dracunculiasis also known as guinea worm disease is caused by infection with the parasitic nematode the guinea worm in may 1986 the thirty ninth world health assembly declared global elimination i e eradication of dracunculiasis as a goal the global dracunculiasis eradication campaign through community based interventions has reduced the burden of the disease from an estimated 3.5 million
