ two further essays appear under the title of the marginalized this could of course be a much large section those who suffer from aids could be included in this number and one might have expected to see at least one essay on the place of women in this volume however the disabled and youth are highlighted both groups are clearly in need of the attention of the churches and both groups are clearly misunderstood and neglected the final section of part two contains essays which focus attention on theological paedagogy all of the other contributions to this volume make suggestions and arguments about curriculum resources and issues of concern for theological educators the causal aim of this book is that these essays may help us to reflect in an intentional way on the implications of contemporary realities for the future of theological education

this timely account of politicized homophobia contests portrayals of the african continent as hopelessly homophobic highlighting how elites deploy it

nowadays the environment looms large in the analysis of conflict in developing societies and the precise role it plays is the subject of an ongoing debate the de bate has moved on from the earlier but still popular notions of power struggles class struggles and ethnic conflicts to a perception of conflict as the product of intense group competition for resources where the state controls the distribu tion of resources itself inevitably becomes party to conflicts whose bone of con tention is access to state power as the most efficient means of gaining access to resources the resources in question are social health education transportation communication recreation etc and material land

water housing jobs contracts licenses permits etc in parts of the world and especially in africa diminishing resources and authoritarian state rule exacerbate group competition leading to political confrontation this is the line i have followed in analysing conflict in the horn of africa markakis 1987 1998 mohamed salih's first contribution in this volume is to move the debate a step beyond this line which can be criticized as unduly materialist he does it by bringing culture into the realm of resources not only as a resource in itself but also as the agency that assigns natural resources their value culture thus becomes a contextual element in conflict over resources whose value is culturally determined

this book examines the various factors that have influenced the growth and development process of contemporary africa after discussing and weighing the schools of thought that have attempted to explain the paradox of africa's reduced growth and development in the midst of abundant resources this volume comes up with comprehensive and detailed suggestions and recommendations to address this painful experience this book consistently states that the average africans forming the overwhelming majority of the african population are the least if at all to be blamed for the paradox but rather the african leadership and its external cronies are to be fully blamed contemporary africa's growth and development seeks a solution to the african growth and development puzzle in proper allocation and oversight of resources vision perseverance courage corruption free and good governance as well as concrete provable solid and genuine unity

human rights in contemporary africa provides an in depth look at the current state of human rights across the continent the book explores the obstacles to human rights including the lingering effects of colonialism and imperialism which led to volatile political situations in many areas human rights in contemporary africa profiles activists and political regimes to provide context for the struggles countries around the continent face as they grapple with the issues of human safety security and dignity

contemporary africa and the foreseeable world order sheds light on the place of africa agency in the competitive and changing global system this book provides scholars policymakers and other stakeholders studying and working on african issues with innovative solutions strategies knowledge insights case studies and analyses to support decision making on how best african states should position themselves in the dynamic global system in order to influence key decisions featuring themes such as the african union au and the consequences of the discovery of oil in the non traditional oil exporting countries the editors and contributors have demonstrated why and how africa's position in the foreseeable world order is largely dependent on the influence of both existing and emerging world powers

war and terrorism in contemporary africa investigates how african conflicts fit into both regional and global geopolitical landscapes the book profiles terrorist organizations rebel groups and governments engaged in hostilities within the continent and beyond war and terrorism in contemporary africa also includes information about how these conflicts affect africans day to day lives

issues of homosexuality are the subject of public and political controversy in many african societies today frequently these controversies receive widespread attention both locally and globally such as with the anti homosexuality bill in uganda in the international media these cases tend to be presented as revealing a deeply rooted homophobia in africa fuelled by

