In addition, the book offers best practices for fostering optimal development for individual infants and high-risk populations while raising standards for neonatal care and creating a smooth transition to appropriate subsequent care. Topics featured in this book include developmental care in the nursery, utilizing neonatal brain imaging to predict neurodevelopmental outcomes of NICU infants, genetic considerations in infants with congenital anomalies, the HRIF clinic organization model, issues common in neurodevelopmental testing of premature infants, the impact of environmental risks such as parental distress and in utero drug exposure on infant neurodevelopment. Follow-up for NICU graduates is a must-have resource for researchers, practitioners, and graduate students in developmental psychology, pediatrics, neuroscience, obstetrics, nursing, and related disciplines.
