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working within a global frame the routledge companion to postcolonial and decolonial literature considers postcolonial and decolonial literary works across multiple genres languages and both regional and transnational networks the companion extends beyond the entrenched hegemony of the postcolonial or anglophone novel to explore other literary formations and vernacular exchanges it foregrounds questions of language and circulation by emphasizing translation vernacularity and world literature this text expands the linguistic regional and critical foci of the emergent field of decolonial studies pushing against the normative currents of postcolonial literary studies and offers a critical consideration of both the volume prioritizes new literatures and critical theories of diasporas borderlands detentions and forced migrations in the face of environmental catastrophe and political authoritarianism reframing postcolonial decolonial literary studies through an emphasis on multilingual literatures this will be a crucial resource for undergraduate and graduate students of postcolonial and decolonial studies

the term feminism is often treated as a stable and universalizing politics and practice for postcolonial feminism the issues of interest are not only social and cultural inequalities in terms of caste class color ethnicity gender and religion but also historical political and geographical inequalities in terms of third world global south and remnants of the colonial past postcolonial feminism pays nuanced attention to historical diversity and local specificity of feminist issues this book draws upon the work grounded specifically in the context of india pakistan and bangladesh to demonstrate the plurality of thinking in mainstream management and organization studies context is often understood as a present static field this book discusses how context is an important consideration for any management and organization study and for feminist studies in management and organization studies it informs the way we need to understand context not just as present but also as past postcolonial feminism highlights the historical roots and past privileges of a context that often gets overlooked in management and organization studies where context is mostly understood in the present this book highlights the contributions of women writers poets and activists such as christina stringer elena samonova gayatri spivak mary douglas naila kabeer and uzma falak to postcolonial feminism in management and organization studies each of these women has engaged with writing that has the potential to enrich and transform understanding of postcolonial feminism in management and organization studies making this book a valuable resource for researchers

how can western modernity be analyzed and critiqued through the lens of enslavement and colonial history the volume maps out answers to this question from the fields of postcolonial decolonial and black studies delineating converging and diverging positions approaches and trajectories it assembles contributions by renowned scholars of the respective fields intervening in history sociology political sciences gender studies cultural and literary studies and philosophy

a quarter of a century after the fall of the berlin wall and from the vantage point of a post cold war globalised world there is a need to address the relative neglect of postcommunism in analysis of postcolonial and neo colonial configurations of power and influence this book proposes new critical perspectives on several themes and concepts that have emerged within or been propagated by postcolonial studies these themes include structures of exclusion inclusion formations of nationalism structures of othering and representations of difference forms and historical realisations of anti colonial anti imperial struggle the experience of trauma involving issues of collective memory amnesia and the re writing of history resistance as a complex of cultural practices and concepts such as alterity ambivalence self colonisation dislocation hegemonic discourse minority and subaltern cultures taken together this volume suggests that some of the methodological instruments of postcolonial criticism can be fruitfully applied to the study of postcommunist cultures and conversely that the experience of the soviet brand of imperialist rule in the form of communism in east central europe can function as an ideological moderator in third world oriented marxist inspired postcolonial discourses this book was originally published as a special issue of the journal of postcolonial writing

this book offers new perspectives on the history of exploitation in africa by examining postcolonial misrule as a product of colonial exploitation political independence has not produced inclusive institutions economic growth or social stability for most africans it has merely transferred the benefits of exploitation from colonial europe to a tiny african elite contributors investigate representations of colonial and postcolonial exploitation in literature and rhetoric covering works from african writers such as ngugi wa thiong o kwame nkrumah and bessie head it then moves to case studies drawing lines between colonial subjugation and present day challenges through essays on mobutu s zaire nigerian politics the italian colonial fascist system and more together these essays look towards how african states may transform their institutions and rupture lingering colonial legacies

despite the urgency to understand how other cultures encounter the west in academic and political spheres feminist

economics has yet to tackle critiques from postcolonial and decolonial feminists about western centric modernism in the field this book introduces a decolonizing approach to feminist economics offering insights that move beyond the boundaries of modern eurocentrism the author explores the relationship between colonialism capitalism heteropatriarchy and ecological degradation while offering critical feminist and decolonizing tools by investigating global struggles the author illuminates our hijacked present and imagines a decolonizing feminist economic landscape that is under transformation transdisciplinary and innovative this book fills a vital gap by exploring the interplay between decolonization and feminist economics challenging the growth logic capitalism and western centrism and imagining new possibilities for more just futures
