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the fifth and thoroughly revised edition of regional geography of the united states and canada provides a rich and comprehensive overview of both the physical and human geography of these two countries and in the true spirit of geography the interactions and interrelations of the physical and human following long traditions of the discipline of geography this text incorporates words maps drawings photographs and numerical data to present its information in an engaging way after covering beneficial precursor topics such as the basics of physical and human geography the text explores fifteen regions of the us and canada the authors observe and describe our planet s geography in thorough and accessible detail while laying out the spatial basics of the location shape and size of the different regions and summarizes their most distinctive thematic qualities physical topics covered include the region s topography and landforms soils climate hydrography vegetation and wildlife the human topics include the region s population the ethnicities and settlement history of its people economic activities including agriculture forestry mining fishing manufacturing and service industries cities and transportation in depth essays expand on specific topics of interest and importance while outlook sections prognosticate about the near future of the regions each chapter concludes with a bibliography of books articles and reports that provide further sources for the interested reader

this book provides an integrated view of each of the four provinces of pakistan considered the four micro regions owing to their relative internal homogeneity and distinctiveness from the adjacent regions each chapter of the book deals with a specific province its physical environment historic antecedents contemporary social and economic organization and potential for future growth this volume presents an in depth study of punjab stressing on its transformation from a barren pastureland to rich fertile agricultural land the mineral rich western provinces of baluchistan and khyber pakhtunkhwa are subjects of focused study the penultimate part of the book is a regional study of sindh evaluating the role of indus in the economy of the province and the contribution of karachi as a financial and commercial center it also outlines the planning and development of the federal capital islamabad a symbol of pride and aspiration of the people of pakistan the book would be of immense academic value to students researchers and teachers interested in area studies and regional planning with a descriptive analysis of the country s physical and social characteristics it would also be a great source of information for professionals

there is only one region the surface of the earth on which mankind finds its home yet although much effort is devoted by geographers towards the study of this diversified environment as a whole it has long seemed necessary by the methods of a special or aregional geography to study its component parts and although nature abhors lines geographers might appear to adore them so busily do they engage themselves in delimiting on their maps allegedly significant areas called aregions as a result every student of geography in school college of education and university has been taught read books and attempted to answer questions on regional geography the problem of region in geographic thought how it may be defined how it has developed and how it is applied has been vigorously debated within the discipline in this incisive examination of the types of regions and regional methods treated in modern geography roger minshull analyzes in detail the concepts of formal functional and city regions in an attempt to clarify this vexing problem in addition to sizes shapes boundaries and organization the phenomena that usually form the content of regions are delineated in an attempt to define the nature of regional geography as some regions are seen to be products of geographers minds it is suggested that certain influences especially the

methods of mapping the separate topics that form the content of regions have been exaggerated regionalism and possible alternatives to the regional method are treated and a large section of the book is devoted to the idea of the compage in which the geographer s choice of topics and method of working is much freer than in more traditional approaches

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this book urges the case for reinstating regional geography as a contemporary and relevant methodology much interest was shown in the 1980s in reviving yet restructuring the field of regional geography the essays in this book both review that work and propose a way forward the essays divide into three sections the first assesses traditional regional geography and its relevance to the study of contemporary situations the second the alternative approaches of world systems analysis diffusion and structuration theory the book concludes by considering the potential of regional geography to interpret the structures within which society operates and its claim to remain at the core of the discipline

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a key concern in the debate and empirical research on the geography of regions is the evolution of the conceptualizations and practical uses of the idea of region this idea prioritises both the intellectual and the practical development of regional studies this book drives the discussion further it stresses the complex forms of agency advocacy involved in the production and

reproduction of regional spaces and space of regionalism as well as the importance of geohistory and context the book moves beyond the territorial relational divide that has characterized debates on regions and regional borders since the 1990s the contributors answer key questions from different conceptual and concrete contextual angles and to motivate readers to reflect on the perpetual significance of regional concepts and how they are mobilized by various actors to maintain or transform the contested spatialities of societal power relations this book was based on a special issue of regional studies

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
