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this anthology comprises of interviews with contemporary south african authors offering vignettes of their lives and summaries of their works in curating this book danyela demir and olivier moreillon step beyond pure literary theory and analysis they welcome the authors to speak and assess the literary panorama in which they live and co create however demir and moreillon also trace concepts and terms that describe the current south african literature such as post transitional literature and literature beyond

2000 by adopting a world literary approach to post apartheid literature this book contributes to debates on contemporary south african writing in addition tracing the post apartheid novel beyond 2000 seeks to raise awareness of the imbalance in both critical and public attention between literary big names such as andré p brink j m coetzee nadine gordimer and zakes mda who are popular worldwide and the younger and newer generation of south african writers who go largely unnoticed print edition not for sale in sub saharan africa

post apartheid gothic white south african writers and space analyzes the representation of space in recent works by south african writers by combining analytical tools borrowed from gothic studies with geocritical and postcolonial approaches mélanie joseph vilain assesses the literary mechanisms utilized by damon galgut henrietta rose innes lauren beukes justin carwright and lynn freed to negotiate the complexities of post apartheid identities in their fiction joseph vilain argues that the literary representations of emblematic places real or imagined the home the farm the city or the non places of dystopia express and reveal anxieties linked to the sharing of space in post apartheid south africa the text successively re visits the places that have been shaping south african white writing since olive schreiner s african farm in other words its topoi both in the etymological sense of place and in the literary sense of recurring themes or arguments joseph vilain argues that these gothicized topoi have provided writers with tools to explore the deep anxieties generated by the redefinition of south african society as the rainbow nation while focusing specifically on the south african avatars of the gothic and their interaction with local forms and genres like the plaasroman the text also discusses the impact of globalization on south african literary cultural social and political identities

to read a crime novel today largely simulates the exercise of reading newspapers or watching the news the speed and frequency with which today s bestselling works of crime fiction are produced allow them to mirror and dissect nearly contemporaneous socio political events and conflicts this collection examines this phenomenon and offers original critical essays on how national identity appears in international crime fiction in the age of populism and globalization these essays address topics such as the array of competing nationalisms in europe indian secularism versus hindu communalism the populist rhetoric tinged with misogyny or homophobia in the united states racial religious or ethnic others who are sidelined in political appeals to dominant native voices and the increasing economic chasm between a rich and poor more broadly these essays inquire into themes such as how national identity and various conceptions of masculinity are woven together how dominant native cultures interact with migrant and colonized cultures to explore insider outsider paradigms and identity politics and how generic and cultural boundaries are repeatedly crossed in postcolonial detective fiction

this book examines south africa s post apartheid culture through the lens of affect theory in order to argue that the socio political

project of the new south africa best exemplified in their truth and reconciliation commission hearings was fundamentally an affective emotional project through the trc hearings which publicly broadcast the testimonies of both victims and perpetrators of gross human rights violations the african national congress government of south africa represented by nelson mandela and archbishop desmond tutu endeavoured to generate powerful emotions of contrition and sympathy in order to build an empathetic bond between white and black citizens a bond referred to frequently by tutu in terms of the african philosophy of interconnection ubuntu this book explores the representations of affect and the challenges of generating ubuntu through close readings of a variety of cultural products novels poetry memoir drama documentary film and audio anthology

this book examines how same sex sexualities are represented in several post apartheid south african cultural texts drawing on a rich local archive of same sex sexualities that includes recent fiction drama film photography and popular print culture while the book situates these texts within the specific context of post apartheid south africa it also looks outwards towards transnational connectivity and cultural flows the author uses the idea of restlessness to refer to the uneven flow of cultural tropes political sentiment ideas ideologies and representational modes across geographical boundaries across time and space and between genres presenting sexual cultures as simultaneously rooted and transnational he focuses on how notions of race and gender in the shadow of colonialism and apartheid play out in the present and shape how sexualities are represented this interdisciplinary book offers a conceptual entry point to several areas of study including transnationalism literary and cultural studies critical race theory gender and sexuality studies and african studies and will be of interest to students and researchers across these fields its inclusion of a range of textual genres extends its reach into visual culture film and media studies history and politics

welcome to our hillbrow is an exhilarating and disturbing ride through the chaotic and hyper real zone of hillbrow microcosm of all that is contradictory alluring and painful in the postapartheid south african psyche everything is there the shattered dreams of youth sexuality and its unpredictable costs aids xenophobia suicide the omnipotent violence that often cuts short the promise of young people's lives and the africanist understanding of the life continuum that does not end with death but flows on into an ancestral realm infused with the rhythms of the inner city pulsebeat this courageous novel is compelling in its honesty and its broad vision which links hillbrow rural tiragalong and oxford it spills out the guts of hillbrow living with the same energy and intimate knowledge with which the drum writers wrote sophiatown into being

nadine gordimer and the rhetoric of otherness in post apartheid south africa observes and examines several issues that are central to the south african writer's works the uniqueness of terror in a difficult historical period the desire to annihilate racial oppression and above all the psychological alienation provoked by racism the analysis also focuses on literary topics that are

specific to gordimer's post apartheid writings such as the significance of multiculturalism the status of writers the banalisation of violence due to mass media coverage the reconciliation with a violent past globalization and loss of cultural and national identity economic exile and migration the book proposes in five chapters a journey into nadine gordimer's novels short stories and non fiction that presents the reader with a multifaceted other who is no longer specific to postcolonial and multicultural south africa but can be identified across the globe as alterity is redefined by globalization

