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this reference grammar provides for the first time a description of the grammar of mandarin chinese the official spoken language of china and taiwan in functional terms focusing on the role and meanings of word level and sentence level structures in actual conversations

ute is a uto aztecan language of the northernmost numic branch currently spoken on three reservations in western colorado and eastern utah like many other native languages of northern america ute is severely endangered this book is part of the effort toward its preservation typologically ute offers a cluster of intriguing features best viewed from the

perspective of diachronic change and grammaticalization the book presents a comprehensive synchronic description of grammatical structures and their communicative functions as well as a diachronic account of a grammar in the midst of change the book is the first of a 3 volume series which also includes a collection of oral texts and a dictionary ute speakers and tribal members may find in the present volume a step by step description of how words are combined into meaningful communication linguists may find a detailed account of one language an account that is unabashedly informed by universals of grammar communication and change

role and reference grammar rrg is a theory of language in which linguistic structures are accounted for in terms of the interplay of discourse semantics and syntax with contributions from a team of leading scholars this handbook provides a field defining overview of rrg assuming no prior knowledge it introduces the framework step by step and includes a pedagogical guide for instructors it features in depth discussions of syntax morphology and lexical semantics including treatments of lexical and grammatical categories the syntax of simple clauses and complex sentences and how the linking of syntax with semantics and discourse works in each of these domains it illustrates rrg s contribution to the study of language acquisition language change and processing computational linguistics and neurolinguistics and also contains five grammatical sketches which show how rrg analyses work in practice comprehensive yet accessible it is essential reading for anyone who is interested in how grammar interfaces with meaning

bislama is the national language of vanuatu the world s most linguistically diverse nation with at least 80 actively spoken oceanic languages used by about 200 000 people bislama began as a plantation pidgin based on english in the nineteenth century but it has since developed into a unique language with a grammar and vocabulary very different from english it is one of very few national languages for which there is no readily available reference grammar this book aims to fill this gap by providing an extensive account of the grammar of bislama as it is used by ordinary ni vanuatu it does not therefore aim to describe any kind of artificial written norm but sets out to capture a range of different kinds of ways that ni vanuatu will say things in various contexts both written and spoken formal and informal the thrust of this volume is to show that bislama has a grammar an unfamiliar concept for those educated in vanuatu it also shows that bislama is a language of considerable complexity which will come as a surprise to many of its users who have been taught to view their language as somehow simple and even deficient

when laurence thompson s original vietnamese grammar first appeared in 1965 it went almost instantly to the top of the list of required reading for serious students of the vietnamese

language it has stayed there ever since but in recent years the title has become almost impossible to find either in bookstores or in libraries where original copies have often grown woefully ragged and marked up or are now simply missing in the meanwhile the author has become aware of a number of minor infelicities and typographical errors requiring correction thus both demand and scholarship have dictated this re edition from the editor s note

a reference grammar of french is a lively wide ranging and original handbook on the structure of the french language it includes new information on register pronunciation gender number foreign words latin arabic english spanish italian adjectives and past participles used as nouns texting word order frequency of occurrence of words and usage with all geographical names examples come not only from france but also from quebec belgium and switzerland readers will appreciate the initial passages illustrating the grammatical features of a given chapter also included is a user friendly introduction to the french language from its latin origins to modern times a full glossary explains any terms that might confuse the less experienced reader and the index leads the student through the detailed labyrinth of grammatical features this handbook will be an invaluable resource for students and teachers who want to perfect their knowledge of all aspects of french grammar
