the sensory profile provides a standard method for professionals to measure a child s sensory processing abilities and to profile the effect of sensory processing on functional performance in the daily life of a child it is a judgment based

caregiver questionnaire each item describes children's response to various sensory experiences the caregiver who has daily contact with the child completes the questionnaire by reporting the frequency with which these behaviors occur therapist or other professional then scores the responses on the questionnaire
