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this story begins with the journey of life to a mother s womb the child would then be named aishwarya fondly called aishu and aish aish lived in a hostel from the age of three while her living parents went on to create other lives without her how did she face the world as a lone young girl with a stamp of being unwanted how did the world respond to the expression of her will

this good girl did everything right for years so why has everything gone so wrong for this self made business woman realtor and mother of two on a hot day in august she s arrested for car jacking assault with a deadly weapon and robbery she s just landed in the incarceration without a passport like the millions of women who came before her she wants to leave the land of chain link and barbed wire behind her fifty nine days later this good girl gone bad walks out a free woman or so she thinks this good girl gone bad wants to help you stay out of jail know how to use your rights understand the court process plea down your charges to minimize the risk of re arrest understand how a conviction affects your future beyond bars filled with good advice from bad girls on the inside and criminal law attorneys who tell it like it is cover your assets with these legal forms and others you didn t know you needed they re easy to fill in and are ready for the notary public power of attorney caregiver s authorization affidavit temporary custody order letter to cps social worker consent for international travel

while k c struggles with sexual development dysfunction hearing loss and depression that impact her young adult years she battles with her family her belief in god and society as a whole regarding what is normal for a woman traumatic events affect her deeply and the emotional pain leads to drug alcohol food and sex addictions k c gets sober in her junior year of high school but sobriety alone is not enough when she finds out that she is miraculously pregnant it is a wake up call she goes through a period of self awareness and eventually turns her bad girl actions into experiences she can use to become a good mother k c recognizes that she could have killed herself or given up hope but she did not instead she persevered sought help and united with others who battled similar demons she celebrates her success and challenges readers of all ages to liberate their secrets

this collection of essays focuses on the representations of a variety of bad girls women who challenge refuse or transgress the patriarchal limits intended to circumscribe them in television popular fiction and mainstream film from the mid twentieth century to the present perhaps not surprisingly the initial introduction of women into western cultural narrative coincides with the introduction of transgressive women from the beginning for good or ill women have been depicted as insubordinate today s popular manifestations include such widely known figures as lisbeth salander the girl with the dragon tattoo the walking dead s michonne and the queen bees of teen television series while the existence and prominence of transgressive women has continued uninterrupted however attitudes towards them have varied considerably it is those attitudes that are explored in this collection at the same time these essays place feminist

postfeminist analysis in a larger context entering into ongoing debates about power equality sexuality and gender

the longest running war is the battle over how women should behave conduct books and the history of the ideal woman examines six centuries of advice literature analyzing the print origins of gendered expectations that continue to inform our thinking about women's roles and abilities close readings of numerous conduct manuals from Britain and America written by men and women explain and contextualize the legacy of sexism as represented in prescriptive writing for women from 1372 to the present while existing period specific studies of conduct manuals consider advice literature within the society that wrote and read them conduct books and the history of the ideal woman provides the only analysis of both the volumes themselves and the larger debates taking place within their pages across the centuries combining textual literary analysis with a social history sensibility while remaining accessible to expert and novice this book will help readers understand the ongoing debate about the often contradictory guidelines for female behavior

cottingham s writings investigate central tensions currently operative in the production distribution and evaluation of art especially those related to cultural production by and about women

good girls bad girls of the new testament takes readers on a powerful journey through the vast landscape of roman occupied judea during the first century and the genesis of christianity this landscape serves as the backdrop for twelve amazing stories of women whose paths intersect either by providence or design with the paths of jesus or paul some of these women are familiar such as mary the mother of jesus while others like the wife of the infamous pontius pilate are lesser known whether she is popular or obscure good or bad each woman s story is an important part of the overall christian narrative good girls bad girls of the new testament invites readers to take a more nuanced look at twelve stories that feature women to explore their lives more deeply in historical context and to understand the real story that includes both men and women the book goes beyond simply telling the story of a particular biblical woman to challenge readers to explore the enduring lessons the ancient writers sought to impart these timeless lessons are as important for us today as they were thousands of years ago

