edited by mylan engel jr and gary lynn comstock this book employs different ethical lenses including classical deontology libertarianism commonsense morality virtue ethics utilitarianism and the capabilities approach to explore the philosophical basis for the strong animal rights view which holds that animals have moral rights equal in strength to the rights of humans while also addressing what are undoubtedly the most serious challenges to the strong animal rights stance including the challenges posed by rights nihilism the kind argument against animal rights the problem of predation and the comparative value of lives in addition contributors explore the practical import of animal rights both from a social policy standpoint and from the standpoint of personal ethical decisions concerning what to eat and whether to hunt animals unlike other volumes on animal rights which focus primarily on the legal rights of animals and unlike other anthologies on animal ethics which tend to cover a wide variety of topics but only devote a few articles to each topic this volume focuses exclusively on the question of whether animals have moral rights and the practical import of such rights the moral rights of animals will be an indispensable resource for scholars teachers and students in the fields of animal ethics applied ethics ethical theory and human animal studies as well as animal rights advocates and policy makers interested in improving the treatment of animals

happy lives good lives offers a thorough introduction to a variety of perspectives on happiness among the questions at issue is happiness only a state of mind or is it something more is it the same for everyone is it under our control and if so to what extent can we be mistaken about whether we are happy what role if any does happiness play in living a good life is it sometimes morally wrong to pursue happiness should governments promote happiness through public policy asking and answering these questions is worthwhile not only as an intellectual exercise but also as a means of gaining practical insight into how best to pursue a happy life

this book offers an original intersection of concepts from immanuel kant s moral command ethics and søren kierkegaard s existential ethics the kantian formulation of moral law is based on theoretical ground while kierkegaardian ethics of the quest for selfhood views it as the very act of living the present work provides an account of both these perspectives and questions whether these approaches to morality are mutually exclusionary using slavoj Žižek s parallax view in the realm of morality it argues that moral philosophy must engage with a constant critique of difference around which the transformation of our various perspectives to morality revolves this work appeals for furtherance of the conversation model and participation of perspectives to transcend positional confinement it advocates the traversing of the ethical parallax to allow for intellectual openness and an empathetic perception of the other engaging and well researched this book will be of interest to scholars and researchers of ethics political philosophy and continental philosophy

people consider desert part of our moral world it structures how we think about important areas such as love punishment and work this book argues that no one deserves anything if this is correct then claims that people deserve general and specific things are false at the heart of desert is the notion of moral credit or discredit people deserve good things credit when they are good people or do desirable things these desirable things might be right good or virtuous acts people deserve bad things discredit when they are bad people or do undesirable things on some theories people deserve credit in general terms for instance they deserve a good life on

other theories people deserve credit in specific terms for instance they deserve specific incomes jobs punishments relationships or reputations the author s argument against desert rests on three claims there is no adequate theory of what desert is even if there were an adequate theory of what desert is nothing grounds justifies desert even if there were an adequate theory of what desert is and something were to ground it there is no plausible account of what people deserve desert collapses will be of interest to researchers and advanced students working in ethics and political philosophy

this accessible book is invaluable to anyone coming to social and political philosophy for the first time it provides a broad survey of key social and political questions in modern society as well as clear discussions of the philosophical issues central to those questions and to political thought more generally unique among books of this kind is a sustained treatment of specifically social philosophy including topics such as epistemic injustice pornography marriage sexuality and the family the relation between such social questions and specifically political topics is discussed these topics include political authority economic justice the limits of tolerance considerations of community race gender and culture in questions of justice and radical critiques of current political theories updates to the second edition emphasize the non statist areas of the subject and include two brand new chapters on social philosophy and transnational justice this second edition also includes revisions throughout and coverage of recent theoretical discussions and world events

for about two decades john w loftus was a devout evangelical christian an ordained minister of the church of christ and an ardent apologist for christianity with three degrees in philosophy theology and philosophy of religion he was adept at using rational argumentation to defend the faith but over the years doubts about the credibility of key christian tenets began to creep into his thinking by the late 1990s he experienced a full blown crisis of faith in this honest appraisal of his journey from believer to atheist the author carefully explains the experiences and the reasoning process that led him to reject religious belief the original edition of this book was published in 2006 and reissued in 2008 since that time loftus has received a good deal of critical feedback from christians and skeptics alike in this revised and expanded edition the author addresses criticisms of the original adds new argumentation and references and refines his presentation for every issue he succinctly summarizes the various points of view and provides references for further reading in conclusion he describes the implications of life without belief in god some liberating some sobering this frank critique of christian belief from a former insider will interest freethinkers as well as anyone with doubts about the claims of religion
