through her unique documentary output twala marked herself as a radical voice on issues of gender race and class the literary gatekeepers of the racist and sexist society of twentieth century southern africa clamped down by literally writing her out of the region s history written out also scrutinizes the troubled racial politics of african history as a discipline that has been historically dominated by white academics a situation that many people within the field are now examining critically inspired by this recent movement cabrita interrogates what it means for her a white historian based in the northern hemisphere to tell the story of a black african woman far from a laudable recovery of an important lost figure cabrita acknowledges that her biography inevitably reproduces old dynamics of white scholarly privilege and dominance cabrita s narration of twala s career resurrects it but also reminds us that twala tragically is still not the author of her own life story
