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the novella as the editors of this volume explain is in many ways the native habitat of modern chinese literary production the ideal fictional form for revealing the various facets of contemporary chinese culture the seven novellas collected here resoundingly support their claim featuring works by award winners and rising stars women and men by the river presents a confluence of some of the most compelling voices in china today together their narratives reflect the rich diversity of chinese experience in the modern era these novellas are stories of coming of age in the countryside of romance in the shadow of an electrical power station or in the watery landscape of a lost love of a daughter s epic journey to find her estranged mother whether telling of love or loss of work or play along the river of experience the narratives are replete with details that bring literary depth to the everyday the mark of the novella these details and the novellas into which they are woven defy simple

the nuns of santa caterina are back and sinister goings on are afoot old gaetano an amiable local drifter is a welcome and regular guest at the convent but to everyone's shock carabinieri matteo finds his body down by the river murdered in cold blood the village is stunned who would do such a thing and where is gaetano's beloved saint bernard caesar determined to get to the bottom of it sister isabella teams up with matteo whether he likes it or not to follow the clues and solve the mystery but it may not be a simple murder case after all and perhaps old gaetano has not always been whom he claimed to be a delicious cosy crime that is as warm as the tuscan sun perfect for fans of julia chapman fiona leitch and richard osman valentina morelli is a german author with the sister isabella series she pays homage to her spiritual homeland and captures the unique feel of life in tuscany for her murder mysteries are a way of telling human stories

stephen byrne strangled his housemaid to silence her screams he felt no compulsion to admit his crime but instead enlisted the help of a friend to help dispose of the body before pointing the finger at this same friend in an attempt to steal the man's lover this chilling story of murder betrayal and revenge reaches a thrilling climax

author of the princess of thornwood drive khalia moreau returns with a cain and abel retelling set in post colonial trinidad in which family rivalry drives one brother on a desperate quest to save yet possibly damn his older sibling the dead live in sapo and they will claim a soul come hell or high water when sixteen year old roran's saintly and light skinned older brother falls ill in 1963 trinidad people in his village sapo blame obeah blaming dark sorcery the same kind believed to have sunk the southern half of sapo thirty years prior is ludicrous to roran he's a boy of science and his

brother is just ill albeit the doctors aren't quite sure with what but when roran hears the cries of those who died in southern sago he seeks out father basdeo a man rumored to have eyes that can see the living and the dead father basdeo explains to roran that roran has the eyes on him too and only roran can save his brother by communing with the spirits he just needs to put his jealousy aside and risk the one thing most people in his village would never dare risk having his soul trapped in sago's sunken side a historical horror fantasy set in post colonial trinidad he burns by the river explores themes of colorism and racism while incorporating folklore and culture unique to the caribbean and it just might keep you up at night come wade in the murky waters of sago if you dare

one of australia's most celebrated novels one woman's journey from australia to london nora porteous a witty ambitious woman from brisbane returns to her childhood home at age seventy her life has taken her from a failed marriage in sydney to freedom in london she forged a modest career as a seamstress and lived with two dear friends through the happiest years of her adult life at home the neighborhood children she remembers have grown into compassionate adults they help to nurse her back from pneumonia and slowly let her in on the dark secrets of the neighborhood in the years that have lapsed with grace and humor nora recounts her desire to escape the way her marriage went wrong the vanity that drove her to get a facelift and one romantic sea voyage that has kept her afloat during her dark years her memory is imperfect but the strength and resilience she shows over the years is nothing short of extraordinary a book about the sweetness of escape and the mix of pain and acceptance that comes with returning home

reflections on race environment politics and living on the front lines of change in angels by the river james gustave gus speth recounts his unlikely path from a southern boyhood through his years as one of the nation's most influential mainstream environmentalists and eventually to the system changing activism that shapes his current work born and raised in an idyllic but racially divided town that later became the scene of south carolina's horrific orangeburg massacre speth explores how the civil rights movement and the south's agrarian roots shaped his later work in the heyday of the environmental movement when he founded two landmark environmental groups fought for the nation's toughest environmental laws spearheaded programs in the united nations advised the white house and moved

into a leading academic role as dean of Yale's prestigious school of forestry and environmental studies yet in the end he arrived somewhere quite unexpected still believing change is possible but not within the current political and economic system throughout this compelling memoir Speth intertwines three stories his own his hometown's and his country's focusing mainly on his early years and the lessons he drew from them and his later years in which he comes full circle in applying those lessons in the process he invites others to join him politically at or near the place at which he has arrived wherever they may have started
