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this book focuses on the interrelationship of social forces industrial expansion and conflict in europe between 1789 and 1945

examines modern theoretical interpretations of social change in relation to young people and provides an overview of their experiences in a number of key contexts such as education employment leisure health crime and politics this second edition offers introductory text for students in sociology of youth sociology of education and more

market reform financial decentralization and economic globalization have greatly accentuated china s social and regional inequalities education is expected to address these inequalities in a context of rapid social change including the rise of an urban middle class changed status of women resurgence of ethnic identities growing rural to urban migration and lingering poverty in remote areas but some argue that state policies have not sufficiently addressed inequitable practices and that schools actually perpetuate and reproduce inequities giving rise to a new

system of social stratification driven more by market forces than socialist principles featuring all original previously unpublished material this volume examines this argument through analysis of selected aspects of educational stratification in china during the reform era chapters focus on the new urban middle class poor rural residents the migrant population in urban areas rural girls and ethnic minorities the contributors are established scholars in the field and they build a conceptual framework for assessing the degree to which china s educational reforms are inclusive equitable and integrative across social categories and groups

this book compares from a historical and sociopolitical perspective the respective systems and contents of music education in mainland china hong kong and taiwan in response to globalization localization and sinification with particular reference to shanghai hong kong and taipei

first published in 1988 this book argues that there is a growing structural crisis in the provision of housing in advanced capitalist countries and that the steady improvement in housing conditions since 1945 is unlikely to continue the dilemmas facing housing policy makers can no longer be seen as concerned just with distributional questions but with problems generated by the restructuring of key elements of housing provision including private housing finance and the housebuilding industry it looks at housing markets housing policies and specific institutions connected with housing provision in many advanced capitalist countries including britain the usa france west germany the netherlands and denmark it considers the different sectors and the changes taking place there using case study material where appropriate to support its varied and convincing arguments

democratizing educational access and building capacity in developing countries and amongst indigenous peoples in developed countries may be elusive but are hopeful goals many developing countries are striving to reengineer their incoherent education systems at a time when they are most vulnerable particularly with susceptibility to natural disasters political unrests and economic instabilities unesco 2007 similarly indigenous peoples in developed countries are seeking more control over education as they consider the long term effects of educational policies that have been forced on them research on education and social change in developing countries has a long history glewwe 2002 hanushek 1995 sider 2011 however there is limited research on educational capacity building in developing countries such as kenya honduras haiti ghana hong kong india peru china and thailand further the educational frameworks by which indigenous peoples in mori canada s first nations and american indian alaska natives have been educated have some significant similarities to those encountered in developing countries the compilation of chapters illuminates research and collaborative initiatives between the authors and local leaders in developing countries and indigenous peoples in developed countries efforts to solve the complexity of social inequities through educational access and quality learning the authors draw on theoretical lens knowledge bases and strategies and identify trends and developments to provide the scope of educational improvement in a globalization context brooks normore 2010 jean marie normore brooks 2009

herbert blumer wrote continuously and voluminously and consequently left a vast array of unpublished work at the time of his death in 1987 this posthumously published volume testifies further to his perceptive analysis of large scale social organizations and elegant application of symbolic interactionist principles blumer s focus on the processual nature of social life and on the significance of the communicative interpretation of social contexts is manifest in his theory of industrialization and social change his theory entails three major points industrialization must be seen in processual terms and the industrialization process is different for different historical periods the consequences of industrialization are a function of the interpretive nature of human action and resembles a neutral framework within which groups interpret the meaning of industrial relations and the industrial sector must be viewed in terms of power relations industrial societies contain inherently conflicting interests the editors introductory essay outlines blumer s metatheoretical stance symbolic interactionism and its emphasis on the adjustive character of social life it places blumer s theory in the context of contemporary macro theory including world systems theory resource dependence theory and modernization theory herbert blumer 1900 1987 formerly chairperson department of sociology at the university of california berkeley was the theoretical and methodological leader of symbolic interactionism and was identified as its foremost proponent for a half century his publications include works on industrial relations research methods mass society collective behavior race relations and social movements david r maines is chairman of the department of anthropology and sociology at oakland university he has worked to articulate an interactionist approach to the study of social organization as well as the fundamental relevance of temporality and communication for sociological analysis thomas j morrione is charles a dana professor of sociology at colby college and he is currently chair of the department of sociology and anthropology at the college he was a research associate 1977 1985 and visiting professor 1984 at the university of california berkeley
