traudl junge was 22 years old and dreamt of a career as a ballerina until the opportunity of her life beckoned and she was appointed as adolf hitler s secretary from 1942 until his death she was at his side in the bunker typing his correspondence his speeches and even his last private and political will and testament it was only after the war that the horrible reality of hitler s regime began to dawn on her and she became racked with guilt for liking the greatest criminal ever to have lived her journal written in 1947 is a startling eyewitness account of hitler s court during its final years and of the building sense of doom as the war progressed

adolf hitler was hardly the modern world s only murderous tyrant and imperialist yet he and the regime he ruled over for 12 years exerted an enormous impact on the history of the 20th century we are still living with the consequences interpretations of his life and legacy continue to exert a range of influences some beneficial and other deleterious on our politics and popular culture for the world to be done with hitler the german journalist and historian sebastian haffner wrote in 1978 it had to kill not just the man but the legend as well that legend has proven to be like the mythical hydra adolf hitler a reference guide to his life and works captures hitler s life his works and legacy it features a chronology an introduction offers a brief account of his life a dictionary section lists entries on people places and events related to him a comprehensive bibliography offers a list of works by and about hitler

a hive of interesting facts and almost unbelievable stories about adolf hitler well worth a look well worth a read war history online based on intelligence documents personal testimonies memoirs and official histories including material only declassified in 2010 guarding hitler provides the reader with a fascinating inside look at the secret world of hitler s security and domestic arrangements the book focuses in particular on both the official and private life of hitler during the latter part of the war at the wolf s lair at rastenburg and hitler s private residence at berchtesgaden the berghof guarding hitler manages to offer fresh insights into the life and routine of the f hrer and most importantly often indiscreet opinions observations and activities of the little people who surrounded hitler but whose stories have been overshadowed by the great affairs of state it covers not only the plots against hitler s life but the way security developed as a result his use of doubles is examined as is security while traveling by land or air as little has been written about the security and domestic life of adolf hitler guarding hitler allows the reader to delve deeper into this previously overlooked aspect of the world s most infamous man a fascinating view into the close world hitler inhabited and which shaped his life and decisions fire reviews

this detailed guide to hitler s secret prussian headquarters is fully illustrated with historic photos and rare color images of how it appears today set deep in the masurian woods of northern poland formally east prussia lies a vast complex of ruined bunkers known as the wolfsschanze or wolf s lair this was hitler s headquarters for the german attack on the soviet union in 1941 it is also where colonel von stauffenberg almost killed hitler in the summer of 1944 built in under total secrecy the wolfsschanze was camouflaged with artificial grass and trees drawing on a unique collection of color photographs hitler s wolfsschanze presents a detailed tour of the 2.5 square mile campus as it appears today with each building and its purpose identified laced with personal accounts of the installation and hitler s routines the wolfsschanze is brought to life once more yet the wolfsschanze was not the only german military complex in this small part of the eastern front this comprehensive volume also shows and describes the german army s headquarters at mauerwald the luftwaffe s headquarters near the current russian border and those of the ss and the reich chancellery both situated near the wolfsschanze

a biography of the man who served as head of the nazi party chancellery hitler s personal secretary and the monster who decided the fate of millions born on june 17 1900 martin ludwig bormann became one of the most powerful and most feared men in the third reich an obsessive bureaucrat it was bormann who helped steer hitler s apparatus of terror so effectively that he became the clandestine ruler of nazi germany after joining the nazi party in 1927 bormann rose through its ranks indeed by july 1933 bormann had maneuvered himself into the position where he became the chief of cabinet in the office of the deputy fñhrer rudolf hess in this role bormann gradually consolidated his power base so that when hess carried out his infamous flight to the united kingdom in 1941 bormann stepped into his shoes as the head of

the party chancellery bormann took control of the nazi party by the end of 1942 he was hitler s deputy and his closest collaborator with the f hrer increasingly preoccupied with military matters hitler came to rely more and more on bormann to handle germany s domestic affairs on 12 april 1943 bormann was appointed personal secretary to the f hrer feared by ministers gauleiters civil servants judges and generals alike bormann identified strongly with hitler s ideas on racial politics destruction of the jews and forced labor and made himself indispensable as the f hrer s executioner cold as ice he decided the fate of millions of people in january 1945 with the third reich collapsing bormann returned to the f hrerbunker with hitler following hitler s suicide on 30 april bormann was named as party minister thus officially confirming his rise to the top of the party late the following day he fled from the bunker to escape the encircling red army his fate remaining a mystery for many years in october 1946 he was found guilty in absentia by the international military tribunal at nuremberg and sentenced to death drawing heavily on recently declassified documents and files the historian and journalist volker koop reveals the full story of the most faithful member of hitler s inner circle an individual who whilst little known to the german people became the second most powerful man in the third reich praise for martin bormann hitler s executioner an unbelievable monster but people still need to know about him and what he did here fulfilled by volker koop who simply doesn t hold back books monthly uk

hitler believed himself to be as much an artist as a politician and his rise to power owed a great deal to the creation of myth around his own personality in his germany politics and culture became one the cult of celebrity nurtured and driven by hitler and his acolyte joseph goebbels in their version of hollywood there were scandals starlets secret agents premieres and the infamous casting couch but one of the actresses was a soviet agent who held the key to killing the f hrer hitler and the nazi cult of celebrity probes the correlation between power and ambition shows how films were used as weapons and uncovers the sexual predilections of the nazi hierarchy it also brings to light previously unpublished information about the hitler film goebbels saw as the greatest story ever told which was in the planning even as hitler himself was heading for his own wagnerian finale

meticulous probably the most disturbing portrait of hitler i have ever read dominic sandbrook sunday times by the summer of 1939 hitler was at the zenith of his power yet despite initial triumphs in the early stages of war the f hrer s fortunes would turn dramatically conflict raged on realising that victory was lost and with soviet troops closing in on his berlin bunker hitler committed suicide in april 1945

one week later nazi germany surrendered his murderous ambitions had not only annihilated his own country but had cost the lives of millions across europe in the final volume of this landmark biography volker ullrich argues that the very qualities and the defects that accounted for hitler s popularity and rise to power were what brought about his ruin a keen strategist and meticulous military commander he was also a deeply insecure gambler who could be shaken by the smallest setback and was quick to blame subordinates for his own disastrous mistakes drawing on a wealth of new sources and scholarship this is the definitive portrait of the man who dragged the world into chaos

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
