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this book provides an analysis of the english american french and russian revolutions as they exhibit universally applicable patterns of revolutionary thought and action

this study aims to update a classic of comparative revolutionary analysis crane brinton s 1938 study the anatomy of revolution it invokes the latest research and theoretical writing in history political science and political sociology to compare and contrast in their successive phases the english revolution of 1640 60 the french revolution of 1789 99 and the russian revolution of 1917 29 this book intends to do what no other comparative analysis of revolutionary change has yet adequately done it not only progresses beyond marxian socioeconomic class analysis and early revisionist stresses on short term accidental factors involved in revolutionary causation and process it also finds ways to reconcile state centered structuralist accounts of the three major european revolutions with postmodernist explanations of those upheavals that play up the centrality of human

agency revolutionary discourse mentalities ideology and political culture

a theoretical account of moral revolutions illustrated by historical cases that include the criminalization and decriminalization of abortion and the patient rebellion against medical paternalism we live in an age of moral revolutions in which the once morally outrageous has become morally acceptable and the formerly acceptable is now regarded as reprehensible attitudes toward same sex love for example and the proper role of women have undergone paradigm shifts over the last several decades in this book robert baker argues that these inversions are the product of moral revolutions that follow a pattern similar to that of the scientific revolutions analyzed by thomas kuhn in his influential book the structure of scientific revolutions after laying out the theoretical terrain baker develops his argument with examples of moral reversals from the recent and distant past he describes the revolution led by the utilitarian philosopher jeremy bentham that transformed the postmortem dissection of human bodies from punitive desecration to civic virtue the criminalization of abortion in the nineteenth century and its decriminalization in the twentieth century and the invention of a new bioethics paradigm in the 1970s and 1980s supporting a patient led rebellion against medical paternalism finally baker reflects on moral relativism arguing that the acceptance of absolute moral truths denies us the diversity of moral perspectives that permit us to alter our morality in response to changing environments

the 21st century has witnessed a considerable and increasing number of political revolutions around the world this contradicts the popular belief of many experts in the 1970s that revolutions occurred mainly in monarchies and empires instead the revolutions of this century have several new characteristics which call for a renewed analysis of the subject this handbook offers a comparative perspective on the new wave of revolutions of the last decade presenting case studies on the color revolutions the arab revolutions of 2010 2011 and the global wave of revolutions in 2013 2018 that spanned regions ranging from africa to the caucasus it offers a better understanding of the varied forms features and historical backgrounds of revolutions as well as their causes accordingly it highlights recent revolutions in their historical and world systems contexts the handbook is divided into seven parts the first of which examines the history of views on revolution and important aspects of the theory of revolution the second part analyzes revolutions within long term historical trends and in their world system contexts in turn the third part explores specific major revolutionary waves in history the fourth part analyzes the first revolutionary wave of the 21st century 2000 2009 the so called color revolutions while the fifth discusses the second wave the arab spring 2010 2013 as an important turning point the sixth part is dedicated to analyzing revolutions and revolutionary movements beyond the arab spring and some revolutionary events from the third wave that began in 2018 the seventh and final part offers forecasts on the future of revolutions given its scope the book will appeal to scholars and students from various disciplines interested in historical trends sociopolitical change contentious politics social movements and revolutionary processes involving both nonviolent campaigns and political violence once again this volume demonstrates the kind of open minded systematic analysis that the field of revolutionary studies requires prof george lawson department of international relations australian national university canberra

this is volume xvii of eighteen of a series on the sociology of behaviour and psychology first published in 1962 this study offers a theoretical synthesis of collective behavior

the triumphant return of a book that gave us permission to throw out the rulebook in activities ranging from play to architecture to revolution when this book first appeared in 1972 it was part of the spirit that would define a new architecture and design era a new way of thinking ready to move beyond the purist doctrines and formal models of modernism charles jencks and nathan silver s book was a manifesto for a generation that took pleasure in doing things ad hoc using materials at hand to solve real world problems the implications were subversive turned off citizens of the 1970s immediately adopted the book as a diy guide the word adhocism entered the vocabulary the concept of adhocism became part of the designer s toolkit and adhocism became a cult classic now adhocism is available again with new texts by jencks and silver reflecting on the past forty years of adhocism and new illustrations demonstrating adhocism s continuing relevance adhocism has always been around think robinson crusoe making a raft and then a shelter from the wreck of his ship as a design principle adhocism starts with everyday improvisations a bottle as a candleholder a dictionary as a doorstep a tractor seat on wheels as a dining room chair but it is also an undeveloped force within the way we approach almost every activity from play to architecture to city planning to political revolution engagingly written filled with pictures and examples from areas as diverse as auto mechanics and biology adhocism urges us to pay less attention to the rulebook and more to the real principle of how we actually do things it declares that problems are not necessarily solved in a genius s eureka moment but by trial and error adjustment and readjustment

revolutions finished and unfinished from primal to final is an important philosophical contribution to the study of revolution it not only makes new contributions to the study of particular revolutions but to developing a philosophy of revolution itself many of the contributors have been inspired by the philosophical approaches of eric voegelin or eugen rosenstock huessy and the tension between these two social philosophies adds to the philosophical uniqueness and richness of the work

the long term implications of such revolutions for women in the usa and in other countries this book briefly outlines the stage by stage progression of events in the english french and russian revolutions thus enabling the general reader to contextualize more easily its discussion of women s revolutionary experiences in those countries this book reappraises the relative importance ascribable to gendered cultural and to statist geopolitical factors through the disastrous revolutionary careers of three consort queens i e henrietta maria of england marie antoinette of france and alexandra feodorovna of russia by contrasting their political failings with the political acumen of three earlier regnant queens in these three countries i e elizabeth i catharine de mēdicis and catherine ii the great finally this book demonstrates how women of humble social station used these unheard of revolutionary situations either to express their grievances and voice their social aspirations or on the other hand to reaffirm their long held allegiance to traditional principles customs and religion it concludes by discussing race ethnicity and statism as challenging issues that need to be confronted in any current discussion of women s revolutionary experiences

prior to 2011 popular imagination perceived the muslim middle east as unchanging and unchangeable frozen in its own traditions and history in life as politics asef bayat argues that such presumptions fail to recognize the routine yet important ways in which ordinary people make meaningful change through everyday actions first published just months before the arab spring swept across the region this timely and prophetic book sheds light on the ongoing acts of protest practice and direct daily action the second edition includes three new chapters on the arab spring and iran s green movement and is fully updated to reflect recent events at heart the book remains a study of agency in times of constraint in addition to ongoing protests millions of people across the middle east are effecting transformation through the discovery and creation of new social spaces within which to make their claims heard this eye opening book makes an important contribution to global debates over the meaning of social movements and the dynamics of social change

that voice is the subject of this book

britain has not been successfully invaded since 1066 nor in nearly 1 000 years has it known a true revolution one that brings radical systemic and enduring change the contrast with britain s european neighbours france germany italy spain greece russia is dramatic all have been convulsed by external warfare revolution and civil war and experienced fundamental change to their ruling elites or social and economic structures frank mclynn takes seven occasions when britain came closest to revolution the peasants revolt of 1381 the jack cade rebellion of 1450 the pilgrimage of grace in 1536 the english civil wars of the 1640s the jacobite rising of 1745 6 the chartist movement of 1838 48 and the general strike of 1926 why at these dramatic turning points did history finally fail to turn mclynn examines britain s history and themes of social religious and political change to explain why social turbulence stopped short of revolution on so many occasions

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
