deep in vast undiscovered caverns under the mountains of this earth live tiny people who call themselves the keepers they move undetected amongst ordinary people on the earths surface due to their size and the speed at which they travel the day school gets out for the year jeffrey williams discovers one of these little people who is assigned to watch over him she places a crystal on him which gives him the power to enter the world of the keepers moving at one thousand miles a hour jeffrey and his sister elizabeth go to the mountains of wyoming to spend the summer with their grandparents during their visit they discover a cave which leads them to the hidden world of these little people the keepers had been expecting them they had been chosen since birth to visit the great city of crystals and to perform a special mission only they could they are guided to crystal city by five of the greatest warriors in the under world their trek takes them on several detours in order to find passageways large enough to accommodate the young giants every turn in the path seems to bring them new dangers and adventures

it is the blazing summer of 1981 and catherine is laid low by childhood illness stuck inside her family s sprawling victorian mansion at the foot of a highland mountain she can only look down into the garden and observe the goings on upon the lawn sam and rosa her elder teenage cousins have come to spend the school holiday in this seemingly idyllic setting and catherine savours the brief visits sam makes to her room but when rosa falls in love with humberto a young spanish man camping in the grounds of the house and catherine witnesses a violent attack on sam s beloved dog the events of that summer take on a darker hue under the mountain is a fiercely intelligent and beautifully written novel about domestic politics and first loves and in an unforgettable narrative that is both moving and haunting sophie cooke powerfully exposes hidden inner lives and reveals the sometimes devastating consequences of love and the lies it can tell

in the baliem valley in central new guinea lived a stone age tribe which survived into the twentieth century the kurelu matthiessen joined the harvard peabody expedition of 1961 which set out to study the tribe as unobtrusively as possible living among the kurelu for two seasons the result was this classic account not of the expedition but of a lost culture the kurelu s timeless rhythms of work and play of warriorship feasting and funerals in under the mountain wall matthiessen illuminates the lives of the kurelu s with respect and sympathy capturing a culture untouched by civilisation and vanishing along with the wilderness lying beneath the dramatic peaks of the snow mountains

in a fractured world where survival is a daily battle ash and caleb solomon have found solace and love in the remote mountain community of beartooth but when their first encounter with the extremist freedom and morality alliance turned deadly caleb vows to protect his family and home from the fanatics controlling neighboring pryor wyoming leading a small team into hostile territory caleb discovers pryor is far darker and more sinister than he ever imagined meanwhile ash faces her own harrowing challenges back in beartooth where every day brings new threats from prowling predators to nature s fury as tensions rise and dangers mount ash and caleb are pushed to their limits the fight for survival becomes more than a battle against enemies it s a test of resilience sacrifice and unbreakable love will they find a way to protect their fragile haven or will the shadows of pryor and the wild claim everything they hold dear

now that the korean war is over dr david cabot is one of many doctors drafted by the army who are ready to head home unfortunately due to a freak communication error dr cabot is now in route to a hillbilly medical practice in boston knob west virginia instead of boston massachusetts where he was looking forward to running a lucrative big city practice his acrimony about his unplanned new home is diminished somewhat when he is met at the bluefield airport by a gorgeous redheaded nurse who immediately captures his interest as jenny stone guides dr cabot through the dichotomous poverty and wealth that surrounds the west virginia coal culture he quickly falls for her while attempting to embrace his new practice and the isolated people enslaved by the mountains and absentee coal magnets but little does he know that his backward journey will soon take him to jail as a moonshiner and eventually into an old fashioned church revival the bowels of a mine disaster and a murder mystery like no other in this historical tale an army doctor drafted in the korean war inadvertently heads toward a new solo practice in west virginia where he falls for a beautiful hillbilly and becomes immersed in a battle for coalminers

from the archetypal stories series giant under the mountain the mystery of sacrifice when two friends jerrell and bill share a vivid dream of a mysterious island they embark on a solstice journey that leads them across turbulent waters and into a land hidden from ordinary sight guided by an ancient interpreter and accompanied by a powerful otherworldly horse they encounter a realm shaped by elemental forces archetypal creatures and an unnamed pressure demanding release through ritual sacrifice as they attempt to rescue a captive girl and confront the shadowy forces behind the island s demand for blood they face the legendary giant who dwells beneath the mountain and the elusive panther man who haunts its waters their quest becomes a trial of courage compassion and the mystery of willing sacrifice giant under the mountain is an archetypal tale of dream logic and mythic confrontation a symbolic journey into the roots of violence power and redemption at once an adventure and a meditation this story explores how small acts of sacrifice and love can tip the balance in a world caught between darkness and transformation

second is an adaptation in verse in the style of medieval mystery plays and the third is a dramatized service of lessons and carols with eucharist some churches adopt one pageant as an annual production others try a different one each year pageant 1 good news of great joy this is the simplest pageant in concept and uses the isaiah text of the prophecies with scenes of the annunciation the arrival at bethlehem the shepherds and the magi it is intended to replace the sermon or liturgy of the word or stand alone pageant 2 a child of might this production is based on medieval mystery plays with static staging that is easier than in pageant 1 however it doe use archaic english and requires memorization it does not include the magi but introduces several characters not usually found in other pageants pageant 3 people look east this version presents a dramatized service of lessons and carols for advent and christmas it features nine scripture readings each followed by a carol or hymn with performance options children mime the readings it is intended to be an entire sunday liturgy includes communion go tell it on the mountain is also available as a downloadable product on the church publishing website

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
