capture of gimpel a few days later they were tried and convicted by military tribune and sentenced to be hanged but presidential politics and world events led to a change in their sentence to life in prison colepaugh served 15 years in federal prison and was released in 1960 for the next 42 years of his life he functioned as a successful businessman community member and husband with his past only known to a select few including his wife in 2002 he was exposed by a journalist and lived in seclusion the remaining three years of his life