present imperfect asks how south african writers have responded to the end of apartheid to the hopes that attended the birth of the new nation in 1994 and to the inevitable disappointments that have followed the first full length study of affect in south africa's literature it understands disappointment both as a description of bad feeling and as naming a missed appointment with all that was promised by the anti colonial and anti apartheid struggle a disappointment attending to contemporary writers treatment of temporality genre and form it considers a range of negative feelings that are also experiences of temporal disjuncture including stasis impasse boredom disaffection and nostalgia present imperfect offers close readings of work by a range of writers some known to international anglophone readers including j m coetzee nadine gordimer ivan vladislavic and zoë wicomb some slightly less well known including afrikaans language novelists marlene van niekerk and ingrid winterbach and others from a new generation including songeziwe mahlangu and masande ntshanga it addresses key questions in south african studies about the evolving character of the historical period in which the country now finds itself it is also alert to wider critical and theoretical conversations looking outward to make a case for the place of south african writing in global conversations and mobilizing readings of writing marked in various ways as south african in order to complicate the contours of world literature as category discipline and pedagogy it is thus also a book about the discontents of neoliberalism the political energies of reading and the fates of literature in our troubled present

refusal transition and post apartheid law under editorship of professor karin van marle is indeed long overdue as some of the authors in the relevant contributions to this publication rightly point out van marle's call for a jurisprudence of generosity enabled through an ethics of refusal signals a new shift in south african jurisprudence through the lens of van marle's ethics of refusal and her jurisprudence of generosity the articles present fresh and meaningful interpretations in respect of a range of very relevant topics ranging from property theory and a rethinking of human rights to the role of forgiveness and the dangers inherent in modern technology

engaging important discussions about social conflict environmental change and imperialism in africa different shades of green points to legacies of african environmental writing often neglected as a result of critical perspectives shaped by dominant western

conceptions of nature and environmentalism drawing on an interdisciplinary framework employing postcolonial studies political ecology environmental history and writing by african environmental activists byron caminero santangelo emphasizes connections within african environmental literature highlighting how african writers have challenged unjust ecologically destructive forms of imperial development and resource extraction different shades of green also brings into dialogue a wide range of african creative writing including works by chinua achebe ngũgĩ wa thiong o bessie head nadine gordimer zakes mda nuruddin farah wangari maathai and ken saro wiwa in order to explore vexing questions for those involved in the struggle for environmental justice in the study of political ecology and in the environmental humanities urging continued imaginative thinking in effecting a more equitable sustainable future in africa

south africa's post apartheid narrative is one of democracy and equality but its flaws run deep argues ives s loukson disclosing prejudices about whiteness homosexuality and democracy in the staged society he claims the concept of relation as an adequate framework for the embodiment of profane democracy understood in agambian terms its fluidity is equated to openness and transparency that are relevant dimensions for profane democracy a demonstration of literary criticism practiced as a fecund interdisciplinary activity loukson's study lays the foundation for post apartheid criticism different from post colonial criticism

apartheid and beyond explores a wide range of south african writings to demonstrate the way apartheid functioned in its day to day operations as a geographical system of control exerting its power through such spatial mechanisms as residential segregation bantustans passes and prisons

mixed race stereotypes in south african and american literature examines the popular literary stereotype the tragic mulatto from a transnational perspective mafe considers the ways in which specific south african and american writers have used this controversial literary character to challenge the logic of racial categorization

african literature is a vast subject of growing output and interest written especially for students this book selectively surveys the topic in a clear and accessible way included are roughly 600 alphabetically arranged entries on writers genres and major works many entries cite works for further reading and the volume closes with a selected general bibliography africa is a land of contrasts and of diverse cultures and traditions it is also a land of conflict and creativity the literature of the continent draws upon a fascinating body of oral traditions and lore and also reflects the political turmoil of the modern world with the increased interest in cultural diversity and the growing centrality of africa in world politics african literature is figuring more and more prominently in the curriculum this book helps students learn about the african literary achievement written expressly for students this book is far more accessible than other reference works on the subject included are nearly 600 alphabetically arranged entries on authors such as chinua achebe athol fugard buchi emecheta nadine gordimer and wole soyinka major works such as things fall apart and petals of blood and individual genres such as the novel drama and poetry many entries cite works for further reading and the volume closes with a selected general bibliography

homosexuality was and still is thought to be quintessentially un african yet in this book chantal zabus examines the anthropological cultural and literary representations of male and female same sex desire from early colonial contacts between europe and africa in the nineteenth century to the present covering a broad geographical spectrum from mali to south africa and from senegal to kenya and adopting a comparative approach encompassing two colonial languages english and french and some

african languages out in africa charts developments in sub saharan african texts and contexts through the work of 7 colonial and some 25 postcolonial writers

an interdisciplinary volume of essays that engages with what the social might mean after apartheid remains of the social is an interdisciplinary volume of essays that engages with what the social might mean after apartheid a condition referred to as the post apartheid social the volume grapples with apartheid as a global phenomenon that extends beyond the borders of south africa between 1948 and 1994 and foregrounds the tension between the weight of lived experience that was and is apartheid the structures that condition that experience and a desire for a post apartheid social think unity through difference collectively the contributors argue for a recognition of the the post apartheid as a condition that names the labour of coming to terms with the ordering principles that apartheid both set in place and foreclosed the volume seeks to provide a sense of the terrain on which the post apartheid as a desire for a difference that is not apartheid s difference unfolds falters and is worked through

this book reflects on south african literature from the perspective of 2020 it emerges from duncan brown s experiences of three decades of working in this field of writing and scholarship it is a personal intellectual exploration and an engagement with the institutional history of literary studies in south africa and elsewhere finding my way also attempts to find more creative engaging and intriguing modes of writing about literature and the humanities universally it seeks to recover a sense of the imaginative the literary and the affective not only as things to value in the literary texts we read but also as ways of understanding and reading texts as ways of writing criticism of registering how books make us feel as well as how they make us think print edition not for sale in sub saharan africa

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
