the bible is one of the world's most important books from the epic stories of the world's creation and exodus in the old testament and the powerful new testament tales of jesus christ the christian messiah the bible has served for millennia as a rich font of material for much of the western world's culture and philosophy inside the easy guide to the bible you will find expert advice to the bible's many important themes and characters

in this book thomas merton presents an interesting and lucid exploration of the function of the bible in contemporary society the author is particularly concerned with the bible as a dialogue between god and man with the bible's relevance for the large number of people who challenge its fundamental truth and with modern attitudes to the bible's ethical and moral teachings his approach is fresh and lively he discusses the attitudes of writers and thinkers as diverse as dietrich bonhoeffer erich fromm pasolini william faulkner and marx as well as the scriptural writings of other world religions such as judaism buddhism and confucianism

paul thomas chronicles a multi level reception study of the bible at both the creation museum and the ark encounter in kentucky usa thomas explores the commercial presentation of biblical narratives and the reception of those narratives by the patrons of each attraction focusing upon

three topics what do young creationists believe how they interpret their beliefs from the bible and what is the user experience at the museums the volume begins by explaining how answers in genesis aig use bible passages to support young earth creationist arguments allowing for the chance to consider the bible via physical means thomas then examines how the creation museum and the ark encounter visitors receive the bible as presented by aig and how this presentation informs visitors understanding of the text exploring concepts such as the most prominent displays of the two attractions the larger context of museums and theme parks and the case studies of the methuselah display and the noah interview he concludes with the summary of the user experience generated by the attractions analyzing the degree to which patrons accept negotiate or resist the interpretation of the bible offered by aig

this is a book about an ancient writer the j writer the yahwist who produced a work of political imagination this work is embedded mainly in the first four books of the bible best known for some of the most popular and influential biblical stories in genesis and exodus the purpose of the book is to represent the whole of the original story with attention to its own meaning without the influence of the other literary strands with which it was later supplemented therefore the work includes a fresh complete translation of the text of the j writer who produced the bible's first history the translation itself helps to establish more clearly than ever the integrity of the j writer the concern here is when and why this history was written especially in light of the concerns for justice and prosperity throughout it is demonstrated how and why this history comes from the court of david it is a royal history of david's subjects as though they were descended from pastoral nomads such as abram isaac and jacob it is argued that the intended audience of the history was probably those bedouin who regularly visited the court of

david in hebron and jerusalem here is a bold and brilliant representation of the j writer s composition perhaps as it was originally intended to be read or heard this ancient tour de force takes on new life in the hands of these skilled interpreters

in this book walter brueggemann america s premier biblical theologian introduces the reader to the broad theological scope and chronological sweep of the old testament he covers every book of the old testament in the order in which it appears in the hebrew bible and treats the most important issues and methods in contemporary interpretation of the old testament literary historical and theological

dante alighieri cited the bible extensively in his commedia but also used his epic poem to meditate on the meaning of the scriptures as a true text the biblical dante provides close readings of passages from the commedia to explore how dante s concept of biblical truth differs sharply from modern notions v stanley benfell examines dante s argument that the truth of the sacred text could only be revealed when engaged with in a transformative manner and that a lack of such encounters in his time had led to a rise in greed and corruption notably within the church he also illustrates how the poet put forth a vision for the restoration of a just society using biblical language and imagery revealing ideas of both earthly and eternal happiness the biblical dante provides an insightful analysis of attitudes towards both the bible and how it was read in the medieval period
