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over the last fifty years the music of jōji yuasa has attained the zenith of international musical standards a study of this great japanese composer is long overdue persuasive and captivating less easy than that of his lifetime friend tōru takemitsu yuasa s music has also been a model for many young composers both from japan and further afield thanks to the long period he spent teaching composition at the university of california san diego 1981 1994 this book serves to illuminate aspects of yuasa s work intricately linked to deep native roots which tend to be more opaque for western and other ears it focusses on various aspects of yuasa s music as well as on the social anthropological aesthetic and critical contexts that have informed his compositional practice in the context of the postwar japanese musical world in a continual interior dialogue which includes jean paul sartre and daisetz t suzuki matsuo bashō and william faulkner henry miller and motokiyo zeami yuasa s avant garde aesthetic project western in conception encounters the productive thought of an unambiguously japanese aesthetic i e that of zen an analysis of yuasa s main works will illustrate and complete the picture of yuasa s world yuasa s works are placed at the centre of the most original of creative forces in the contemporary music world a place where for yuasa in the same idea of creativity there has to be an avant garde component

now appearing in an english translation this book by szymon paczkowski is the first in depth exploration of the polish style in the music of johann sebastian bach bach spent almost thirty years living and working in leipzig in saxony a country ruled by friedrich august i and his son friedrich august ii who were also kings of poland as august ii and august iii this period of close polish saxon relations left a significant imprint on bach s music paczkowski s meticulous account of this complex political and cultural dynamic sheds new light on many of bach s familiar pieces the book explores the semantic and rhetorical functions that undergird the symbolism of the polish style in baroque music it demonstrates how the notion of a polish style in music was developed in german music theory and conjectures that bach s successful application for the title of court composer at the court of the elector of saxony and king of poland would induce the composer to deliberately use elements of the polish style this comprehensive study of the way bach used the polish style in his music moves beyond technical analysis to place the pieces within the context of baroque customs and discourse this ambitious and inspiring study is an original contribution to the scholarly conversation concerning bach s music focusing on the symbolism of the polonaise the most popular and recognizable polish dance in 18th century saxony in saxony at this time the polonaise was associated with the ceremonies of the royal electoral court in dresden and saxon musicians regarded it as a musical symbol of royalty paczkowski explores this symbolism of the polish royal dance in bach s instrumental music and which is also to be found to an even greater extent in his vocal works the polish style in the music of johann sebastian bach provides wide ranging interpretations based on a careful analysis of the sources explored within historical and theological context the book is a valuable source for both teaching and further research and will find readers not only among musicologists but also historians art historians and readers in cultural studies all lovers of bach s music will appreciate this lucid and intriguing study

the 4 seasons frankie valli rank among the top american vocal acts of all time collectively they amassed seven 1 hits 18 top ten and an incredible 61 singles in the hot 100 they also placed 32 lps on the top albums charts their hit making years spanned more than a half century their hits include sherry big girls don t cry walk like a man rag doll working my way back to you can t take my eyes off of you my eyes adored you december 1963 oh what a night grease their stardom was no overnight success as they struggled through lean years and recorded many flops while searching for that elusive hit record the rag to riches story has been told via an award winning broadway musical a clint eastwood produced motion picture learn about the hits misses obscure album tracks and b sides as they sang their way from delinquents to esteemed members of the r r hall of fame the book examines the music they made famous and tells of all the glorious years that passed between

this book traces the development of music in the late 20th and early 21st centuries with regards to the work of six women composers sofia gubaidulina joan tower ellen taaffe zwilich libby larsen chen yi and judith weir the study integrates cultural contexts with the composers biographies their diverse compositional styles and provides in depth analyses of their musical works the kaleidoscope of women s sounds in music of the late 20th and early 21st centuries offers a more detailed guide to not only these composers but also their musical characters and styles than previous studies on women s music it discusses several aspects of these women s compositional perspectives and their personal experiences as they developed their music careers the book also places emphasis on how these composers incorporated diverse musical styles and the idioms of others into the development of their own distinctly personal styles the analytical approach adopted in this book is supplemented with illustrations of musical examples in order to provide a more complete understanding of the work of these composers

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
