richter's history and records of baseball the american nation's chief sport originally published in 1914 is the most comprehensive and ambitious among the early books about baseball this volume richter writes is designed to supply the growing need of a concise yet complete record of our national game and to serve this purpose in such a form as to make it valuable possibly indispensable as a book of special information of ready reference and of general interest to all lovers and students of the great game the book is divided into three parts part i covers the origins of baseball the first professional league the national and american leagues the american association baseball tours warring leagues the world series and the minor leagues part ii includes team and individual performance records through 1914 richter's takes on the great pitchers of early baseball and brief commentary on two classic poems inspired by the game part iii includes the history and text of the first national agreement the development of baseball playing rules and information on the pioneering players owners executives and writers

regarded by many of his contemporaries as the greatest baseball player of all time john peter honus wagner enjoyed a remarkable career with the pittsburgh pirates his record of 17 consecutive 300 plus seasons is a mark that will probably never be broken he led the national league eight times in hitting six times in slugging percentage and five times in stolen bases known as the flying dutchman he also excelled in the field defining the shortstop position for a generation though one of the original inductees in the baseball hall of fame he has often been overlooked by baseball fans and historians a humble man whose biggest passions were hunting and fishing the pirate shortstop lacked the flamboyance of a ty cobb or babe ruth he rarely smoked or drank though he sometimes indulged in a sandlot game with the neighborhood kids based on contemporary newspaper accounts family scrapbooks and correspondence and wagner's own vest pocket notebooks this is the story of baseball's first superstar

whether football or baseball golf or track sports have played an important part in cleveland's history bob feller jesse owens bill veeck larry doby lou boudreau jim brown bob lemon hank greenberg they are only a few of the hundreds of personalities who have made cleveland one of the great sports capitals in the country over 150 photographs bring alive the proud tradition of sports in cleveland the book written with a keen interpretive sense documents how sports began from disorganized confined contests to their present incarnations as near religions the plain dealer

what can possibly account for the strange state of affairs in professional sports today there are billionaire owners and millionaire players but both groups are constantly squabbling over money many pro teams appear to be virtual cash machines generating astronomical annual revenues but their owners seem willing to uproot them and move to any city willing to promise increased profits at the same time mayors continue to cook up sweetheart deals that lavish benefits on wealthy teams while imposing crushing financial hardships on cities that are

already strapped with debt to fans today professional sports teams often look more like professional extortionists in hard ball james quirk and rodney fort take on a daunting challenge explaining exactly how things have gotten to this point and proposing a way out both authors are professional economists who specialize in the economics of sports their previous book pay dirt the business of professional team sports is widely acknowledged as the bible of sports economics here however they are writing for sports fans who are trying to make sense out of the perplexing world of pro team sports it is not money in itself that is the cause of today s problems they assert in fact the real problem stems from one simple fact pro sports are monopolies that are fully sanctioned by the u s government eliminate the monopolies say quirk and fort and all problems can be solved if the monopolies are allowed to persist so will today s woes the authors discuss all four major pro team sports baseball football basketball and hockey hard ball is filled with anecdotes case studies and factual information that are brought together here for the first time quirk and fort devote chapters to the main protagonists in the pro sports saga media unions players owners politicians and leagues before they offer their own prescription for correcting the ills that afflict sports today the result is an engaging and persuasive book that is sure to be widely read cited and debated it is essential reading for every fan

cleveland and the surrounding area was home to one of the earliest and most active baseball scenes outside of the eastern seaboard this extraordinarily detailed history combines author commentary with first hand accounts to document baseball s rapid development and popularization in the region during the decades following the civil war ordered chronologically and then geographically by town chapters follow the game s rise from the earliest reports on ball in 1841 to the era of loosely organized town to town rivalries and semipro clubs and finally through the early era of the professional and eventually major league sport

august garry herrmann entered the murky waters of 19th century machine politics in cincinnati serving as a trusted lieutenant to one of the most powerful political bosses in the country george b cox herrmann a gifted man who introduced modern management principles to municipal government and oversaw the committee that built cincinnati s modern water works system eventually did for baseball what he did for his home town guiding it into a new century along with george b cox and cincinnati mayor julius fleischmann herrmann bought the cincinnati reds from john t brush in 1902 by 1903 he had chaired the peace conference between the leagues that ushered in the modern game with the leagues united herrmann was selected to head up the national commission a three person ruling body that governed major league baseball in the years before the commissionership

in an era of unique baseball stadiums the polo grounds in new york stood out from the rest with its horseshoe shape the polo grounds had extremely short distances down the foul lines and equally long distances up the alley and to center field some of baseball s most historic moments bobby thomson s shot heard round the world willie mays catch fred merkle s

infamous blunder happened at the polo grounds this book offers descriptive text and photographs that give a sense of the glory of this classic ballpark additionally it contains historical articles and memories submitted by more than 70 former players who played at the polo grounds

national league players planned revolt as the crowds swelled hoping to take advantage of baseball's growing popularity the season became as one sportswriter said something approaching a lobster frankenstein nightmare book jacket

the 1908 american league pennant race was described as a fierce and fluctuating fight with five games left in the season each of the league's four westernmost teams still had a shot at the championship it was the height of the deadball era noted for its spectacular pitching low scoring quickly played games and memorable characters it was also a time when professional baseball truly came into its own as america's national pastime this lively account

details a neglected chapter in the game's history

new major leagues have sprung up throughout the history of baseball both long term successes the American and National Leagues and the transitory of which the Federal League 1914-15 and the Mexican League 1946 were two some leagues were born of noble motives the Union Association 1884 to abolish the reserve clause others farcical the Global League 1969 and many were stillborn never playing that first inning such as the Continental League 1959-60 here is their history and an analysis of the conditions that determined success or failure this is a first class work in the comprehensive baseball history category and belongs on the shelf along with those impressive volumes of Harold Seymour and David Voigt Society for American Baseball Research SABR Bibliography Committee Newsletter well researched worthy library journal

this is the first full length biography of Kid Nichols 1869-1953 who won 30 or more games a record seven times and was the youngest pitcher to reach 300 career victories much new light is shed on Nichols early life in Madison Wisconsin along with important influences and experiences as a teenager living in Kansas City Nichols professional career is documented by drawing heavily from publications of the era and his own words the high regard in which he was held by fans teammates and even opponents is contrasted with his contentious relationship with team owners Nichols period of restlessness ambition and risk taking following his long stint with Boston's National League team is detailed as is the campaign to get him into the Hall of Fame the book includes previously unpublished photos from his descendants archives many more than a century old

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