religious and cultural traditions but so far little energy is expended in understanding these controversies in all their complexity and the critical role religion plays in them complementing the companion volume public religion and the politics of homosexuality in africa this book investigates christian politics and discourses on homosexuality in sub saharan africa the contributors present case studies from various african countries from nigeria to south africa and from cameroon to uganda focusing on pentecostal catholic and mainline protestant churches they critically examine popular christian theologies that perpetuate homophobia and discrimination but they also discuss contestations of such discourses and emerging alternative christian perspectives that contribute to the recognition of sexual diversity social justice and human rights in contemporary africa

based on ethnographic studies conducted in several african countries this volume analyses the phenomenon of deliverance which is promoted both in charismatic churches and in islam as a weapon against witchcraft in order to clarify the political dimensions of spiritual warfare in contemporary african societies deliverance from evil is part and parcel of the contemporary discourse on the struggle against witchcraft in most african contexts however contributors show how its importance extends beyond this highlighting a pluralism of approaches to deliverance in geographically distant religious movements which coexist in africa against this background the book reflects on the responsibilities of pentecostal deliverance politics within the condition of epistemic anxiety of contemporary african societies to shed light on complex relational dimensions in which individual deliverance is part of a wider social and spiritual struggle spanning across the study of religion healing and politics this book contributes to ongoing debates about witchcraft and deliverance in africa

the challenge of state formation and national integration is evident and the need for a solution is even more demanding in places like africa where nation states were formed under very special historical circumstances in perspectives on nation state formation in contemporary africa author godknows boladei igali presents a digest that examines the challenges of state formation and national integration in africa and offers preferred solutions within the context of the symbolic diversities in this study igali outlines the immediate context and challenges of national integration in africa in its human dimension he reviews the political formations of ancient africa which varied in size philosophical premise and organisational structures and discusses partition military invasions conquest and colonisation he then addresses colonial rule or administration african nationalism and decolonisation and analyses the process of nation state formation in post independent africa from the perspective of the political systems and ideologies reviewing a wide range of time from ancient times through the colonial period and since independence this survey discusses the processes of national integration and nation state formation in africa providing

perspectives that deepen the understanding of these nation building processes

in different but complementary ways the chapters in this collection provide a deeper understanding of socio cultural processes in various parts of the african continent they do so in the context of contemporary mediated processes of globalization and emphasize the agency of africans

this volume advances the discussions of leadership in africa s specific history culture economy and politics the book promotes an understanding of leadership and its paradoxes and illuminates the conditions under which political leadership has been produced and how those conditions have shaped leaders

this book discusses how the historical dimensions in kenya zimbabwe and south africa are similar dominated by oppressive settler colonialism and authoritarian independent governments their ruling elites characterised by greed and corruption zimbabwe is outstandingly oppressive plagued from the start by planned regularised ferocious and unparalleled violence as described in one chapter perpetrated by zanu pf and president robert mugabe it targeted the organised urban poor hope arose when the trade unions created the mdc in harare in 1999 a chapter on south africa is also included and outlines how a small anc elite chose external armed struggle around 1960 their campaign marooned thousands of young people in angolan camps for no military gains and the neglect of domestic political development a new and independent formation the united democratic front from 1983 tried to build a popular non racial participatory democracy however an intolerant anc was determined on its supremacy and nelson mandela suppressed the front in 1991 no similar democratic aspiration has subsequently appeared another country examined in this text is tunisia which since 2010 has been totally different utilising an organised civil society a democratic islamist party and wide readiness to compromise an open politics is being created against big odds

this book mediates a dialectics between power and subjectivity versus history and politics the invention of africa is not merely a residue of africa s encounter with europe but a project in continuity in contemporary history of africa where history has become a location of struggle and meaning a location of power and domination eze contends that postcolonial african studies that thrive by way of unanimity analogy or homogeneity are merely advancing a defeatist historicism it attempts to gain essence by inverting the terms of colonial discourse and is decisively implicated in the very logic of coloniality this method of historiography not only stifles the overall socio political imagination of contemporary africa but offers a dogmatic blueprint for politics of domination eze argues that a chance for an african renaissance is dependent on review mechanisms of african historiography

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