this dramatic rereading of postmodernism seeks to broaden current theoretical conceptions of the movement as both a social philosophical condition and a literary and cultural phenomenon phil harper contends that the fragmentation considered to be characteristic of the postmodern age can in fact be traced to the status of marginalized groups in the united states since long before the contemporary era this status is reflected in the work of american writers from the thirties through the fifties whom harper addresses in this study including nathanael west anaïs nin djuna barnes ralph ellison and gwendolyn brooks treating groups that are disadvantaged or disempowered whether by circumstance of gender race or sexual orientation the writers profiled here occupy the cusp between the modern and the postmodern between the recognizably modernist aesthetic of alienation and the fragmented disordered sensibility of postmodernism proceeding through close readings of these literary texts in relation to various mass cultural productions harper examines the social placement of the texts in the scope of literary history while analyzing more minutely the interior effects of marginalization implied by the fictional characters enacting these narratives in particular he demonstrates how these works represent

the experience of social marginality as highly fractured and fracturing and indicates how such experience is implicated in the phenomenon of postmodernist fragmentation harper thus accomplishes the vital task of recentering cultural focus on issues and groups that are decentered by very definition and thereby specifies the sociopolitical significance of postmodernism in a way that has not yet been done

women s transgressive behaviors and perspectives are challenging societal norms in the arab world giving rise to anxiety and public debate simultaneously however other arab women are unwillingly finding themselves labeled bad as authority figures attempt to redirect scrutiny from serious social ills such as patriarchy and economic exploitation or as they impose new restrictions on women s behavior in response to uncertainty and change in society bad girls of the arab world elucidates how both intentional and unintentional transgressions make manifest the social and cultural constructs that define proper and improper behavior as well as the social and political policing of gender racial and class divisions the works collected here address the

experiences of women from a range of ages classes and educational backgrounds who live in the arab world and beyond they include short pieces in which the women themselves reflect on their experiences with transgression academic articles about performance representation activism history and social conditions an artistic intervention and afterwords by the acclaimed novelists laila al atrash and miral al tahawy the book demonstrates that women s transgression is both an agent and a symptom of change a site of both resistance and repression showing how transnational forces such as media discourses mobility and confinement globalization and neoliberalism as well as the legacy of colonialism shape women s badness bad girls of the arab world offers a rich portrait of women s varied experiences at the boundaries of propriety in the twenty first century

in feminist politics intersectionality and knowledge cultivation radhika govinda engages with intersectionality as critical theory as critical methodology and as critical pedagogy to make sense of feminist politics in india and beyond and knowledge making on feminist politics as such in doing so she makes a case for theory making conducting empirical research and classroom teaching to be understood as integral parts of knowledge cultivation each feeding into the other differently put the book encapsulates govinda s engagement spanning fifteen years and four case studies exploring what insights an intersectional lens throws up and how these insights complicate our understandings of marginality privilege and solidarity in the field of women s and gender studies in feminist classrooms in women s and social movements in particular ngo led feminist activism state led development initiatives and digital feminist campaigns and in everyday social relations in rural and urban spaces uncovering interrogating and disrupting the politics of coloniality and feminist complicity is an important running thread in the book through a reflexive account of her own location and practice in the academy at the cusp of the global north and the global south govinda highlights the importance of being attentive to intersectional positionality and to the contextual specificities of engaging in feminist politics and knowledge making in the age of global neoliberalism

ends of assimilation examines how chicano literature imagines the conditions and costs of cultural change arguing that its thematic preoccupation with assimilation illuminates the function of literature john alba cutler shows how mid century sociologists advanced a model of assimilation that ignored the interlinking of race gender and sexuality and characterized american culture as homogeneous stable and exceptional he demonstrates how chicano literary works from the postwar period to the present understand culture as dynamic and self

consciously promote literature as a medium for influencing the direction of cultural change with original analyses of works by canonical and noncanonical writers from am rico paredes sandra cisneros and jimmy santiago baca to estela portillo trambley alfredo v a and patricia santana ends of assimilation demands that we reevaluate assimilation literature and the very language we use to talk about culture
